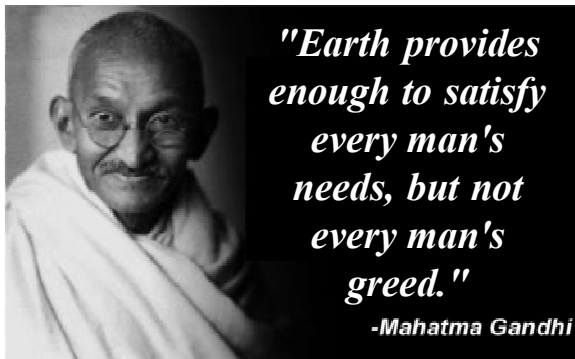

Andaman & Nicobar Group of Islands shortlisted in the online Common Entrance Examination (CEE) for Recruiting Year 2025-26, as Agniveer General Duty (All Arms), Agniveer Office Assistant / Store Keeper Technical (All Arms), Agniveer Technical (All Arms), Agniveer Tradesman 10th pass (All Arms), Agniveer Tradesman 8th pass (All

Arms), Sepoy Pharmacy, Soldier Technical Nursing Assistant/ Nursing Assistant (Veterinary) and Agniveer (General Duty) Women in Corps of Military Police.

To ensure maximum participation and ease of access, the rally will be conducted at Netaji Stadium, Sri Vijaya Puram from 08-10 October, 2025 for candidates from North & Middle Andaman and

South Andaman districts, and at the Mini Sports Stadium, Campbell Bay on 14 & 15 October, 2025, exclusively for aspirants of the Nicobar District. District Administration, SA restores Government Land & clears public path through eviction drives at Hobdypur and Wimberlygunj Villages



Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 30

In line with its commitment to removing unlawful occupations and facilitating public access to common resources, the District Administration, South Andaman today carried out eviction drives at Hobdypur and Wimberlygunj Tehsil.

At Hobdypur village, the Revenue team undertook the clearance of encroachments from the proposed public path area. Encroachers had attempted to occupy the land by planting arecanut trees on Government land.

During the operation, the unauthorized plantation was removed and an extent of 0.05

hectares of land was restored to the Government khata for its rightful use.

Further, at Wimberlygunj village, a long-standing issue of obstruction of a designated public path was resolved. The eviction team removed the encroachment that had blocked the pathway, thereby restoring free passage to the general public. The clearance of this obstruction marks the end of a persistent grievance faced by the villagers and reaffirms the District Administration's commitment to protecting public rights of way.

Hon'ble MP lays foundation stones for various works under PMGSY-III in Car Nicobar



Car Nicobar, Sept. 30

In a significant step towards improving road connectivity and infrastructure in Car Nicobar, the foundation stones for the works under PMGSY-III namely Up gradation of Road from SH-03 to Kinmai, Car Nicobar (Length - 2.250 km, Estimated Cost - Rs.2.63 Cr), SH-03 to Malacca via Japan Road Junction to JNV Junction Arong (Length - 14.014 Km, Estimated Cost - Rs.16.02 Cr), Kakana Junction to APWD Guest House Junction, SBI to SH-03 (Length - 7.146 Km,

Estimated Cost - Rs.8.27 Cr) were laid today by Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament in the presence of Shri Amit Kale, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District, and Shri T. K. Prijith Rekha, Chief Engineer, Andaman Public Works Department (APWD) at Kinmai, Malacca & Perka, Car Nicobar.

The ceremony was graced by the Chief Tribal Captain of Car Nicobar, Shri Lionel Nicomed alongside several respected tribal leaders and community



members marking the importance of the project for the Island's socio-economic development.

Speaking on the occasion, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament highlighted the Government's continued commitment of strengthening rural connectivity in remote Islands. 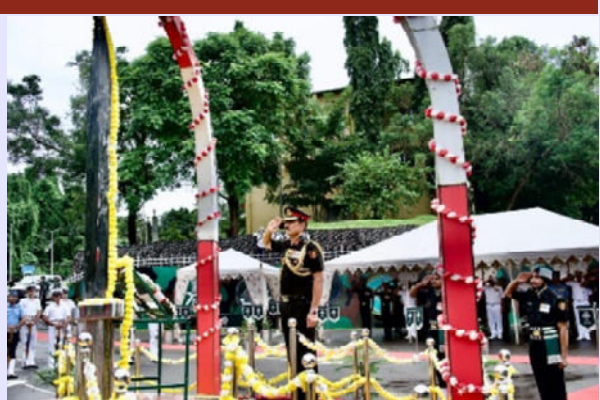
CINCAN hands over command of Andaman & Nicobar Command

