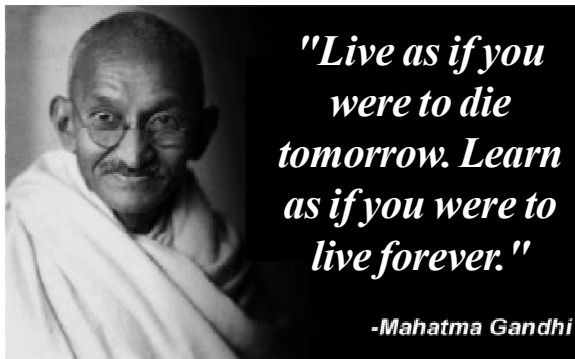

Ceremonial Plantation event under SPICE PRAVAH (Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam) as part of Sewa Pakhwada held at Progeny Farm, Jirkatang

Chief Secretary underscored the importance of spices in daily lives and its rich historical significance

To accomplish sustainable agriculture and self-reliance in spice production, the Department of Agriculture, Andaman & Nicobar Administration, officially launched the ambitious campaign SPICE PRAVAH on 31st July, 2025. Continuing the Administration's goal of attaining 100% spice import substitution, the Department of Agriculture has organized a Ceremonial Plantation event under SPICE PRAVAH (Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam) as part of Sewa Pakhwada at Progeny Farm, Jirkatang today.

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, was the chief guest on the occasion. Ms. Chanchal Yadav, IAS, Commissioner-cum-



Secretary (Agriculture) was the special guest. Shri Neeraj Bharati, IAS, Secretary (Vigilance & Home), Shri Satnam Singh, IAS, Secretary (GA/Protocol and Personnel), Shri Rajesh Chopra, IAS, Secretary-cum-RCS, Ms. Pallavi Sarkar, IAS, Secretary (Agriculture), Ms. Priyanka Kumari, Director of Agriculture, Shri Venkat Ram Babu, Pradhan, Wimberlygunj,

farmers and officials from Department of Agriculture enthusiastically joined in planting clove seedlings, symbolizing a collective commitment to the success of the SPICE PRAVAH under Sewa Pakhwada.

Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Secretary highlighted the various activities under Sewa Pakhwada like Swasth Nari, Sashakt



Parivar, Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam and SPICE PRAVAH in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. He underscored the importance of spices in daily lives and its rich historical significance. He also noted that the country imports several varieties of spices from abroad. Through the SPICE PRAVAH initiative, by promoting the cultivation of tree-based spices in

these Islands, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands can emerge as a key contributor to the nation's spice production and import substitution of spices apart from generating employment in various field associated under SPICE PRAVAH.

The Chief Secretary appreciated the efforts of the Department of Agriculture in making the SPICE PRAVAH a

successful initiative by planting about 70,000 seedlings in a span of 55 days since the initiation of the campaign.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Agriculture) shared her thoughts on the significance of the initiative. She informed that the plantation of spices has already commenced under SPICE PRAVAH and emphasized the need for establishing a comprehensive database of farmers and spice plantations to ensure systematic monitoring. She further highlighted that regular field visits should be conducted at defined intervals and that continuous technical support must be extended to farmers until the stage of spice harvesting. 56th GST Council Meeting recommends reduction in GST for various goods & services

In pursuant to the 56th GST Council Meeting, it is being informed to all citizens of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, that the following changes has come into effect from 22nd September, 2025 in Goods and Services Tax (GST).

- ▶ Exemption of GST on all individual life insurance policies whether term life, ULIP or endowment policies and reinsurance thereof to make insurance affordable for the common man and increase the insurance coverage in the country.
- ▶ Exemption of GST on all individual health insurance policies (including family floater policies and policies for senior citizens) and reinsurance thereof to make insurance affordable for the common man and increase the insurance coverage in the country.
- ▶ Rationalisation of the current 4-tiered tax rate structure into a citizen friendly 'Simple Tax' - a 2 rate structure with a Standard Rate of 18% and a Merit Rate of 5%; a special de-merit rate of 40% for a select few goods and services.
- ▶ Reduction of GST from 18% OR 12% to 5% on a host of common man items such as, hair oil, toilet soap bars, shampoos, toothbrushes, toothpaste, Bicycles, Tableware, kitchenware, other household articles.
- ▶ Reduction of GST from 5% to NIL on Ultra-High Temperature (UHT) milk, Pre-packaged and labelled chena or paneer; All the Indian Breads will see NIL rates (Chapati or roti, paratha, parotta, etc).
- ▶ Reduction of GST from 12% OR 18% to 5% on almost all of the food items such as packaged namkeens, Bhujia, Sauces, Pasta, Instant Noodles, Chocolates, Coffee, Preserved Meat, Cornflakes, Butter, Ghee, etc.
- ▶ Reduction of GST from 28% to 18% on Air-conditioning machines, TVs~32 inch (all TVs now at 18%), Dishwashing machines, Small cars, Motorcycles equal to or less than 350 CC.

the importance of detailed planning for post-harvest management, including the provision of modern tools and dryers to facilitate effective processing of spices.

