

12 Govt. & 13 Private Hospitals registered under PC-PNDT Act in Isles

Act mandates display of signboard indicating 'Detection/revelation of sex of foetus is illegal' in all Ultrasonography Units

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 17

The Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulation and Prevention of Misuse) Act, 1994 (PNDT), as amended in 2003 to The Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act (PC & PNDT Act), is a law to curb the abhorrent practice of sex determination and sex selection.

Pre-natal diagnostic techniques like amniocentesis and ultrasonography have been used all over the world for the detection of genetic

A medical practitioner who contravenes any of the provisions of PC-PNDT Act may get imprisonment for a term that may extend to three years and with a fine that may extend up to Rs. 10,000 and on any subsequent conviction, he/she may get an imprisonment that may extend to five years and with a fine that may extend to Rs. 50,000.

abnormalities. However, in India, they are being misused for the past three decades for the detection of the sex of the unborn child and subsequently for sex-selection - that is to eliminate fetuses selectively, if they are female. 'The Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act' not

only prohibits determination and disclosure of the sex of the foetus but also bans advertisements related to pre-conception and pre-natal determination of sex.

Under the Act, it is mandatory in all Ultrasonography Units to display a signboard that clearly indicates that detection/revelation of the sex of the foetus is illegal. Further, all Ultrasound

scanning machines have to be registered and the manufacturers are required to furnish information about the clinics and practitioners to whom the Ultrasound machinery has been supplied. Any clinic having any type of imaging machine capable of performing prenatal sex determination shall register their facility with the appropriate

authority.

A medical practitioner who contravenes any of the provisions of this Act may get imprisonment for a term that may extend to three years and with a fine that may extend up to Rs. 10,000 and on any subsequent conviction, he/she may get an imprisonment that may extend to five years and with a fine that may extend to Rs. 50,000. The name of the medical practitioner would be reported to the State Medical Council by the Appropriate Authority for taking necessary action, including

about the importance of World Food Day.

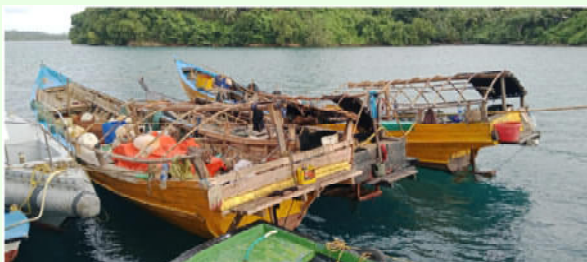

Anti-Poaching Operation conducted by Police in Kamorta Island; 1295 kgs of Sea Cucumber seized

Car Nicobar, Oct. 17

In a swift and effective response to credible information received from local fishermen on Oct.14, 2024 regarding the sighting of poachers in three dinghies off the coast between Vikash Nagar and Kakana, an anti-poaching operation was launched by police team, led by Sub-Inspector Calvin, SHO, PS Nancowrie, including HC YBK Murthy, PC Sunder Johnson, PC Paul Kristopher, PC S.M. Krishna, and PC Sartaz Khan with assistance from local fishermen.

Upon reaching the creek, the team found three suspicious dinghies believed to be belonging to Burmese poachers. The police party conducted a search of Burmese poachers in and around the seashore and jungle area, however, due to



poor weather conditions and a p p r o a c h i n g darkness, the Burmese poachers could not be apprehended. The inspection of the 3 dinghies revealed a significant haul of sea

The general public, especially the local fishermen have been requested to pass on any credible information about the presence of foreign/suspected persons to local police for immediate check of their credentials/apprehension. 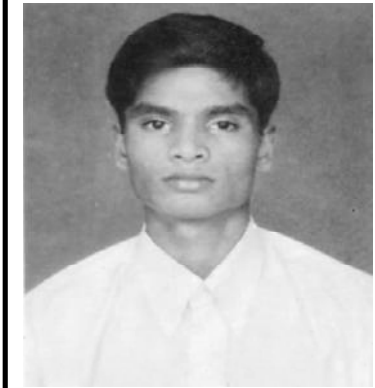
