Empowering Entrepreneurship through PMEGP Scheme

Scheme offers bank-financed loans up to Rs.50 lakhs for manufacturing & Rs.25 lakhs for service/trading/ business units with substantial Govt. subsidy

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 7
The District Industries Centre, Department of Industries is the implementing agency of Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) in Municipal areas, Shaheed and Swaraj Dweep in Andaman District and Nancowrie Group of Islands in Nicobar District. The Government of India has been implementing Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) since 2008 with the objectives to generate employment opportunities in rural as well as urban areas through setting up of new self-employment ventures / projects / micro enterprises. Besides, the objective is also to bring together widely dispersed traditional artisans/rural and urban unemployed youth and give them self-employment opportunities to the extent possible, at their place.

The scheme offers bank-financed loans up to Rs.50 lakhs for manufacturing and Rs.25 lakhs for service/trading/business units with a substantial Government subsidy. Applicants must be at least 18 years old, and for projects above Rs.10 lakhs (manufacturing) or Rs.5 lakhs (services/trading/business), a minimum educational qualification of 8th standard pass is required. The self-contribution and subsidy percentages under the PMEGP scheme are as follows:

Category	Urban Area	Rural Area
General Category	10% Contribution, 15% Subsidy	10% Contribution, 25% Subsidy
Special Category (SC/ST/OBC/Women/Minorities/ Ex-Servicemen/PWD, etc.)	5% Contribution, 25% Subsidy	5% Contribution, 35% Subsidy

The prospective entrepreneurs and the beneficiaries whose loan has already been sanctioned by the Banks can undergo EDP training. The duration of the training would be for at least 5 days for projects with project cost up to Rs.5 lakh and for project with cost above Rs.5 lakh, the duration of EDP would be at least 10 days. No EDP training will be mandatory for projects up to Rs. 2 Lakh. Aspiring entrepreneurs, especially youth, women, and individuals from marginalized communities are encouraged to take



advantage of this opportunity and apply for financial assistance under the PMEGP scheme. Interested applicants may visit the implementing agencies DIC/KVIB along with necessary documents such as Aadhaar Card, passport size photo, Aadhaar linked phone numbers, e-mail ID, Local/Rural Certificate, PAN Card, OBC Certificate, Special category Certificate etc and submit their online loan applications under PMEGP scheme at www.kviconline.gov.in. The implementing

agencies DIC/KVIB provides full support to applicants throughout the process-from preparation of the project report and submission of the online application in coordination with banks for loan sanction and subsidy

Government land measuring 5,000 square meters reclaimed by District Administration (SA) at Garacharma village

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 7
As part of the District Administration's ongoing efforts to safeguard Government land and ensure its proper utilization, an encroachment drive was conducted yesterday at Atom Pahar, Garacharma Village.

During the operation, the revenue team identified encroachments spread across approximately 5,000 square metres of prime Government land recorded under Government khata. The encroachments in the form of 08 temporary residential structures along with multiple unauthorized fencing, had been illegally erected over the land. To ensure the smooth execution of the drive, heavy machinery, including a Hitachi excavator, was deployed for the demolition and clearance activities. The encroached structures were systematically dismantled, and the area was cleared of all



unauthorized occupations. The encroached area was promptly restored to its original status, reaffirming the Administration's commitment to protecting public land and preventing unauthorized occupation. The District Administration reiterates its firm commitment to act against illegal encroachments and appeals to the general public to refrain from occupying Government land without proper authorization. Citizens have been encouraged to cooperate with the District Administration in preserving public resources and maintaining the rule of law. The District Administration, South Andaman reiterates that such operations will continue unabated in all areas where illegal occupation is identified. ANCCI hails decision to rationalize GST slabs

The decision of the GST Council to reduce the GST rate on cement from 28% to 18% will


