Hon'ble MP reviews transportation services in N&M Andaman

Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, along with Shri Bishnu Pada Mondal, Panchayat Samiti Member (Urmilapur Constituency), and Shri Yaghambaram, Pradhan, GP Calicut, today met the Director, State Transport Service (STS) to review and discuss the enhancement of transportation services in North & Middle Andaman. During the discussion, the Director (STS) informed that by the end of January 2026, a total of 14 new buses will be added to the STS fleet. Out of these, 02 each will be allotted to Rangat, Mayabunder and Diglipur, and 01 bus to Baratang STS units to strengthen the public transportation network in these regions. The Director further informed that 73 Drivers and 96 Bus Conductors are being engaged through GeM, with payment of admissible wages as per the Minimum Wages Act. He also informed that 20 appointments to eligible persons under compassionate grounds have been provided against suitable posts, a step that has not been taken since many years, marking a significant administrative action by the Department. Regarding the request for a new bus route to Calicut, as raised by the Pradhan of Calicut, the Director assured that necessary arrangements will be made after reviewing the existing routes where STS buses are already operating in the area. Observing the prompt and positive response of the Director, Hon'ble MP appreciated the efforts of the STS Department for their commitment towards improving the transportation services across the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, a press release from the MP Office said.

Upon verification, it was established that the girl is a native of Purba Bardhaman and had arrived in the Islands accompanied by an accused individual.

District Administration (SA) conducts mass eviction drive & reclaims 2500 Sq. Mtr. of Govt. land at Attom Pahar, Garacharma

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 23

As part of the ongoing, large-scale encroachment clearance campaign, the District Administration, South Andaman, undertook a major anti-encroachment operation today at Attom Pahar, Garacharma village, successfully reclaiming a significant expanse of Government land that had been recently subjected to illegal occupation.

Upon inspection, it was discovered that portions of the area had been unlawfully appropriated, with makeshift fencing and temporary structures being raised in blatant violation of government land ownership. Acting with reports received from vigilant field functionaries, a dedicated team of revenue officials, supported by ground staff and earth-moving machinery was immediately mobilized to the site to dismantle and remove all unauthorized occupations.

The drive resulted in the removal of seven encroachments, including six fencing structures and one temporary shed, thereby restoring approximately 2,500 square meters of valuable government revenue land to its rightful and legal status under government possession.

In a parallel operation, Revenue officials also cleared an illegal obstruction, a temporary railing erected over government land at North Bay village. The clearance was executed in the presence of the Revenue
