UTGST Deptt. issues directive for strict adherence to recent changes made in GST

Businesses not adhering to GST rules & regulations will be penalised

In pursuant to the 56th GST Council Meeting, Notification number 13/2015-Central Tax, 14/2025-Central Tax, 15/2025-Central Tax, 16/2025-Central Tax, 9/2025-Central Tax (Rate), 10/2025-Central Tax (Rate), 11/2025-Central Tax (Rate), 12/2025-Central Tax (Rate), 13/2025-Central Tax (Rate), 14/2025-Central Tax (Rate), 16/2025-Central Tax (Rate) and 17/2025-Central Tax (Rate) all dated 17/09/2025 have been issued by CBIC. It has been observed that some of the businesses of Andaman & Nicobar Islands are not adhering to the recent changes made in the GST. Some businesses of Andaman & Nicobar Islands are not passing the benefits of recent changes made in GST to the customers.

In view of the above circumstances, the GST Department is running a drive in Andaman & Nicobar Islands penalising the businesses who are not adhering to the recent changes made in GST and not passing on the benefits to the customers.

Hence, all businesses have been informed that they must adhere to the rules and regulations formed by GST Department. The businesses who are not adhering to the GST rules and regulations will be penalised as per GST rules and regulations.

If any resident/ business wants to lodge a grievance with respect to non-compliance or any clarification relating to GST rates or its implementation in the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, they may do so by informing on the WhatsApp number 9595359698, a press release from UTGST said.

ANPCC extends deadline for industrial units to obtain direct CTO till Oct. 31

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 5

The Andaman and Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) has extended the deadline for industrial units that were established without prior pollution clearance to regularize their operations. In its XXXIV meeting held in May 2025, the Committee decided to allow such units to apply for Consent to Operate (CTO) directly-without obtaining prior Consent to Establish (CTE)-till 31st October, 2025.

As per the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1986, compliance with these regulations is mandatory.

The ANPCC has observed that several industrial units in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands have been set up and are operational without acquiring the necessary pollution consents. This constitutes a violation of the aforementioned Acts. While a previous compliance window was provided to such units, the committee continues to receive CTO applications without prior CTE, prompting the extension. The CTO will be issued only if the industrial unit meets all applicable environmental norms. The ANPCC emphasized that no CTO applications will be entertained after October, 31, 2025 from units that failed to obtain CTE prior to establishment.

All stakeholders and industrial entrepreneurs are reminded that it is a statutory requirement to obtain CTE before

Draft Beach Tourism Guidelines 2025 and Draft Beach Tourism Policy 2025 for A&N Islands prepared by Directorate of IP&T

The Directorate of Information, Publicity & Tourism, A&N Administration has prepared draft Beach Tourism Guidelines-2025 and draft Beach Tourism Policy-2025 for the pristine beaches and exceptional biodiversity. These fragile oceanic Islands host a rare mix of tropical rainforests, coral reefs, mangroves, and seagrass meadows. Out of a total of 836 Islands, only 31 are inhabited, leaving vast stretches of the archipelago in its natural state. With a 1,962-kilometre coastline, the Islands are home to some of the most ecologically sensitive and visually spectacular beaches in the world.

In recent years, the Islands have witnessed an unprecedented rise in tourism, particularly beach tourism, which has brought notable economic opportunities. However, this rapid growth has also resulted in mounting pressures on the environment and local communities. Unregulated tourism may lead to issues such as degradation of coastal and marine ecosystems. The rising footfall-both from domestic and international tourists-demands proactive and structured management to avoid long-term ecological damage.

The Beach Tourism Policy has been developed to respond to these challenges by providing a framework for sustainable, inclusive, and regulated tourism. Given that majority of the Islands' area is forest and most of the beaches are in reserve forests and protected areas,

A & N Police issues update on missing case of Niamat Ali

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 5

A missing report of Shri Niamat Ali (49 years), a resident of Shadipur, Sri Vijaya Puram, who had travelled to Chennai on 27th July, 2025 for business purposes, was reported by his family at PS Aberdeen which was registered forthwith and taken up for enquiry. Considering the gravity of the case, a special Police team led by SI G. Mohan Rao and PC/ 614 Jairaj of PS Aberdeen was immediately deputed to Chennai to trace the missing person.

During initial investigation, the team coordinated with S2 Police Station, Chennai Airport and gathered vital evidences including CCTV footages, mobile call records, and witness statements. The analysis of CCTV footage in Chennai accessed by the team confirmed that Shri. Niamat Ali had travelled from Chennai Airport to Vandalur, where he was last seen with a young man later identified as

Mohammed Ayaan, R/o A&N Islands - a college student pursuing studies at Chennai.

Based on technical, circumstantial evidence and witness statements, the team identified main suspects who were from Andaman & Nicobar Islands who could have information about the status of the missing person.

Further, the enquiry at Chennai revealed that the missing person had landed in Chennai, taken public and private transport over there and had met certain people. Acting on the leads provided by the team of PS Aberdeen, Chennai Police registered an FIR No. 36/2025 of missing person dated 10/08/2025 at S2 Police Station, Chennai Airport for further investigation and later the same was transferred to PS K h i l a m b a t h a m , Tambaram District. All the material collected by PS Aberdeen team was handed over to Tamil Nadu Police and the local

police have solved the case as a murder and is further investigating the case.

The family of Niamat Ali had approached Shri Hargobinder Singh Dhaliwal, IPS, Director General of Police, A&N Islands. Pursuant to her representation, the DGP personally coordinated with the Chennai Police and ensured that all necessary and appropriate actions were promptly initiated. He personally followed up the case meticulously with Tamil Nadu Police and ensured all the support possible to the victim family.

The investigation is going on and the A&N Police is committed to ensuring justice for the victim and his family and continues close coordination with Tamil Nadu Police for any support to the family, and the Tamil Nadu Police for any investigative support, a press release from SSP, South Andaman District said.

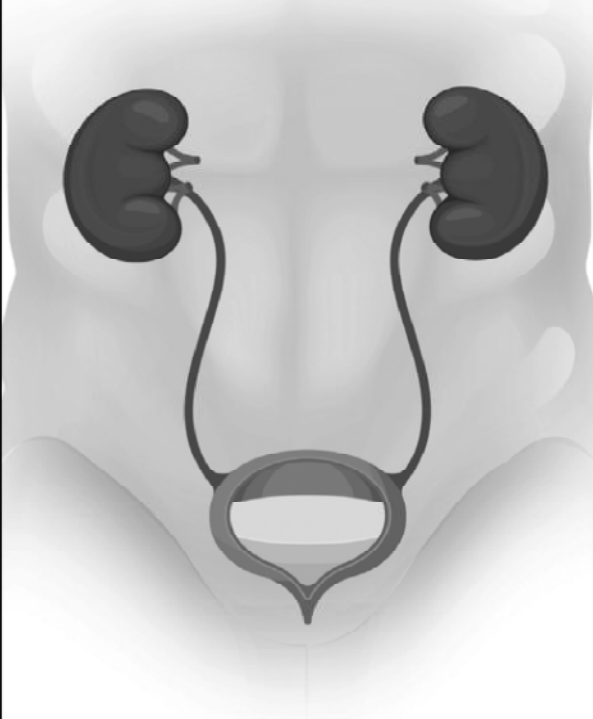
