Shillong, Sept. 2  
The North Eastern & Eastern States/UTs Tourism Ministers Conference, a prestigious gathering aimed at discussing and promoting tourism across the Eastern States and Union Territories of India, was successfully held today at Shillong in Meghalaya.

The conference was chaired by Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, Hon'ble Union Minister for Tourism and Culture. Shri Suresh Gopi, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Tourism, Admiral D.K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) Hon'ble Lt. Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Tourism Ministers of different States of North Eastern & Eastern State attended the conference.

In his address, the Hon'ble Union Minister for Tourism and Culture stated that Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi ji has promoted India's tourism sector at the global level, as a result, the tourism sector across the country has now got a new shine. In the



roadmap for developed India, sustainable development of the tourism sector has been placed at the top level. He also took opinion while presenting the vision of the Central Government.

Speaking in the conference, Hon'ble Lt. Governor A&N Islands highlighted the proactive steps taken by UT Administration to promote sustainable tourism in Isles. He said, a single window clearance

system for all tourism related activities has been made fully functional under the Tourism Department of A&N Administration to facilitate potential investors and stakeholders in the Tourism Sector. He further stated that tourist footfall has increased manifold (except during COVID -19) in the Islands. Post COVID, tourism activities are gradually gaining momentum. The Hon'ble Lt. Governor

also mentioned that Air Asia will be commencing International flight operation between Port Blair and Kuala Lumpur from 16.11.2024 and the commencement of this flight will give a phenomenal boost to tourism and export of marine products. He also apprised the gathering about the e a r l y operationalisation of Sea Plane in the Islands. Apart from this, to promote the Islands as a premier diving destination and put the Islands on the world diving

map, plans are being made to create multiple Guinness World Records by forming the largest human chain etc.

Hon'ble Lt. Governor also elaborated on development of NSCB Dweep as National Memorial, Viper Island as Heritage Tourism destination, Ecotourism Projects in PPP model being e x p l o r e d , Guidelines for Water Sports activities, formulating policies for Bird Watching, Caravan Luxury T e n t e d Accommodation,

House Boat Tourism, Astro Tourism and A&N Bed & Breakfast/ Home-stay Scheme.

The event brought together key dignitaries and leaders from various States/UTs to deliberate on strategies for boosting tourism while preserving the unique cultural and ecological heritage of the region.

Later, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor also interacted with the Chief Minister of Meghalaya, Shri Conrad K Sangma.

#### Soon, you can fly directly from the Andamans to Malaysia

#### The first international flight from Port Blair will start before the year ends

The Andaman and Nicobar Islands' Veer Savarkar International Airport in Port Blair will soon have international connectivity. From 16<sup>th</sup> November, Air Asia will operate an international flight to Kuala Lumpur in Malaysia. This marks the beginning of direct international travel to and from the Andaman islands, making them more accessible to global travellers. Currently, Port Blair is connected by air to Delhi, Chennai, Bengaluru and Kolkata. Kuala Lumpur is the inaugural international destination.

Since the airport's new integrated terminal building was inaugurated on July 18, 2023, the airport has made significant progress, with the commencement of night operations this year on 28<sup>th</sup> June.

## World Coconut Day befittingly celebrated in Isles Secretary (Agriculture) urges farmers to adopt organic farming and use Biopesticides & Biofertilizers in the field

Port Blair, Sept. 2

The World Coconut Day 2024 was celebrated in a befitting manner at Conference Hall of Zonal Agriculture Office, South Andaman today. Shri B.S. Jaglan, IAS, Secretary (Agriculture), A & N Administration inaugurated the programme as chief guest. Speaking on the occasion, the Secretary (Agriculture) enlightened the farmers about the importance of production and productivity of coconut in improving the economy of these Islands. To increase the productivity of the palms and to improve the economic status of the farmers, he urged them to rejuvenate the old plantations by adopting new technologies provided by the Department of Agriculture and Coconut Development Board.

Under the Scheme PM-AASHA copra procurement is under process, he said and to minimize the loss faced by the copra farmers, due to quality degradation of copra, he requested the farmers to maintain the moisture content of copra at lower level and to adopt the quality packaging options. Further, he urged the farmers to come forward and establish an Integrated Coconut Processing Unit in the Islands, so that various value added products like Coconut oil, coconut milk, Coconut milk powder, desiccated coconut powder, Coconut cream, Coconut chips, coir, activated carbon, compost etc. may be produced. For technical know-how and latest technologies for establishing the Integrated Coconut Processing Unit, the Department of Agriculture will be



deputing farmers to mainland. Secretary (Agriculture) appealed to the farmers to adopt organic farming and urged them to use Biopesticides and Biofertilizers in the field. He also informed that there is good scope for crops like coconut, arecanut, spices and vegetables, hence the Administration is trying to introduce new High yielding and resistant to pest & diseases varieties from mainland institutions. He concluded with the message to the youngsters to come forward and make agriculture a respectable profession.

