1st Anniversary celebration of PM Vishwakarma Scheme to be held at Wardha, Maharashtra today

UT Administration to organize a function at Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Auditorium, Dollygunj

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 19

The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), GoI will be celebrating the 1st Anniversary of PM Vishwakarma Scheme tomorrow (Sept.20). The PM Vishwakarma scheme was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on 17th September, 2023 and the scheme aims at upskilling the Vishwakarmas with the knowledge of modern tools and techniques coupled with credit support for expanding their business with the objective of bringing सम्मान, सम्पन्न और समृद्धि to the Vishwakarmas. As on 12th September, 2024, under the Basic Skill Training Component, a total of 8,30,678 Vishwakarmas have been trained under the scheme.

As part of the celebration, a mega event



has been planned at Wardha, Maharashtra tomorrow (Sept. 20) which will be graced by the Hon'ble Prime Minister,

Shri Narendra Modi. A total of 500 Centres have been shortlisted on pan India basis where the event at Wardha will be live telecast.

The UT Administration of Andaman & Nicobar Islands will also join in the celebration at a programme to be organized at Dr. B.R.Ambedkar Auditorium, Dollygunj, Sri Vijaya Puram on Sept. 20, 2024 from 11 am onwards. Shri Narendra Modi ji, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India will virtually (through Video Conferencing) attend the mega event.

Guidelines issued by CPCB for disposal of Thermoset plastics including SMC/FRP

Concerned authorities & general public advised to comply with the directions

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 19

Thermoset plastic are family of plastics comprising of Epoxy resins, unsaturated polyester resins, phenolic resins, unsaturated polyester resins, melamine-formaldehyde resin and polyamides. The SMC/FRP products are a kind of thermoset plastics commonly made from composites of glass fibers embedded in polyester resin, vinyl ester resin, epoxy resins etc. Once cured by heat or other methods, thermosets become infusible and insoluble, making them non-re-mouldable and non-recyclable due to their permanent

chemical structure.

As per the directions issued by Hon'ble NGT in its order dated 27.01.2015 in O.A.No.124/2014 in the matter of Money Goyal & Akash Seth Vs. Ministry of Environment & Forests and Ors.CPCB has duly notified the guidelines on 25.05.2016 for disposal of thermoset plastic waste including Sheet Molding Compound (SMC) and Fibre Reinforced Polymer (FRP) which is available in the link <https://cpcb.nic.in/displaypdf.php?id=cGxhc3RpeY3dhc3RlL1RoZSxjb3NldF9HdWlkZWxpbnVzLnBkZg>

Further, the following Plastic Waste Management Rules are reiterated to ensure compliance in the management of thermoset plastics:

I. Rule 5(c), Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016"Thermoset plastic waste shall be processed and disposed of as per the guidelines issued from time to time by the Central Pollution Control Board."

II. Rule 8 (1) (a), Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 "The waste generator shall take steps to minimize generation of plastic waste and segregate plastic waste at source in accordance with the

Ayushman Pakhwada to be celebrated from Sept. 20 to 30

25,254 families (72,447 members) registered under AB-PMJAY Scheme in Isles as on date

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 19

Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) and Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM), the flagship schemes under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI was launched on 23rd September, 2018 and 27th September, 2021 respectively.

This September will mark 6 years of AB-PMJAY and 3 years of ABDM. Since their launch, these schemes have won crores of hearts, lit lamps of happiness in crores of homes and saved out-of-pocket health expenditure for crores of households

becoming the lifesaver for beneficiaries.

To commemorate the journey of AB-PMJAY and ABDM, Ayushman Pakhwada will be celebrated from 20th to 30th September, 2024 throughout the nation. This will include activities to create awareness and educate the people of these Islands about the scheme and benefits attached with it.

AB-PMJAY scheme was launched with an aim to provide cashless treatment worth Rs. 5 lakh per family per year against secondary and tertiary hospitalization care. At present, 25,254 families (72,447 members) have

registered under the AB-PMJAY scheme in this UT and are entitled for cashless treatment of Rs. 5 lakh. Till date, around 2,000 beneficiaries have been referred under the AB-PMJAY Scheme to empanelled hospitals at mainland from this UT.

