Vice Presidential Election to be held today

New Delhi, Sept. 8

The elections for the post of Vice President will be held tomorrow (Sept. 9). NDA nominee and Maharashtra Governor, Shri C P Radhakrishnan will face the INDIA bloc's nominee and former Supreme Court Judge, Shri B Sudershan Reddy in the election.

The Vice President is elected by an electoral college consisting of members of both Houses of Parliament. Vice President is elected by the system of proportional representation



by means of the single transferable vote, and the voting at such an election is held by a secret ballot.

Presently, the Lok Sabha has 542 Members and the Rajya Sabha has 239 Members. The electorate for the Vice-Presidential election this time is 781, and the majority mark at 391. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

Skywatchers across the Islands witnessed a stunning event last night, a total lunar eclipse, also known as 'Chandra Grahana'. Total Lunar Eclipse is a rare and spectacular celestial event which is also known as 'Blood Moon'. It is caused when the sunlight first travel to earth's atmosphere which scatters short wavelength of blue light and allow longer red



wavelength to pass and reach to the moon giving it a beautiful crimson colour. The event was

marked with great enthusiasm and curiosity among students and sky lovers.

Special arrangements were made by Science Centre for telescope viewing, allowing students and general visitors to witness the eclipse closely and appreciate the beauty of the Moon as it passed through Earth's shadow. India beat Korea 4-1 to lift Asia Cup Hockey title; Also qualify for next year's FIH World Cup

Patna, Sept. 8

In the Men's Asia Cup Hockey Championship, India won their fourth title by a convincing 4-1 win over South Korea in an exciting final at Rajgir Hockey Stadium in Bihar. With this win, India has ended the eight-year-long wait to regain supremacy on the continent. India has also qualified for the FIH Men's Hockey World Cup 2026 in the Netherlands and Belgium. India opened the scoring sheet in the first minute itself when Sukhjeet scored from the left flank with a reverse hit into the far post to give the hosts an early lead.

The hosts found their second goal in the 28th minute, a little before the end of the first half, when Dilpreet scored a brilliant shot despite being in pressure from the defenders. Dilpreet struck again in the 45th minute after a well-coordinated move involving captain Harmanpreet Singh and Rajinder. With the game looking done and dusted, India sprung a surprise with a penalty corner in the 50th minute as first-rusher Amit Rohidas took the drag flick and took India 4-0 up. South Korea made a late strike to get some solace from the match when Son Dain converted a penalty corner. However, it was too little, too late, as India had already sealed the game with an unassailable lead. Meanwhile, Hockey India has announced 3 lakh rupees each to players. The support staff members will also receive 1.5 lakh rupees each.

Next-Gen GST Overhaul: Staple Foods Tax-Free, Processed Foods at 5% - Big Relief for Consumers and Small Businesses

New Delhi, Sept. 8 (PIB)

The GST Council in its 56th meeting on 3rd September, 2025 made the recommendations relating to changes in GST tax rates; provide relief to individuals, common man, aspirational middle class and measures for facilitation of trade in GST. The reduced GST rates will be effective from 22nd September, 2025.

The major processed food products on which GST rates have been reduced is placed at Annexure I.

Benefits of the GST rate rationalization:

- ⇒ Simplified tax structure
- ⇒ Reduced prices for almost all food products thus promoting ease of living.
- ⇒ Lower prices will boost demand for food products, expansion of investment, employment generation.
- ⇒ Support for Manufacturing: Correcting inverted duty structures boosts domestic value addition and exports.
- ⇒ Better revenue generation in the sector through broader base and better compliance.
- ⇒ Resolving Classification Issues - Similar goods and services will be placed in the same rate slab, reducing disputes and lowering litigations costs.

Analysis:

In a historic move to simplify the Goods and Services Tax(GST), GST Council in its 56th meeting has reduced the GST structure from four slabs (5%, 12%, 18%, 28%) to two main rates-5% (merit rate) and 18% (standard rate) along with a 40% special rate for sin/luxury goods. These changes come into effect from September 22, 2025.

The food-processing sector has been a major beneficiary in this rationalization of tax rates with most products witnessing a decline to 5% GST slab.

This rationalization of GST to lower levels provides a variety of stimulants to the sector and encourage a virtuous cycle of economic growth through following:

Simplified tax structure: The simplified tax structure brings uniformity across food items with reduced number of tax slabs. A stable tax environment will help businesses plan long-term investments, encourage compliance, and drive economic growth.

Reduced prices: The consumers shall witness overall reduced food prices, making staples more affordable. This in turn stimulates consumer demands, FMCG and packaged food businesses
