Two local residents of Nicobar Island arrested for supporting Myanmar Poachers with logistical aid General public urged not to interact or provide any assistance to foreign poachers

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 19

In a significant anti-poaching operation, the Anti-Poaching Team of Police Station Teresa had successfully apprehended eight Myanmar poachers near Bambooka Island on 17th August, 2024. The poachers were subsequently booked under the Foreigners Act, 1946, and the case is being investigated by PS Crime and Economic Offence. During sustained interrogation, the Myanmar poachers revealed that some local residents of

General public advised to immediately report any sighting of foreign intruders or poachers, whether at sea or on land, to the nearest Police Station, the Police Control Room at 03192-232100, or to the Coast Guard authorities

Bambooka Island, under the jurisdiction of Police Station Teresa, had met them and provided various logistical support. In return, the poachers had given these residents certain gratifications for their assistance.

As part of the ongoing investigation,

several articles provided by the Myanmar poachers have been recovered from two local residents, identified as Robinson Vinod, S/o Cephas, 33 yrs, R/o Bambooka, Teresa & Ronald, S/o Inicoinylo, 37 yrs, R/o Bambooka, Teresa by a Police team comprising

of Sub-Inspector Parvash, Constable Amos George, and Constable Amit Singh. As a result, these individuals have been arrested, and investigation is actively progressing to uncover further details and connections in this case.

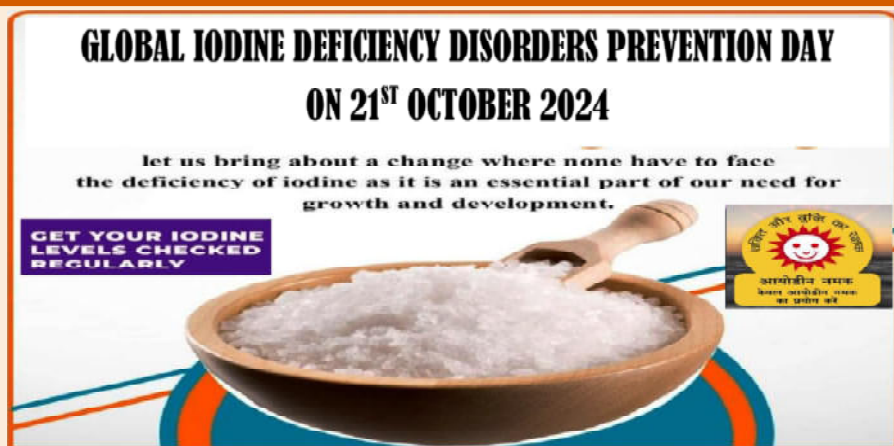

National Iodine Deficiency Disorders Control Programme Day to be observed in Isles on Oct.21

National Iodine Deficiency Disorders Control Programme (NIDDCP) Day will be held on 21st October, 2024, by the Directorate of Health Services in association with Union Territory Health Mission with the aim to ensure zero mental and physical retardation, deaf & mutism, cretinism, still births, abortion etc., due to lack of Iodine.

Iodine is an essential micronutrient required daily at 100-150 micrograms for normal human growth and development. To achieve the last mile of iodized salt coverage, concerted efforts need to be made by



developing contextual and targeted strategies at the sub-national level. A deep dive into India Iodine Survey 2018-19 by Nutrition International reveals that the progress in household coverage of adequately iodized salt has plateaued at 76%. It is an excellent example of 'Made-in-

India and Made-for-India' national health program model, acclaimed as a global public health success story. Indian scientific institutions, Government and industry collaborated and complemented in shaping the program and ensuring its success. Iodine nutrition

is essential to protect the population from iodine deficiency disorders. For ages, salt has been the perfect staple as the source of Iodine in our diet. It is especially critical during the first 1000 days of a child for their brain development. Hence, it is important for the

Seven apprehended with seizure of Rs. 83,400 cash
