

◆ AI in School Curriculum:

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 emphasises the inclusion of contemporary subjects like Artificial Intelligence (AI) in school curricula, at appropriate stages, to foster innovation and digital literacy among students. The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has already implemented AI as a subject in affiliated schools. #### **Provisions of Immigration & Foreigners** Act 2025 related to Form C & Form S and connected Rules Order/Notification

Sri Vijava Puram, Oct. 22

This is to bring to notice of general public, hoteliers and accommodation providers that the Immigration and Foreigners Act 2025 was passed by Parliament and the President of India gave assent on April 4, 2025. The Government of India has specified the 01st day of September 2025, as the date on which the provisions of the said Act shall come into force.

With regards to Form C now known as Form III provisions generated by any accommodation providers including Hotels, Guest Houses, Hospitals, Institutions and Form S now known as Form II provisions by Universities/Educational Institutions etc., the following provisions are applicable:

- Sections 8, 9, 10, 14, 23 and 25 of the Immigration and Foreigners Act
- Rule 16, 17, 18 & 21 of the Immigration Rules 2025.
- MHA Notification vide F. No 25022/11/2025-F.I dated 01.09.2025 regarding compounding of offences.

The following provisions are newly introduced:

- (i) Keeper of accommodation may file FORM-III (previously known as FORM-C) for all foreigners including Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Cardholders (previously exempted). This is applicable to -
- Boarding House, Club, Dak-Bungalow, Rest House, Hostel, Paying Guesthouse(Govt. & Private), Sarai, Rented Accommodation, Hotel, Lodges, Homestays, Bed & Breakfasts, Tents, Hospital or other premises of like Nature, Premises of Religious Institutions, Charitable Trusts, any other Trusts, Public Organisations or any other Organisations or entity of Social or Religious or of Public Nature, Furnished or Unfurnished.
- Hospital, Nursing Home or any other Medical Institution providing medical lodging or sleeping facility in the premises (for both patients and attendants).
- Every University and Educational Institution including school or any other institution Form II (previously known as Form S), Form-III (previously known as Form-C) for foreign students staying in Hostels. (ii) Every hospital, Nursing home or any other Medical institution shall furnish information in respect of any child born to foreigners (either or both the parents are foreigner) or death of any foreigner in their place within seven days of the occurrence of the birth or death, as the case may be.

(iii) In addition to submission of Form-III, every keeper of accommodation (Hotels, Guesthouses, Hospitals, Nursing homes etc.) shall require every foreigner, including an OCI Cardholder, seeking accommodation in his premises to furnish the necessary particulars for recording, and sign, on his arrival at the accommodation, and at the time of his departure, the date and time of his departure and the address to which he is proceeding, which shall be maintained by the keeper of accommodation electronically for a period of at least one year. (iv) Government of India has specified that, before initiating any

prosecution under the said Act or during trial, the FRRO may compound the offence with penalty as under: SI.No. Applicable to Section or offences of the Act


