Shri Prakash Adhikari, Chairperson, DPC (SA), highlighted the overall purpose, vision and significance of the DPC meeting for coordinated district development.

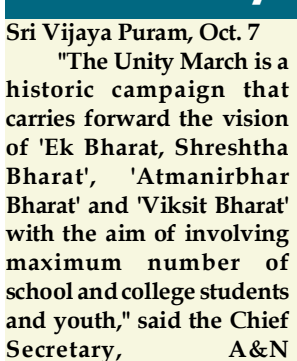

Deputy Commissioner (SA) reviews compliance on use of Cough Syrups in paediatric population

Directs all health facilities, private clinics & pharmacy stakeholders to refrain from dispensing cough syrups to general public without valid Doctor's prescription

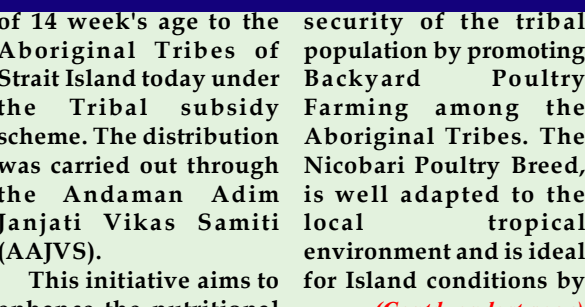
Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, convened a meeting today with all concerned stakeholders to review and ensure compliance with the Advisory issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoH&FW), Government of India, regarding the rational use of cough syrups in the paediatric population. The meeting was held in reference to the directions issued by the Director General of Health Services (DGHS), MoH&FW, and the subsequent circular issued by the Directorate of Health Services, Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

The session aimed to strengthen regulatory vigilance and promote the safe and judicious use of cough syrups, especially among children. The meeting was attended by representatives from the Health Department, Drug Control Administration, Medical Officers, Pharmacists, Private Clinics, and Private Chemist Associations.

As per the advisory issued by the DGHS, cough and cold medications should not be prescribed or dispensed to children under 2 years of age. These medications are generally not recommended for children below 5 years, and for older children, their use should follow careful clinical evaluation and close supervision. Strict adherence to appropriate dosing, shortest effective duration, and avoidance of multiple drug combinations is essential. A detailed review was undertaken to assess the current availability and distribution of cough

fertilizer shops into one-stop service centres for farmers, integrating sales, soil testing, advisories, and scheme awareness. She encouraged the Agriculture Department and private input dealers to work in coordination and cooperative institutions to ensure that PACS effectively function as PM-KSK units delivering quality inputs and services to farmers.

In her address, Ms. Priyanka Kumari, Director (Agriculture), A&N Administration, highlighted the need for organizing such orientation programmes to ensure uniform understanding and effective implementation of Government schemes and also empowers the officials and stakeholders to comply with statutory requirements and deliver better services to farmers.

The subsequent technical sessions covered the regulatory frameworks and licensing procedures for various agricultural inputs. Dr. (Smt.) S.C. Rekha, Joint Director (Agri.), HQ (I/c), gave a detailed presentation on the regulatory and procedural requirements for fertilizer licenses. She discussed documentation, inspection, renewal protocols, and the importance of compliance with the Fertilizer (Control) Order.

Shri Navasakthi, Assistant Director (Agri.), Extension, delivered a session on the orientation for pesticide licensing, explaining the step-by-step process. Ms. Jacinta Bage, Assistant Director (Agri.), conducted a session on seed licensing and regulation, explaining the procedures for obtaining and renewing seed licenses, certification requirements, and the responsibilities of dealers to maintain seed quality. Shri Abdul Rasheed, Assistant Registrar of Cooperative Societies briefed the participants on the role of PACS in PM-KSK, emphasizing that PACS can serve as integrated Centres providing fertilizers, seeds, pesticides, soil testing, and scheme information to farmers. He highlighted how PACS can play a pivotal role in delivering input services to farmers through PM-KSK, thus strengthening the cooperative network and promoting farmer-centric service delivery.

Ministry of Health and Family Welfare issues advisory on rational use of cough syrups in children

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 7

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has issued an advisory to all States and Union Territories regarding the rational use of cough syrups in the paediatric population, emphasizing patient safety and responsible prescribing practices. The Healthcare Professionals and the general public have been advised to avoid unnecessary use of cough and cold preparations in young children.

As per the advisory, cough and cold

medications should not be prescribed or dispensed to children under 2 years. These are generally not recommended for ages below 5 years and above that, any use should follow careful clinical evaluation, with close supervision and strict adherence to appropriate dosing, the shortest effective duration and avoiding multiple drug combinations.

Most acute cough illnesses in children are self-limiting and often resolve without P h a r m a c o l o g i c a l

intervention. The public have been advised to adopt Non-pharmacological methods including adequate hydration, rest and other supportive measures as the first line of approach.

In addition, all healthcare facilities and clinical establishments have been instructed to ensure that only products manufactured under Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) and containing pharmaceutical-grade excipients are procured and dispensed, a press release from DHS said.

syrups across Government and private health facilities, as well as retail drug vendors. Inspection teams will be deployed to monitor compliance at Government-aided facilities, private clinics, and pharmacies to ensure that the sale and use of cough syrups strictly adhere to national health advisories.

The Deputy Commissioner directed all health facilities, private clinics, and pharmacy stakeholders to refrain from dispensing cough syrups to the general public without a valid doctor's prescription. Stakeholders were urged to maintain strict vigilance, ensure that only approved and safe formulations are used for paediatric patients, and submit periodic reports on inspections and compliance. In addition, community-level awareness campaigns will be conducted to educate the public for use of cough syrups in children with prior medical consultation only.

The meeting concluded with a call for collective responsibility among healthcare providers, pharmacists, and regulatory bodies to safeguard public health especially that of children through the rational use of medicines, a press release from DC (SA) said.

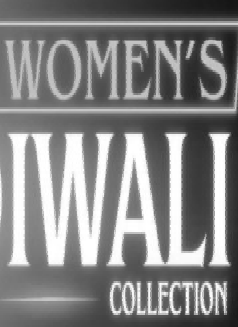

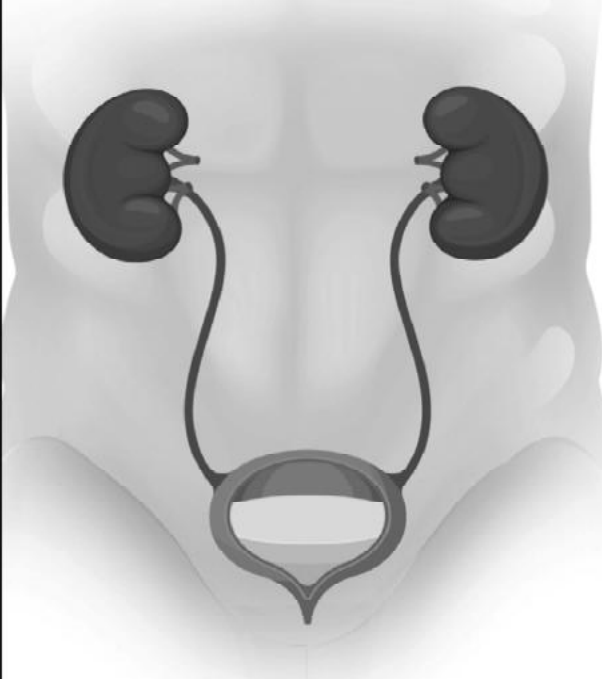

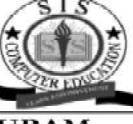