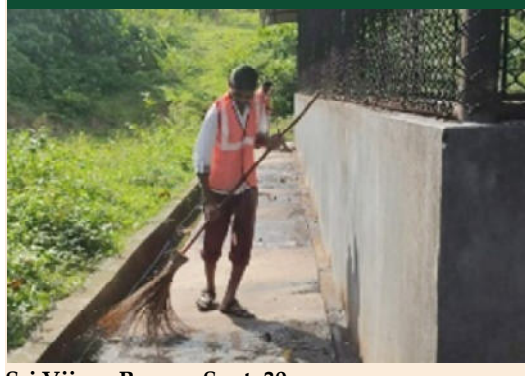

years-were actively pursued, and OTR Ports at Kamorta and Campbell Bay were declared Strategic Projects on 18th Sept., 2025 by the Department of Defence with approval of the Defence Secretary, enabling exemption from Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) and environmental clearances and paving the way for their timely execution. Justice delivered: Accused sentenced to 20 years rigorous imprisonment in POCSO case of PS Diglipur

Mayabunder, Sept. 30

The North & Middle Andaman District Police continue to demonstrate their steadfast commitment to justice, ensuring prompt and resolute action against perpetrators of sexual crimes. In a significant judgment pronounced on 25/09/2025, the Hon'ble Special Judge (POCSO), Sri Subhajit Basu, sentenced the accused Ajay Sarkar to 20 years of rigorous imprisonment and imposed a fine of Rs.50,000/- in connection with Crime No. 48/2020 of PS Diglipur under the POCSO Act, 2012.

This verdict stands as a testament to the diligent effort of the investigating officer Sub-Inspector Tamilarasan under the leadership of the then SHO Inspector Pritham Behari, PS Diglipur. Their unwavering pursuit of truth, professional acumen and relentless work were instrumental in securing justice for the victim.

The case pertains to an incident of sexual assault. Upon the victim's disclosure, a case U/S 5(j)(m)(n)/6 of the POCSO

Act, 2012 r.w.s 376/323 IPC was promptly registered at PS Diglipur, initiating swift and coordinated legal action against the accused.

This landmark judgement sends out a strong and clear message that crimes against children will be met with the harshest consequences. The Andaman & Nicobar Police maintain a strict zero-tolerance approach toward such grave offenses and remain firmly committed to protecting the rights and dignity of the most vulnerable members of society.

Nicobar Police commend the exceptional investigative work of the officers involved and reaffirm our dedication to upholding the rule of law, ensuring justice, and maintaining public trust in our system.

Deptt. of AH&VS performs Life-Saving Surgery on Cow in Guptapara

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 30

The Department of AH&VS conducted a life-saving surgical procedure on a 16-year-old cow owned by Shri Shyamal Mondal, a resident of Guptapara village, South Andaman yesterday. The cow, diagnosed with ruminal impaction due to ingestion of large quantities of foreign material, underwent a rumenotomy to address severe digestive obstruction.

The procedure was performed by Dr. Ninad S. Lawhale, Senior Veterinary Officer, Veterinary Dispensary Manglutan, assisted by Shri AbdulMajeed, Senior Veterinary Compounder, and veterinary



compounders Shri Pranab Deewan and Smti. P. Laxmi. During the surgery, approximately 3 kilograms of plastic and jute material were removed from the cow's rumen, enabling its stabilization and recovery. The on-site operation demonstrated the veterinary team's expertise in addressing critical health issues in resource-constrained

settings. The case highlights the growing concern of plastic ingestion by livestock, often caused by animals consuming waste while grazing in open fields. Shri Shyamal Mondal expressed gratitude to the veterinary team for their timely intervention and dedicated efforts in saving his cow's life, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

Mock Drill on Earthquake and Tsunami conducted at Hut Bay

Hutbay, Sept. 30

In line with the Chief Secretary's directive mandating mock drills across all Departments of the A&N Administration, a comprehensive mock drill simulating an earthquake followed by a tsunami was conducted at Hut Bay, Little Andaman today. The drill was conducted under the supervision of the Tehsildar, Little Andaman (Incident Commander), and was coordinated with various departments including Health, Fire Services, Revenue, Civil Supplies, CD Block, A&N Police, along with PRI members and participation of the general public.

Emergency protocols were activated at 9.15 AM, triggering a swift and coordinated response. The communication team



alerted the Emergency Operation Center (EOC) and concerned Departments. Fire tenders and ambulances arrived promptly, ensuring timely rescue and medical support.

Evacuation procedures were efficiently carried out, moving residents and staff to elevated safe zones using departmental vehicles. Search and rescue operations were executed in a timely and organized manner, with injured individuals (as per the simulated scenario) receiving immediate first aid from trained personnel. The drill highlighted strong inter-

departmental coordination, readiness, and adherence to disaster management protocols.

A debriefing session followed, where the Incident Commander and Block Development Officer reviewed the exercise, commending the proactive participation of all Departments. They emphasized areas needing improvement, particularly in resource availability and communication flow, and recommended updating emergency resources to enhance future preparedness, a press release from BDO Little Andaman said.

