VP inaugurates PMAY (Urban) Flats at Ghoghla in Daman & Diu

India is the centre of the world, there is no other country like India: Vice President

New Delhi, Sept. 22
Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar said, "Those who think big have made India the main centre of the world. There is no other country like India. I am not saying this - major global institutions are accepting this change. A big change, which could not even be imagined earlier, is coming to the fore." Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar inaugurated Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) flats at Ghoghla, Diu today and handed over the keys of PMAY flats to the beneficiaries.

Addressing the gathering on the occasion, he reflected on the profound influence of national leadership and said, "There is a lot in a name, the name 'Narendra', formed by the combination of 'nar' and 'indra', has made everything possible." Appreciating the significant progress made in housing development, Shri Dhankhar said that over 21,000 houses have been sanctioned and constructed in the region under various Government



schemes. He emphasised on the remarkable changes taking place in the country and credited the leadership for this progress. He said, "The specialty here is that whatever is approved, it becomes possible. Why is everything becoming possible in the country? It is because the person who is making it possible is leading the country."

Speaking on the major awards given in the country, the Vice President said that the last decade has witnessed profound changes with regard to the selection of recipients of some of the highest civilian honours of the country, including the Padma Shri, Padma Bhushan, Padma Vibhushan and Bharat Ratna awards. He further said that this progress symbolises India's journey towards "Ram Rajya". "It shows that the country is changing and moving towards Ram Rajya", he said. Emphasising on transformational governance, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar pointed to the unprecedented development in infrastructure and essential services across the country. Short-term credit to farmers for agricultural needs 9678 applicants sanctioned loan by Banks under Kisan Credit Card scheme in A&N Islands

Under the Kisan Credit Card (KCC) scheme, different banks functioning in South Andaman has sanctioned loan to 9678 applicants' up to June, 2024. The maximum number of beneficiaries was covered by the State Bank of India and A&N State Co-operative Bank.

The highest number of applications was received in the Agriculture Sector, for which loan was sanctioned to 7912 applicants amounting to Rs. 21.08 crores. Similarly, in the Animal Husbandry Sector, loan was sanctioned to 1012

applicants amounting to Rs. 4.81 crores while in Fisheries Sector, loan amount of Rs. 7.08 crores was sanctioned to 754 applicants till June, 2024.

The total amount disbursed as loan in KCC scheme stood at Rs.32.97 crores in A&N Islands. The Kisan Credit Card scheme aims at

providing adequate and timely credit support from the banking system under a single window with flexible and simplified procedure to the farmers for their allied farm activities which includes to meet the short term credit requirements for cultivation of crops; Post-harvest expenses;

Produce marketing loan; Consumption requirements of farmer household; working capital for maintenance of farm assets and activities allied to agriculture; investment credit requirement for agriculture and allied activities, Lead Bank Sources informed.

Considering the success of the Scheme, an additional component namely Expanding/Upgrading the existing unit set up under PMEGP/REGP/PMRY/MUDRA has been added, wherein the units already setup under PMEGP/REGP/PMRY/MUDRA and performing very well in terms of turnover, profit making are eligible for availing further financial assistance up to Rs.1.00 crore for Manufacturing units and Rs. 25 lakhs for Service/trading activities. The financial assistance will be provided through Banks with uniform subsidy of 15% by the Government for all categories of beneficiaries. Self contribution by beneficiaries will be 10% of the proposed expansion and up gradation project cost.

The objectives of the provision of 2nd Loan under PMEGP Scheme is to fulfill the need of additional financial assistance for upgrading and expansion to the successful /well performing units. The purpose is to cater to the need of the entrepreneurs for bringing new technology /automation, so as to modernize the existing unit and to enhance the productivity of the existing unit with the inclusion of the additional dose of funding and assuring additional wage employment.

All the existing units assisted under PMEGP/REGP/PMRY/MUDRA scheme are eligible for availing the 2nd loan under PMEGP to upgrade their units. The aspiring units are required to submit online applications in the PMEGP Portal at www.kviconline.gov.in along with the necessary documents.

India defeats Bangladesh in Chennai Test; take lead in two-match series

Chennai, Sept. 22

In Cricket, India defeated Bangladesh by 280 runs in the opening Test match in Chennai today, taking a 1-nil lead in the two-match series. Chasing a target of 515 runs, Bangladesh were bundled out for 234 runs in their second inning on Day 4. For hosts, Ravichandran Ashwin claimed a six-wicket haul, powering India to a comprehensive victory. At the end of day three yesterday, Bangladesh were at 158 for the loss of 4 wickets when stumps were drawn. India declared their second innings on



287 for 4 on Day 3 with the help of Shubman Gill and Rishabh Pant's centuries, putting the hosts firmly in control of the opening test between the

neighbouring countries. The hosts were already in the ascendancy since bundling out Bangladesh for 149 in their first inning and claiming a lead of 227.

Billiground Police apprehends accused in attempted murder case

Billiground, Sept. 22

PS Billiground received information regarding an attempted murder case on Sept.18, 2024

where Arogyaswamy, R/o Betapur brutally attacked his wife with a knife due to family disputes. The victim suffered multiple lacerated wounds but was rescued due to the timely intervention of passersby. Acting swiftly, SI M.V Shiju Kumar, SHO PS Billiground, along with ASI Muthu, ASI Rajni Babu, HCs Bawali & Kamlesh, PCs Mustafa, N a r a y a n , Abhijeet, Bhagirath, Silas, Selvam and Ct Diwakar, immediately reached the scene.

Following the commission of the crime, the accused fled to the nearby jungle with the weapon and tried his best to evade

arrest but the Police launched a massive manhunt, leveraging technical intelligence and human inputs to track his digital and physical footprints.

On Sept.20, 2024, the relentless efforts of the Police paid off, and Arogyaswamy was apprehended from Panchawati jungle, while trying to flee from Billiground and had came closer to road expecting to catch a vehicle. The weapon used in the crime was also recovered from his possession which he has hidden in a clandestine manner. Subsequently, the accused namely Arogyaswamy, S/o Late K. Villayan, 39 yrs, R/o Betapur was arrested in this case which has been registered under the relevant sections of BNS, 2023, a press release from SP (N&MA) said.
