Employers with fewer than 50 employees must hire at least two new workers annually, while those with over 50 employees must hire at least five.

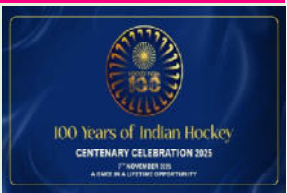