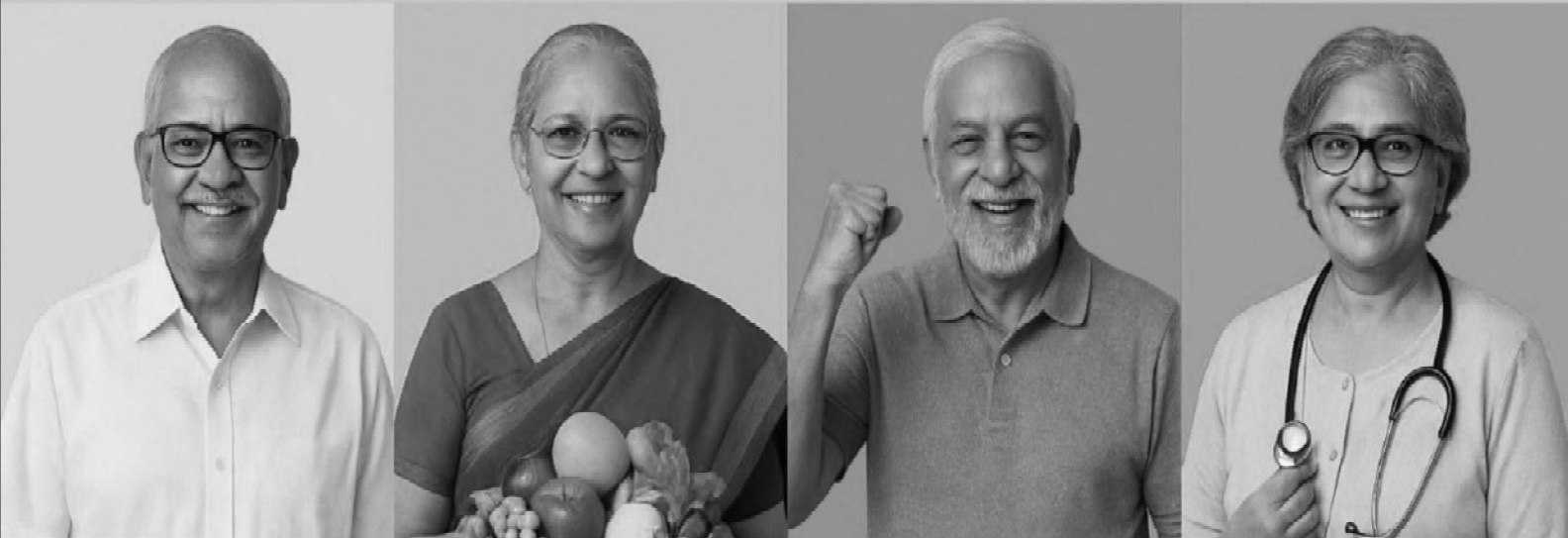

1. Only those Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. which possess valid licences, shall be allowed to function.
2. All such establishments shall have sufficient number of CCTV cameras which shall cover the entry and exit of persons and selected critical locations of the premises. All the cameras installed at all the entry and exit locations shall be in working condition and their coverage shall be preserved for not less than 30 days.
3. All such Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. shall maintain a Register-having complete details of persons staying in the said premise. A copy of the valid ID proof of such persons shall be kept for record.
4. All such Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. shall ensure that details relating to Form-C (Arrival Report of Foreigners in Hotel) are submitted to the Registering Authorities within the prescribed period. All procedures/guidelines shall be followed in respect of any Foreign National staying in the said premise.

This order shall come into force w.e.f zero hours of 01.10.25 and shall remain in force for a period of 60 days unless withdrawn earlier.

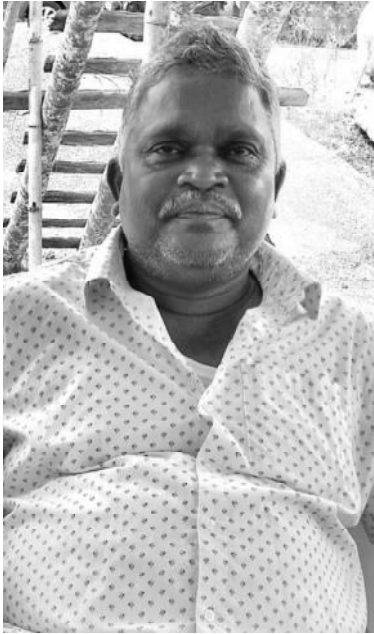

Now, therefore, I, Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by virtue of Section 163 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS)-2023, do hereby order as an emergency measure that no landlord/owner/manager of the residential/commercial etc establishment shall let/sublet/rent out any accommodation to any person unless and until he/she has furnished the particulars of the said tenant(s) or Paying Guest to the local Police Station concerned. Similarly, no landlord/owner/manager or the residential/commercial etc establishment shall employ any servants/house help/unless and until he/she has furnished the particulars of the said servants (s) to the local Police Station. All the persons who intent to offer accommodation on rent or employ any servant/house help shall inform in writing the particulars of tenants, paying Guests & Servants to the Station Officers concerned in whose jurisdiction the premises falls. Any breach of this order would invite action Under Section 208 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS)-2023.

In view of above the emergent nature of the order, it is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general.

This order shall come into force w.e.f zero hours of 01/10/2025 and shall be effective for a period of Sixty days and is applicable to those also who already have domestic servants/ maids and has not informed the Police yet when order is in force.
