Cabinet approves additional instalment of three percent DA to Central Govt. employees and DR to Pensioners

New Delhi, Oct. 16 (PIB)

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, has approved an additional instalment of Dearness Allowance (DA) to Central Government employees and Dearness Relief (DR) to pensioners w.e.f. 01.07.2024 representing an increase of three percent (3%) over the existing rate of 50% of the Basic Pay/Pension,

to compensate against price rise. This increase is in accordance with the accepted formula, which is based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission. The combined impact on the exchequer on account of both DA and DR would be Rs.9,448.35 crore per annum. This will benefit about 49.18 lakh Central Government employees and 64.89 lakh pensioners.

Two new projects inaugurated under MGNREGA

The Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), a demand-driven wage employment scheme, continues to play a pivotal role in providing employment opportunities and enhancing the livelihood of rural households across the country. MGNREGA guarantees 100 days of wage employment per financial year to each household in rural areas, focusing on unskilled manual labour.

Two recent initiatives under the MGNREGA

scheme have been taken up at CD Block Prothrapur under South Andaman District. One pertains to development of moringa plantations on the land of individual beneficiaries as per Category-B works of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) in the villages of Rangachang and Beodnabad under the Gram Panchayat Beodnabad on October 8, 2024. District Administration, N&MA conducts eviction drive at Rangat Tehsil; reclaims 6000 Sq.M. of Govt. Land

Mayabunder, Oct. 16

The District Administration of North & Middle Andaman carried out series of four eviction drives at Rangat Tehsil, successfully reclaiming 6000 square meters of Government land from unauthorized encroachment. The operation covered 1000 square meters at Santanu village and 5000 square meters at Rampur village, where encroached areas were being used for arecanut and banana plantations.

The eviction drive was conducted with active support from the local Revenue and Police Departments. The District Administration ensured the operation



proceeded smoothly, without disruption to public activities.

agreement reinforces India's commitment to integrating AYUSH systems into the global healthcare framework. Additionally, on August 1, India and Vietnam signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) focused on medicinal plants, while a landmark MoU with Malaysia on Ayurveda promotes research and the establishment of an Ayurveda Chair at Universiti Tunku Abdul Rahman. The Ministry launched the "One Herb, One Standard" initiative on August 6, 2024, aiming to standardize herbal medicines for enhanced safety and efficacy. Plans are also underway to open special medical stores for AYUSH medicines at every tehsil level, improving public access to traditional treatments. Furthermore, the National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Healthcare Providers (NABH) has completed evaluations of 1,489 Ayushman Arogya Mandir facilities, with 1,005 certified for Ayush Entry Level Certification, promoting high-quality healthcare under the National AYUSH Mission, said the Research Officer.

He further informed that the Ministry launched the "Har Ghar Ayur Yog" campaign, promoting Ayurveda and Yoga in communities, while successfully organizing 14,692 AYUSH camps for the elderly, exceeding its target. Six new Centers of Excellence have been established with Rs. 52.47 crore in funding, and Ayurvedic packages have been integrated into the Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) to enhance affordability. Additionally, three Central Research Institutes for Yoga and Naturopathy are in the preliminary stages of establishment, further strengthening research capabilities in traditional medicine. The Ministry's participation in the Swachhata Hi Sewa 2024 campaign highlights its commitment to cleanliness and community engagement.

Listing out the achievements made by the Regional Ayurveda Research Institute (RARI) in Sri Vijaya Puram, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, operating under the Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences, Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India and dedicated to enhancing the health and well-being of the tribal population, he said, RARI conducts comprehensive research initiatives and community outreach programs aimed at advancing Ayurvedic healthcare. Located in Chakkargao, the institute is committed to delivering effective Ayurvedic treatments free of cost to general and geriatric patients. RARI provides free Ayurvedic treatment and medicines through its regular Outpatient Department (OPD) and outreach programs, notably the Tribal Health Care Research Programme (THCRP). Since its inception in 1984, RARI has treated over 2,16,898 patients. The Institute has also conducted extensive health surveys, covering more than 1,37,000 individuals, and has initiated significant research projects, including a medico-botanical survey to explore native medicinal plants and studies assessing the effectiveness of Ayurveda in tribal communities. Currently, the Institute conducts research in the assessment of prevalence of metabolic syndrome in general public of South Andaman District and its relation to human prakriti. Additionally, the Institute is involved in the survey, healthcare and ayurvedic research among the tribal population in remote villages of Isles. Through collaborations, such as the recent MoU with ICAR-CIARI to standardize agro-techniques for medicinal plants, RARI is dedicated to enhancing Ayurvedic practices and community health outcomes, he said.

