Hon'ble Prime Minister reviews security situation & defence preparedness during Combined Commanders' Conference 2025 in Kolkata

Hon'ble PM emphasises on Jointness, Aatmanirbharta & Innovation for enhanced operational readiness of the Armed Forces

New Delhi, Sept. 15 (PIB)

Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi reviewed the security situation and the operational preparedness of the Armed Forces during the 16th Combined Commanders' Conference (CCC) in Kolkata, West Bengal today. The Hon'ble Prime Minister was briefed on the operational readiness in the context of the new normal created by Operation Sindoor, and the future of warfare amidst the emerging technology and tactics. He also reviewed the reforms implemented in the last two years, and the plan for the next two years.

Hon'ble Prime Minister complimented the Armed Forces for the success of



Operation Sindoor and their integral role in nation building, anti-piracy, safe return of Indian citizens from conflict zones as well as providing Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief to friendly countries. In line with 2025 being the 'Year of Reforms' in defence, he instructed the Ministry of Defence to swiftly implement concrete steps to

achieve greater Jointness, Aatmanirbharta and Innovation to meet future challenges and prevail against any eventuality.

Hon'ble Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh was present during the meeting, along with National Security Advisor, Shri Ajit Doval, Raksha Rajya Mantri, Shri

concern over the suspension of electricity supply to the Modern Fish Market. In addition, the matter regarding the construction of the newly proposed Fish Market at Dignabad was also discussed. The

Hon'ble MP emphasized the need for early execution of this project to enhance livelihood facilities for the fishermen community in the locality, a press release from MP Office said.

Electricity Department successfully revives 2.5 MW of generation capacity at Bambooflat Power Plant; installation of 3 MW additional DG sets in progress

Installation of 10 MW + 5 MW capacity plants progressing at steady pace; expected to be completed by end of November 2025

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 15

The Electricity Department, A&N Administration has informed the general public and valued electricity consumers that 2.5 MW of generation capacity has been successfully revived and added to the grid of Sri Vijaya Puram on Sept. 14, 2025. This has been achieved through the revival of two Diesel Generator units (1X1500 KVA + 1X2250 KVA) in the existing 10 MW private power plant at Bambooflat following extensive repair and restoration efforts and successful test run. With this addition, the available power capacity has increased from 33 MW to 35.5 MW during evening peak hours thereby providing relief to some extent to the consumers.

Further, steps are underway for the

installation of 3 MW additional DG sets in the same power plant at Bambooflat which is expected to be commissioned by the end of this month and will enhance the overall power availability to about 38.5 MW. This will help in addressing the ongoing power scarcity to some extent.

Additionally, the new Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) of 10 MW + 5 MW capacity recently approved by the Joint Electricity Regulatory Commission (JERC) have already been executed with the firms. The installation and commissioning work of these plants is progressing at a steady pace and is expected to be completed by end of November 2025 as per the stipulated gestation period. These augmentations in generation capacity in Sri Vijaya Puram will ensure adequate availability of

power in the grid to meet the present power requirement of Sri Vijaya Puram and adjoining areas of South Andaman.

The Electricity Department is making all possible efforts to meet the present power paucity through deployment of DG sets and other measures but the consumers are also earnestly requested to come forward for installation of Rooftop Solar (RTS) systems in their premises under PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana (PM-SGB-MBY). This initiative not only ensures self-resilience and energy security for households and establishments but also enables consumers to avail Central and UT subsidies. Active participation in this scheme will significantly contribute towards de-dieselization by reducing

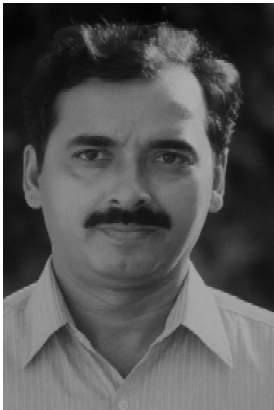

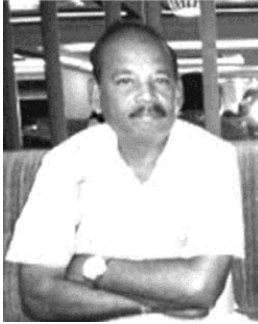
