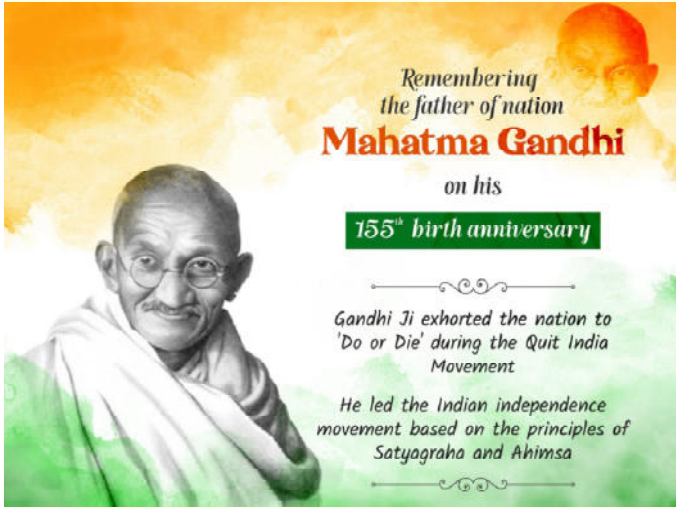

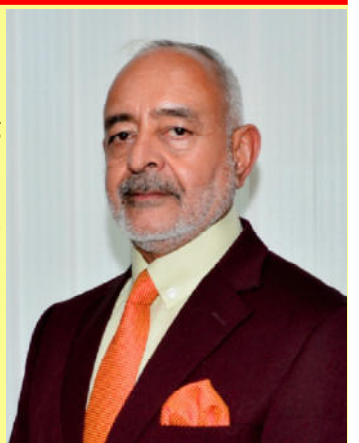
MESSAGE

Under the provisions of Rule 4.3 (a) 7 (a) to (e) of the Excise Policy & 9(iii) of the bar guidelines issued by the Administration vide order No. 4192 dated 18/11/2008 respectively, the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman District has ordered that Oct. 2,2024 shall be observed as 'Dry Day' in connection with 'Gandhi Jayanti'.

No liquor shops, hotels, restaurants, clubs and establishments selling/serving liquor

shall be permitted to sell/serve liquor to anyone whosoever on the aforesaid day. People have also been requested to keep themselves away from consuming any kind of spirituous and fermented liquor/wines or display the same for sale on the above date.

This order is applicable to IMFL vending licenses i.e. ANIIDCO, CSD Canteen, all Defence Canteen, Police Mess and all private bar licensees functioning at South Andaman District.

- > Minimum Certification required: Open Water Diver from any recognized WRSTC Training Agency.
- > Minimum logged dives required: 10 or more.
- > Participants need to submit the WRSTC Medical Form with a Doctor's 'Fit to dive' approval on page 3. (The WRSTC Medical Form and Physician's Guide document will be provided upon registration.)
- > Participants must be above 18 years of age.

Preference will be given to:

- > Certified divers with certifications higher than Open Water Diver and more than 10 logged dives.
- > Divers with their own equipment.
- > The A&N Administration will provide diving equipment as required by participants who do not have their own gear, except for Prescription masks, if needed.

Note: Divers needing Prescription Diving Masks must bring their own diving masks.

Selection process:

- > A panel of Dive Professionals and ANC will select the final participants. Selected participants will be informed through email about further processes.
- > Participants above the age of 50 years must provide a Medical Fitness certificate.

No person –
a) Who has entered info or contracted a marriage with a person, having a spouse living, or
b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:
Provided that the Lieutenant Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
5. POWER TO RELAX: -
Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of posts or persons.
6. SAVING:
Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