In addition to research and clinical services, RARI engages in various extension activities that benefit both the general and tribal populations of the Islands. These initiatives include distributing prophylactic Ayurvedic medicines, immunity-boosting kits, medicinal plants and conducting free Ayurvedic medical camps. The Institute also organizes awareness lectures and promotes traditional Ayurvedic food items, further fostering a holistic approach to health and wellness in the region, he added. Dr. Harjeet Singh, Research Officer (Pharmacognosy) and Dr. Akash Lal, Research Officer (Ayurveda) were also present on the occasion.

up to the terminal building braving scorching sun and rain.

The inauguration of the much needed facility of 'Golf Cart' was done by the Airport Director, VSI Airport, Shri Devendra Yadav and Director, Civil Aviation/Transport, Dr. Jatinder Sohal by flagging off the Golf Cart, marking the inauguration of the facility at Airport entry gate wherein the passengers who were on the maiden trip on this cart were received/greeted with rose flower petals.

As per airport regulations, auto rickshaws are not allowed to enter inside the airport premises, because of which, passengers coming to airport in auto rickshaws have to walk till the terminal building. To address this hardship, the Airports Authority of India and the Department of Civil Aviation, A&N Administration have collaborated and with a joint initiative came up with the solution of plying 'Golf Cart' between airport entry gate and terminal building.

Speaking on the occasion, Director, Civil Aviation said, the Andaman and Nicobar Administration is committed to providing support and facilitation in mobility and last mile connectivity to general public. He informed that in order to facilitate the airport bound passengers with better conveyance, bus service was introduced by the Transport Department for citizens connecting Jetty, Bus Terminus and Airport and other important areas, so that the public could reach inside the airport and travel to important points in the city with economical charge. Now, with the starting of Golf Carts, this facility will prove to be an initiative which will facilitate the public especially senior citizens, children or specially abled even in adverse weather conditions enabling them to reach to the departure gate of the New Terminal building from the entry gate of the VSI Airport.

In his brief address, the Airport Director stated that this initiative will bridge the major transportation gap in airport premises and improve the facilitation of the passengers at the airport. Airports Authority of India (AAI) is committed to continuous improvement and excellence of passenger facilitation. Guidance and support from the Andaman and Nicobar Administration is acting as a catalyst for quick turnaround. Andaman and Nicobar Administration and Airports Authority of India have collaborated on multiple fronts and some of the successful passenger facilitation outcomes are operations of Pre-paid taxi service at Airport, City Bus Service at Airport and AVSAR counter for selling products at Airport by Self Help Groups etc., the Airport Director added.

This Golf Cart service will be free of cost and passengers have to just display their same day airline journey ticket or boarding pass to avail this service. The service will be operational from 5.30 am to 3 pm and available for all the passengers travelling on that day on first come first serve basis.

Speaking to the media persons, tourists from Assam, Shri Dipankar Das & Narayan Das appreciated the initiative of the Andaman and Nicobar Administration and Airports Authority of India (AAI) for starting the conveyance facility which has provided a great relief. With the new facility in place, now the commuters need not walk up to the Departure entry gate of the terminal building with their luggage, they said.

Session on 'Challenges in Tejas (LCA) Flight Control Design, Development and Testing' held at DBRAIT

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 16

A technical talk was organised by Dr B.R Ambedkar Institute of Technology for the final year and pre-final year students of the Institute in its Conference Hall on 'Light Combat Aircraft-Tejas, flight control design, development and testing' yesterday. The session was conducted by Dr. Vijay V Patel, Technology Director (CLAW), an outstanding Scientist at A e r o n a u t i c a l Development Agency, Ministry of Defence, DRDO, Bengaluru.

Dr. Patel has more than 29 years of experience in working as a Member of National Control Law (CLAW) team for LCA flight control design and also contributed towards development of technology for autonomous take-off and landing for Ghatak, feasibility studies from flight mechanics parameter perspective for AMCA, Ghatak, LCAMK2, Navy Mk2 programs. He has



shared LCA CLAW Design Development experience with other national projects (LCH (HAL-RWRDC, RLV (ISRO), Chandrayan-3 (ISRO) various UAV projects of ADE, missile guidance with RCI and DRDL teams, integration of missile with Aircraft etc. and played major role in the technical reviews related to control systems.

He explained about the flight control law development cycle including parameter identification to update aero- database in order to expand flight envelope. The fundamentals of control law design for an

unstable fighter aircraft was also discussed and the mathematical challenges in order to achieve certain performance goals. He demonstrated various laws of physics practically and emphasised the students for keeping scientific temperament and critical thinking. The program was very informative and more than 150 students participated in this session which also featured a Q & A segment, which allowed students to ask questions including career opportunities in DRDO etc, a press release from DBRAIT said.