Speaking on the occasion, the Pradhan of Gram Panchayat Wimberygunj, Shri Venkat Ram Babu, expressed his gratitude to the Department for undertaking the SPICE PRAVAH initiative. He highlighted that such initiatives must yield fruitful results in the farmers' fields. He further stated that the farmers of Gram Panchayat Wimberygunj have already begun taking advantage of SPICE PRAVAH and have initiated the planting of spices in their fields.

Earlier, welcoming the gathering, Secretary (Agriculture) highlighted the significance of the ongoing event Sewa Pakhwada under SPICE PRAVAH (Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam) initiative in promoting spice cultivation especially clove across the Islands. She underlined the objectives of the SPICE PRAVAH initiative which seeks to encourage farmers to diversify into spices such as black pepper, clove, nutmeg, cinnamon and other high-value crops. She also emphasized that under Phase I, the target was to bring 40 hectares under spice cultivation with 70,000 seedlings to be planted. However, due to the overwhelming response from the farming community and the dedicated efforts of the Department staff and officials, the program successfully expanded to 46 hectares, with the active participation of over 13,000 farmers under SPICE PRAVAH. Highlighting the initiatives of the Department, the Secretary (Agriculture) informed that spice aggregation centers and a spice processing center are to be established for the collection and value-added processing of spices. She further emphasized that the spices of the Islands are pure and authentic, and beyond their culinary uses, the



Department has also initiated efforts to harness their medicinal properties. Notably, spices such as cinnamon and nutmeg are being used in the production of soaps. Tests and analysis revealed a fat content of 74%, placing them in the luxury category. Additionally, the Department is planning to launch MADHU KRANTI, an innovative initiative to infuse honey with spices.

Shri T. Babu, a farmer from Miletalak village, expressed his gratitude to the Department of Agriculture, stating that he has planted spices in his field through the support of the Department. He also encouraged other farmers to adopt spice cultivation in their respective fields.

During the event, the chief guest and other dignitaries distributed clove seedlings to the farmers. The ceremonial plantation was attended by 60 progressive farmers and departmental officials.

Apart from the state-level function, ceremonial plantation programmes were also held across seven different zones.

At Little Andaman, Dr. Sachin Shinde, IAS, Commissioner-cum-Secretary alongwith Shri Sunil Kumar, IFS, DFO, Little Andaman, Shri Ajoy Mondal, Tehsildar, Little Andaman, Shri Belthazar, BDO, Little Andaman, Shri Raja Up- Pramukh, Little Andaman, PRI members planted the cinnamon seedlings in the Progeny Farm, RK Pur. 56th GST Council Meeting recommends.....

- Reduction of GST from 12% to 5% on agricultural goods, such as tractors, agricultural, horticultural or forestry machinery for soil preparation or cultivation, harvesting or threshing machinery, including straw or fodder balers, grass or hay mowers, composting machines etc.
 - Reduction of GST from 12% to 5% on labour intensive goods such as Handicrafts, Marble and travertine blocks, granite blocks, and Intermediate leather goods.
 - Reduction of GST from 28% to 18% on Cement.
 - Reduction of GST from 12% to NIL on 33 lifesaving drugs and medicines and from 5% to NIL on 3 lifesaving drugs & medicines used for treatment of cancer, rare diseases and other severe chronic diseases.
 - Reduction of GST on all other drugs and medicines from 12% to 5%.
 - Reduction of GST from 18% to 5% on various medical apparatus and devices used for medical, surgical, dental or veterinary usage or for physical or chemical analysis.
 - Reduction of GST from 12% to 5% on various medical equipment and supplies devices such as wadding gauze, bandages, diagnostic kits and reagents, blood glucose monitoring system (Glucometer) medical devices, etc.
 - Reduction of GST from 28% to 18% on Small Cars and Motorcycles equal to or below 350cc.
 - Reduction of GST from 28% to 18% on buses, trucks, ambulances etc.
 - Uniform rate of 18% on all auto parts irrespective of their HS code; Three-Wheelers from 28% to 18%.
 - Correction of long-pending inverted duty structure for the manmade textile sector by reducing GST rate on manmade fibre from 18% to 5% and manmade yarn from 12% to 5%.
 - Correction of inverted duty structure in fertilizer sector by reducing GST from 18% to 5% on Sulphuric acid, Nitric acid and Ammonia.
 - Reduction of GST from 12% to 5% on renewable energy devices and parts for their manufacture.
