## DLSA to hold National Lok Adalat on Sept. 14

Port Blair, Sept. 1

The District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), Andaman & Nicobar Islands will be holding National Lok Adalat in the District Court Complex at Port Blair and Sub-Divisional Court Complex at Mayabunder and Circuit Court at Diglipur on Sept. 14. Besides the compoundable nature of cases pending in different Courts, disputes at the pre-litigation stage will also be entertained by the National Lok Adalat for disposal upon consensual settlement between the parties. Pre-litigation disputes include (i) NI Act cases u/s 138 (ii) Money recovery cases (iii) Labour dispute cases, (iv) Electricity and water bills cases (excluding non-compoundable) (v) Maintenance cases (vi) Civil disputes and (vii) Disputes under the Consumer Protection Act.

The public in general having any such dispute at the pre-litigation stage or post-litigation stage are at liberty to submit their disputes in writing to the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Port Blair before Sept. 9 so that their disputes may be processed and made ready for hearing before the National Lok Adalat on Sept. 14, a press release from DLSA said.


