

District Administration, SA maintains zero-tolerance approach to encroachments Conducts anti encroachment drive in Austinabad; reclaimed 4,000 Sq.mtrs of Govt. land Halts illegal construction activities at four sites in Swaraj Dweep

In a swift and decisive anti-encroachment operation, Revenue officials have reclaimed 4,000 square meters of Government land in Austinabad village. The crackdown resulted in the removal of five unauthorized encroachments, including one structure and four fenced areas, all illegally occupying Government property.

In a separate surprise inspection at Swaraj Dweep, Revenue Officials discovered illegal construction activities at four sites. The unauthorized developments were immediately halted, demonstrating the Administration's unwavering commitment to protecting public land and upholding the law.

The District Administration, South Andaman, has made it clear that such operations will



continue relentlessly across the region, targeting all illegal occupations. Citizens have been strongly urged to respect public land and adhere to regulations, as non-compliance will not be tolerated.

"The District Administration maintains a zero-tolerance approach to encroachments. We will uphold the rule of law and safeguard public property at all costs," stated the Deputy Commissioner,

DHS issues advisory on Monkey Pox

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 11
With the recent surge of Mpox (Monkey pox) Cases in India, we need to gear up our knowledge on prevention of the disease. Mpox is a zoonotic viral disease with symptoms similar to Smallpox, though less severe. Severe cases are more common in children and depend on factors such as virus exposure, patient health, and complications. It spreads through prolonged close contact with an infected person or direct contact with body fluids, lesion material, or contaminated items like clothing or linens, and also through respiratory routes.

Once the virus enters the human body, it shows symptoms in 6-13 days and even between 5-21 days also. Following the incubation period, the exposed person

starts getting symptoms such as fever, headaches, muscle pain, malaise, sore throat, chills, dry cough and swelling of lymph nodes in various parts of the body. Typical umbilicated skin rash develop over the body which develops in four stages of macular, popular, vesicular and pustular. The rash gets over by 2-4 weeks after shedding the scab on the skin. An infected person remains infective from 02 days before start of the symptoms and remains so till the last scab falls off/gets subsided.

To prevent the disease one should follow few steps such as:

- ◆ Avoid contact with materials (e.g., bedding, clothing) that have been in contact with infected individuals.
- ◆ Isolating infected patients from others.
- ◆ Practicing good hand hygiene, such as

washing hands with soap and water or using alcohol-based hand sanitizers, especially after contact with infected animals or humans.

- ◆ Using appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) when caring for patients.
- ◆ Properly containing and disposing of contaminated waste (e.g., dressings) under Biomedical Waste Management guidelines for infectious waste.

People have been requested to be vigilant. They have also been asked to avoid any misinformation and panic messages with regards to Mpox. If anyone finds a suspected case or contacts in their locality, they have been requested to inform 232102 with details for getting medical assistance, a press release from DHS said.

A&N Police issues Advisory on illegal Digital Lending Apps

A large number of complaints are being reported nationwide pertaining to illegal digital lending apps, which provide short term loans/ micro credits at exorbitant interest rates along with processing/hidden charges. These apps, which may not be Regulated Entities (RE) by RBI, target members of vulnerable and low income groups, and the borrowers are asked to provide mandatory access to confidential personal data like contacts, location, photos/videos, in order to avail the loans.

This personal data is then misused for blackmail and harassment. The illegal apps make use of bulk SMSs. Digital advertisements, chat messengers and mobile app stores, etc. on a mass scale. All citizens have been advised against the usage of these illegal lending apps, for availing loans. If anyone has been cheated, blackmailed or harassed as a result of using these apps, they have been advised to report the matter to the Cyber Cell, CID, Sri Vijaya Puram or the nearest Police Station of the area without delay, a press release from SP, CID said.

PS Billiground busts illicit liquor operation in Korang Nallah Jungle

Billiground, Oct.11
In a concerted effort to combat the illegal liquor trade, PS Billiground executed a successful jungle raid on Oct.5, 2024. Under the direction of Sub-Inspector Shiju Kumar, SHO PS Billiground, a dedicated team led by Head Constable Amrita Bawali, along with Police Constables Ashok Das, Anurud Das, Biplob Bachar, and Abhijeet Mondal, targeted the Korang Nallah jungle area. This location had been under surveillance due to ongoing suspicions of illicit activities.

During the search, the team uncovered and seized a significant array of equipment used for illegal distillation of liquor. The items confiscated include two distillation units (bhattis), 09 Nos. iron drums

containing 2,000 liters of lehan along with 2 Nos. half drums, and other related bhatti materials. Subsequently, the police team destroyed the seized lehan and other Bhatti materials on-site, ensuring that these materials could no longer be used for illegal activities. This swift action underscores the ongoing commitment of North & Middle Andaman District Police to curb the production and distribution of illicit liquor in the region.