In his address, the Director of Agriculture, A & N Administration, Shri Abhishek Gulia, said that the nutritional and cultural benefits of coconut and its multitude uses from root to fruit makes coconut an economically valuable crop. Under the PM-Vision, the doubling of farmers' income is a programme initiated by the Government of India to increase the income of farmers. Through PM-AASHA Scheme, the farmers can receive remunerative prices for

copra, which ultimately increase income of the farmer.

Earlier welcoming the gathering, Shri Ramesh Kumar, Joint Director (Agriculture) briefed about the importance of celebrating World Coconut Day. Smt. S.C. Rekha, Assistant Director (Agri.) HQ also spoke on the occasion. During the programme, the chief guest distributed prizes to the winners of Fruit & Vegetable Show, Flower Show of ITF-2023-24 and Millet Mela. A technical session was also held. The programme concluded with vote of thanks proposed by Shri Navasakthi, Assistant Director (Agri.). Altogether 100 participants including farmers, coconut entrepreneurs and officials of the department participated in the programme.

Similar programme was also organized in various zones (Little Andaman, Car Nicobar & Campbell Bay) in a befitting manner for creating awareness among the farmers of far flung Islands, a press release from Directorate of Agriculture said.

## Anti-Narcotics Police Station executes two successful operations, seizes 1.245 kg of Ganja

Port Blair, Sept. 2

Demonstrating an unwavering commitment to combating drug-related activities, the Anti-Narcotics Police Station executed two targeted operations on August 30, 2024, resulting in significant seizures and arrests.

In the first operation, acting on specific intelligence, a team led by Insp. Pritam Behari, SHO, Anti-Narcotics and including ASI Sanjay Yadav, PC Nanak Singh, PC Ratan Das, PC M. Raja Rao, and PC Vishal Kumar, recovered 850 grams of Ganja from the RMS Parcel Hub, Postal Department, Port Blair.

The Ganja was seized after observing all codal formalities.

In the second operation, another team from the Anti-Narcotics Police Station, also led by Insp. Pritam Behari

and comprising of SI Mohd Rahil Islam, PC Ratan Das, PC S. Nanak Singh, PC M. Raja Rao, PC Vishal Kumar, LPC Anjana Halder, and LPC Nandita Mistry, conducted a raid at a private courier service company at Gurudwara Lane, Port Blair. During the raid, they recovered 495 Grams of Ganja hidden inside a geyser. The Ganja was seized

after following all codal formalities. During further investigation, the suspects involved in this case were identified and arrested.

Both raids were conducted under the supervision of Shri Vishesh Dhatteerwal, Dy.SP, Narcotics, and the overall supervision of Shri Mohd. Irshad Haider, IPS, SP (CID), A&N Islands. Cases under the relevant sections of the NDPS Act, 1985 have been registered at the Anti-Narcotics Police Station and further investigations are currently under progress, a press release from SP (CID) said.

## PS Rangat seizes methamphetamine; accused arrested

Rangat, Sept. 2

In a rapid and effective operation, PS Rangat successfully intercepted an illegal drug transaction based on reliable intelligence. Under the leadership of Shri Rahul L. Nair, IPS SDPO Rangat, a specialized team was promptly assembled. The team, led by SI Madhab Halder, SHO, PS Rangat including SI Abdul Sajeed, PCs K. Acting on a tip-off that an individual named Sanjeev Kumar Halder is in possession of illicit drug which he is trying to sell near transformer, Janakpur, Rangat, the team positioned themselves discreetly near the spot.

Shortly thereafter, the suspect was intercepted by the raiding team resulting in the recovery of 10 gram of Methamphetamine drug from the possession of suspect named Sanjeev Kumar Halder, S/o Late Bharat Chandra Halder, 42 yrs, R/o Bhatubasti, Port Blair, now at Rangat. Following thorough interrogation, the accused person confessed to his crime and subsequently, the accused was arrested and a case was registered at PS Rangat under the NDPS Act.

