Encouraging response received for High-End Eco-Tourism Projects in A&N Islands

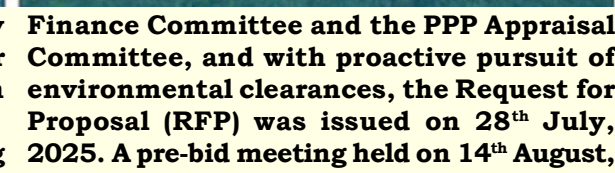
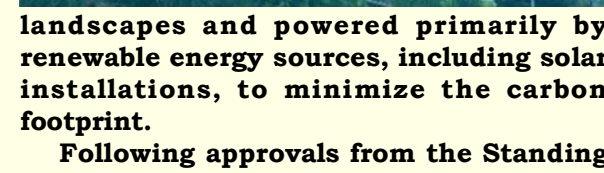
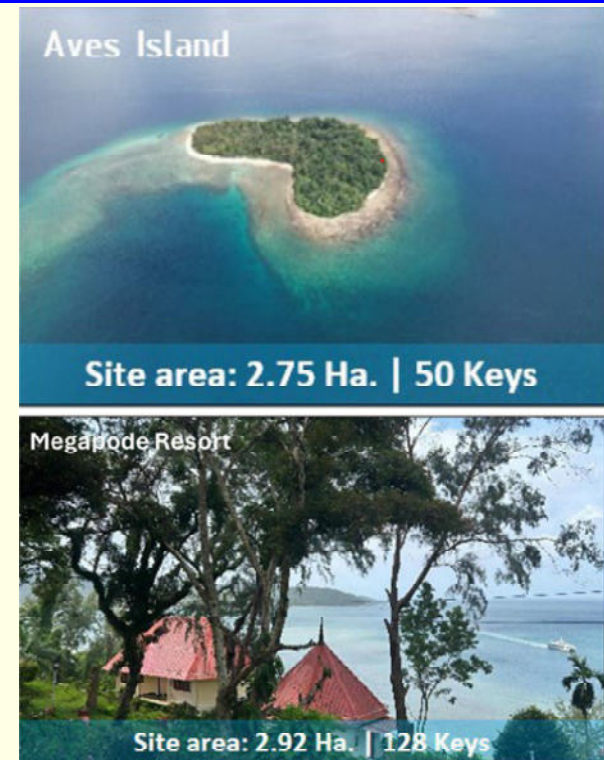
Projects to unlock significant economic value, boost high-end luxury tourism & generate local employment opportunities

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 13

The UT Administration of Andaman & Nicobar Islands has received an encouraging response from leading hospitality developers and investors for its ambitious high-end eco-tourism projects aimed at unlocking the Islands' immense tourism potential.

Five transformative projects, launched under the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model, cover Shaheed Dweep, Long Island, Smith Island, and Aves Island, along with the redevelopment of the iconic Megapode Resort located in the heart of Sri Vijaya Puram City. The initiative aligns with the Government of India's Holistic Development of Islands (HDI) framework and seeks to position the Andaman & Nicobar Islands as a premier global destination for sustainable, nature-led tourism.

Designed to promote eco-friendly and responsible tourism, the projects adhere to international sustainability standards such as LEED, GRIHA, and Green Globe certifications, and comply with Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) and environmental norms. Each development is conceived to be self-sustaining and low-impact, blending seamlessly with the Islands' natural



2025 witnessed participation from over 100 representatives of around 60 potential investors, reflecting strong market interest in the projects.

By the bid submission deadline of 6th October, 2025, the Administration received:

- Five bids for the Shaheed Dweep project
- Four bids for the Megapode Resort redevelopment
- Two bids for Aves Island
- One bid for Long Island

These bids are currently under technical evaluation, and the work will be awarded to the highest bidder after completion of both technical and financial evaluations. The Megapode Resort redevelopment is expected to be completed within three years, while the Island projects have an estimated four-year completion timeline.

The development of these resorts under the PPP model will unlock significant economic value, boost high-end luxury tourism, and generate substantial local employment opportunities, both direct and indirect - marking a major stride toward the sustainable and inclusive growth of the A&N Islands, a press release from ANIIDCO said.

District Administration, SA evicts massive encroachment on Govt. land at North Bay & Bambooflat



Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 13

As part of its ongoing efforts to safeguard Government land from unauthorized occupation, the District Administration, South Andaman, carried out an extensive eviction operation today at North Bay village and Bambooflat.

During the operation, a large-scale encroachment on Government land under the possession of the Andaman Public Works Department (APWD) situated at North Bay village was identified and successfully evicted. An area of measuring 500 sq. mtr. of Government land was cleared and subsequently handed over to the concerned officials of the APWD Department or its protection and future utilization.

In a similar anti-encroachment action, the Revenue Department with active support from the Police Department and field staff removed an unauthorized shed

structure erected on Government land near the Tsunami Shelter at Bambooflat, thereby restoring an area measuring 1000 square meters of Government land to its original condition.

The District Administration has reiterated its zero-tolerance policy towards encroachments on public land and has urged the

ANIIMS issues clarification on allotment of AIQ MBBS seats

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 13

In the recent past, concerns were raised on MBBS seats reserved under All India Quota, which often remain vacant after the counselling process. The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Sciences (ANIIMS) in a press release has clarified that as per the Notice No. U-12021/06/2021 dated 18.12.2021 issued by the office of ADG(ME), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Gol wherein, the Ministry has categorically stated that "no AIQ seats will be reverted back to the respective States after the completion of AIQ Round 2 counselling.

The release further stated that the Ministry has taken this decision based on an order from the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Nihila PP - Versus- The Medical Counselling Committee & Others. The Hon'ble Court directed that four rounds of online counselling be conducted for the All India Quota: AIQ round-I, AIQ Round-II, AIQ Mop-up, Round, and AIQ Stray Vacancy Round. The seats that were previously reverted to States after the Round-II now continue to be filled in the AIQ Mop-up-and Stray Vacancy rounds, which are conducted by the Medical Counselling

Committee. These rounds are for AIQ seats only, which include 15% of undergraduate i.e 17 seats out of the total 114 seats of ANIIMS.

Further, to set aside the concerns on the issue of vacant seats, ANIIMS has stated that after notification dated 18.12.2021 by the MoHFW, all the AIQ seats have been filled up and no MBBS seats remained vacant after the counselling process. ANIIMS has been taking all its efforts every year for filling up of MBBS seat in a fair and transparent manner following the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, the press release added.
