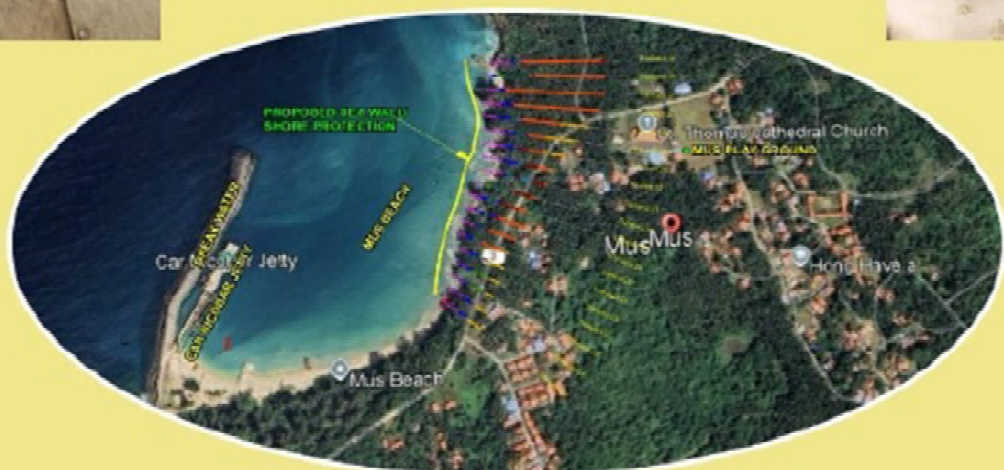

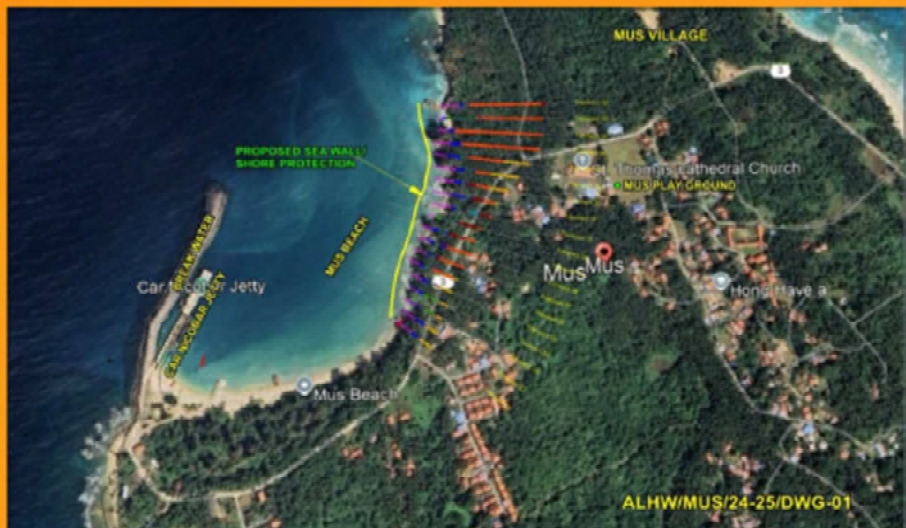

Mus Harbour, located in Car Nicobar, is the only all-weather port in the region and serves as a vital lifeline for the Nicobarese population. Operational since 2003, the harbour has faced severe erosion on its eastern side over the past decade, along with siltation in the basin, leading to significant land loss and affecting port operations.

To address these challenges, the Ministry of Ports, Shipping & Waterways has sanctioned a shore protection project under the Central Sector Plan, at an estimated cost of Rs. 47.13 Crore. The project includes construction of a 450-meter long sea wall and is expected to be completed within 15 months.