The whole operation was conducted under the overall direction and supervision of Ms. Geetanjali Khandelwal, IPS, Superintendent of Police, North & Middle Andaman District, a press release from SP (N&MA) said.

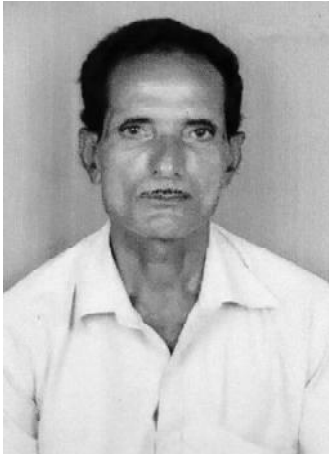

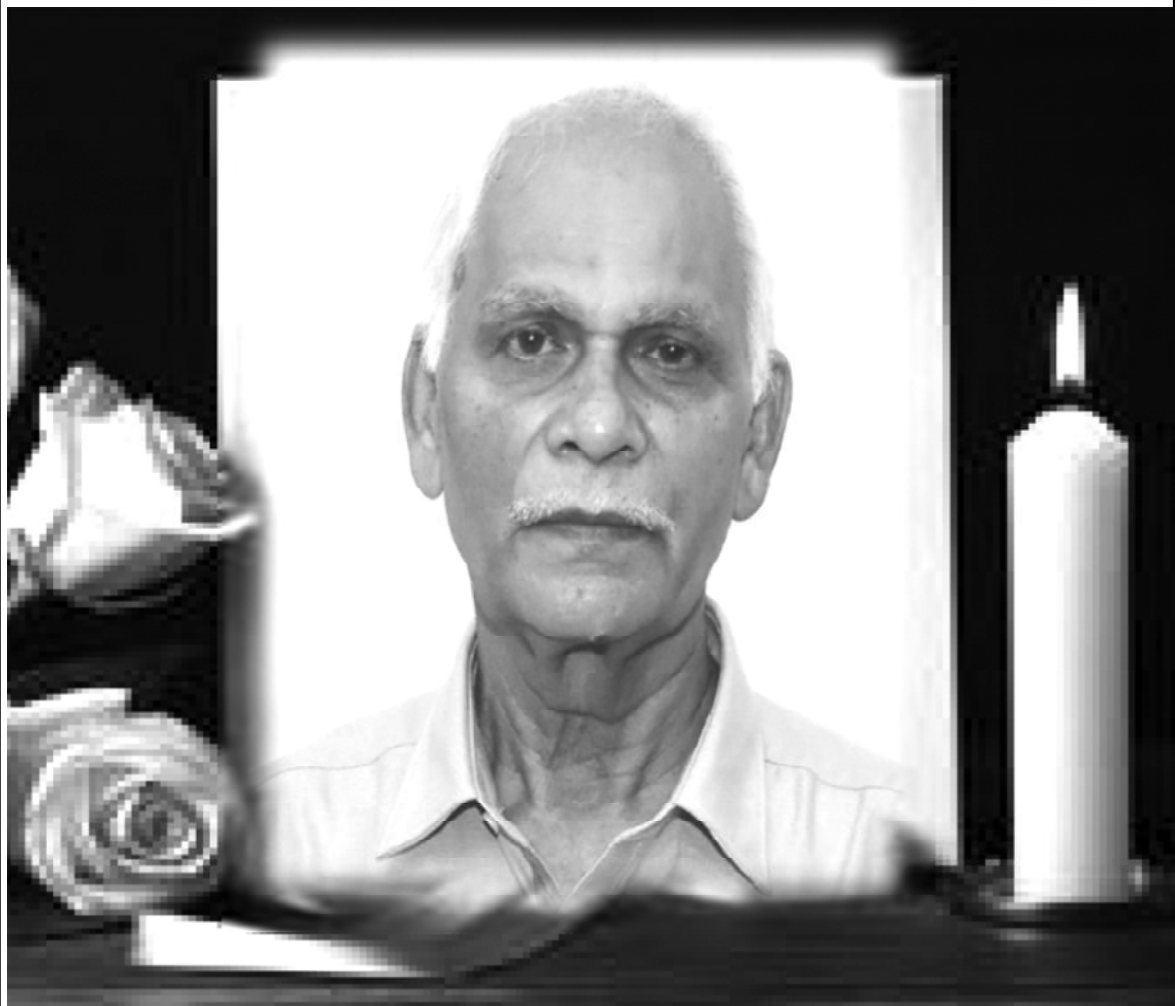
