Cabinet approves Terms of Reference of 8th Central Pay Commission

New Delhi, Oct. 28 (PIB)

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, today approved the Terms of Reference of 8th Central Pay Commission. The 8th Central Pay Commission will be a temporary body. The Commission will comprise of one Chairperson; One Member (Part Time) and one Member-Secretary. It will make its recommendations within 18 months of the date of its constitution. It may consider, if necessary, sending interim reports on any of the matters as and when the recommendations are finalized. While making the recommendations the Commission will keep in view the followings:

- ♦ The economic conditions in the country and the need for fiscal prudence;
- ♦ The need to ensure that adequate resources are available for developmental expenditure and welfare measures;
- ♦ The unfunded cost of non-contributory pension schemes;
- ♦ The likely impact of the recommendations on the finances of the State Governments which usually adopt the recommendations with some modifications; and
- ♦ The prevailing emolument structure, benefits and working conditions available to employees of Central Public Sector Undertakings and private sector.

Background:

The Central Pay Commissions are periodically constituted to go into various issues of emoluments structure, retirement benefits and other service conditions of Central Government employees and to make recommendations on the changes required thereon. Usually, the recommendations of the pay commissions are implemented after a gap of every ten years. Going by this trend, the effect of the 8th Central Pay Commission recommendations would normally be expected from 01.01.2026.

The Government had announced formation of the 8th Central Pay Commission in January, 2025 to examine and recommend changes in the Salaries and other benefits of Central Government employees.

District Administration (SA) clears roadside encroachments at Sri Vijaya Puram; public access restored

Pursuing its zero-tolerance policy towards land encroachments, the District Administration, South Andaman, carried out a major eviction drive at Sri Vijaya Puram to clear unauthorized occupations on Government Revenue land along the roadside area.

Continuing its sustained efforts to remove encroachments from public land, a team from the Revenue Department, in coordination with the Police Department and with active support from municipal labourers carried out an eviction drive near JNRM College. During the operation, 11 unauthorized structures, including ghumtis, makeshift stalls, and temporary shops that had been operating without valid permission on Government Revenue land were removed. The drive was executed in a well-coordinated manner, ensuring the process was carried out peacefully and efficiently under adequate police protection.

The eviction covered the entire stretch from Flag Point to Girls' School, Sri Vijaya Puram, where several temporary commercial setups had been obstructing

Marine Fisheries Census 2025 by Fishery Survey of India commences in A&N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 28

The Marine Fisheries Census 2025 is being carried out across the country under the overall coordination of the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India, to generate comprehensive data on the marine fisheries sector, including details on fisher folk population, fishing craft and gear, infrastructure facilities, and socio-economic conditions of marine fishing communities.

The census operation in the Union Territories, including the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, is being undertaken by the Fishery Survey of India (FSI).

In the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the Marine Fisheries Census 2025 is scheduled to be conducted from 3rd November to 18th December 2025 in close coordination with the Directorate of Fisheries, A&N Administration. Enumerators have been specially trained to collect accurate data from all marine fishing villages, landing centres, and individual fisher households across the islands. The data generated



from this nationwide census will serve as a vital input for fisheries development planning, infrastructure creation, livelihood support, and sustainable resource management in the marine fisheries sector.

The inaugural function of the enumerators' training programme for the Andaman & Nicobar Islands was held today, with Ms. Jagtap Kalyani Rajendra, Director of Fisheries, A&N Administration, gracing the occasion as chief guest and distributing the Tabs to the Field Level Coordinators (FLC) and releasing the Marine Fisheries Census 2025 Pamphlets.

Earlier, Dr. C. Babu, Fisheries Scientist welcomed the participants and Shri. Bala Nayak, Mechanical Marine Engineer delivered presidential address and Shri. Kastub Bargode, Senior Scientific Assistant

delivered vote of Thanks. Later, Dr.C.Babu gave hands on training on the VyAS Bharath app developed for the enumerators. The Dy. Director of Fisheries, Nicobar District, Asst Director of Fisheries, South Andaman District and Fishery Officials, Sagar Mitras and Enumerators from the South Andaman District attended the training physically, while those from North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar Districts participated virtually. The Fishery Survey of India appeals to all fishers and stakeholders to extend their full cooperation to the enumerators during the Marine Fisheries Census 2025 to ensure the successful completion of this important national exercise, a press release from Fisheries Department said.

TB Clinics organized across Nicobar District as part of TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan 2025

Car Nicobar, Oct. 28

As part of the TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan 2025 for Nicobar District, under the National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP), several TB Clinics were organized across the district on Oct. 24. A TB Clinic was conducted at BJR Hospital, Car Nicobar, along with AAM Mus, AAM Big Lapathy, Sub Centre Small Lapathy, Sub Centre Tapoiming/Chuckchucha.

During the clinic, all TB patients were examined by the Doctors for weight, treatment adherence, and side effects, and were advised to maintain a protein-rich diet and good personal hygiene. All patients were found to be taking their medicines regularly and showing satisfactory progress.

Similar TB Clinics

were also held at PHC Teresa, PHC Katchal, and CHC Nancowrie. At PHC Teresa, the Medical Officer interacted with TB patients and reviewed their treatment progress, weight, and general health condition. At PHC Katchal, the Medical Officer examined patients for treatment adherence, weight, and side effects, and provided counseling on maintaining a balanced diet and healthy hygiene practices. At CHC Nancowrie, the Medical Officer examined all TB patients for adverse drug reactions and overall health status, emphasizing the importance of a nutritious diet, clean environment, and personal hygiene for faster recovery.

At PHC Campbell Bay, a TB Clinic was conducted by the Medical Officer.

All TB patients were examined for weight, adherence, and side effects, and were counseled to follow a healthy diet, maintain proper hygiene, and strictly adhere to their treatment schedule. All patients were found to be compliant with their medication and responding well to treatment.

These coordinated TB Clinics reflect the strong commitment of the District Administration, Nicobar, towards achieving the goal of a TB-Free Nicobar District under the TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan 2025, through regular patient follow-up, effective counseling, and continuous awareness activities conducted under the National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP), a press release from NTEP, Car Nicobar said.

Note: Except for the EF, no other document needs to be collected during the Enumeration Phase.

Electors are required to fill the Enumeration Form (EF) and hand it over to the BLO. Alternatively, electors can submit the form online through the Election Commission portal at <https://voters.eci.gov.in>.

The guiding principle of the SIR is to ensure that no eligible citizen is left out and no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll.

To meet the growing demand for poultry ducklings among farmers, the Department of AH&VS has distributed 1300 Nos. of Vigova Ducklings on 27.10.2025 through its institutions across South Andaman. The distribution was carried by departmental institutions including Veterinary Hospital, Wimberlygunj, Veterinary Dispensaries at Port Mout, Manglutan; Veterinary Hospital, Garacharma & Central Hatchery, Livestock Farm Complex, Dollygunj.