Likewise, Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) was launched with an objective to create a national digital health ecosystem that supports universal health coverage in an efficient, accessible and secure manner.

The Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) card

generated under ABDM will help the patient to securely store and access their medical records (such as prescriptions, diagnostic reports and discharge summaries), and share them with health care providers to ensure appropriate treatment and follow-up. Currently, 4,43,065 ABHA have been generated in this UT.

The ABHA card uniquely identify person, authenticating them and threading their health records (only with the consent of the patient) across multiple systems and stakeholders, a press release from Nodal Officer, AB-PMJAY said.

District Administration conducts eviction drive at School Line & Chouldari

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 19

In a decisive move to protect public assets and ensure the safety of public spaces, the District Administration of South Andaman successfully carried out an eviction drive in School Line and Chouldari Village.

During the operation, the Revenue Officials dismantled an RCC (Reinforced Cement Concrete) structure that was in the initial stages of construction at Survey No. 200/P at School Line village and an area of 300 sq.mtr was restored in Sri Vijaya Puram Tehsil.

In a similar effort, an eviction drive was carried out in Chouldari village, in response to unauthorized construction on Government land. The Revenue Officials acted to address the situation where an unknown individual had laid the foundation for a structure in Survey No. 329, resulting in the eviction of 200 square meters of land from encroachers in Ferrargunj Tehsil.

This decisive action reflects the District Administration's commitment to defending public property and ensuring its appropriate use. By reclaiming these essential public spaces, the Administration sends a clear and



unequivocal message that illegal encroachments on Government land will not be tolerated under any circumstances and the Administration will continue its vigilant efforts to prevent unauthorized constructions and encroachments. The District Administration

calls upon the public to respect Government property and strictly warns that any future attempts at encroachment will attract severe legal consequences.

The institutionalization of care services is crucial for enhancing female workforce participation.

Suggestive standards and protocol have been formulated for setting up Creches by any Individual/ Service Agencies/ Corporations/ Companies/ Universities/ Hospitals/ Care Service Providers/Government Organizations/Non-Governmental Organizations, etc., addressing the minimum essential requirements. These standards and protocol aim to provide

comprehensive childcare in a safe and secure environment, fostering the overall development of children.

Additional facilities may be incorporated to further enhance the well-being of children. State Governments and UT Administrations have also been advised

to adopt these standards and protocols for setting up and managing Creches. Accordingly,

Ministry of Women and Child Development, GoI has issued comprehensive Minimum Standards for establishing Creches. The

Bar and POL owners directed to strictly comply with due dates for VAT remittance

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 19

It has been observed that some Bar owners and POL (Petroleum, Oil & Lubricant) owners are not remitting their Value Added Tax (VAT) on a monthly basis within the due dates as notified vide F.No.1-1/DC (SA)/VAT (PF)/2017-18/5974 dated 31st December, 2020 issued by the Commissioner (VAT), A & N Islands. This non-compliance constitutes a gross violation of VAT Rules and results in a significant loss to the Government exchequer.

Therefore, all Bar owners and POL owners have been once again directed to strictly comply with the due dates as per the aforementioned notification provided as under:

Further, it is clarified that, henceforth all the Value Added Tax Returns shall be submitted at the Office of the Value Added Tax Officer (HQ) situated at RCS Office, VIP Road, Sri Vijaya Puram.

This directive is issued in the interest of maintaining proper tax compliance and ensuring the financial health of the Government exchequer, a press release from VATO (HQ), RCS Office said.

Deptt. of CS&CA issues Advisory on precautions to be taken while handling LPG cylinders

Taking into account, LPG Consumer's safety and prevention of any accidents at Marriage Halls/Restaurants/Eateries & other Commercial Establishment, all such business entities have been advised to take adequate precautions

while handling LPG cylinders including use of standard commercial hose and stove as per ISI standard specification, which would immensely boost to avert any untoward incident.

As per guidelines, the business entities involved in diversion of

domestic LPG cylinders for commercial purpose is a punishable offence, failing which, stern action as deemed fit as per extant Rules will be initiated against such commercial establishment, an advisory issued by Deptt. of CS&CA said.


