Hon'ble Prime Minister inaugurates Semicon India 2025 in New Delhi

The day is not far when India's smallest chip
will drive the world's biggest change: PM

New Delhi, Sept. 2 (PIB)

The Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the 'Semicon India - 2025', aimed at catalysing India's Semiconductor ecosystem, at Yashobhoomi in New Delhi today. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister acknowledged the presence of semiconductor industry CEOs and their associates from India and abroad. He welcomed distinguished guests from various countries, entrepreneurs associated with start-ups, and young students who had come from different states across the nation.

Shri Modi stated that he returned last night from his visit to Japan and China, and today he is present among the



audience in Yashobhoomi, a hall filled with aspirations and confidence. Mentioning his passion for technology has always been natural and well-known, the Prime Minister said that during his recent visit to Japan, he had the opportunity to visit the Tokyo Electron factory

along with Japanese Prime Minister H.E. Mr. Shigeru Ishiba. He mentioned that the CEO of that company is present among the audience today. The Prime Minister emphasized that his inclination towards technology repeatedly brings him among such gatherings. He

expressed that being present among the audience today brings him great joy.

Noting the presence of semiconductor sector experts from across the globe, with representation from over 40 to 50 countries, Shri Modi emphasized that India's innovation and youth power are

also visibly present at the event. He stated that this unique combination sends a clear message, "The World trusts India, the World believes in India and the World is ready to build the Semiconductor Future with India". The Prime Minister welcomed all distinguished guests attending Semicon India and affirmed that they are important partners in India's journey towards a developed and self-reliant nation.

Remarking that in the world of semiconductors, it is often said, 'Oil was black gold, but chips are digital diamonds', the Prime Minister stated that oil shaped the previous century, and the fate of the world was determined by oil wells.

PM SURYA GHAR: MUFT BIJILI YOJANA

In line with the Government of India's ambitious target of achieving 100% solarization of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands and following the launch of the PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana in February 2024, the A&N Administration has initiated the registration of willing consumers for rooftop solar (RTS) installations across the islands.

So far, 66 consumers have successfully installed rooftop solar plants under this scheme, resulting in a noticeable reduction in their electricity bills based on their individual consumption patterns. This initiative not only reduces dependence on conventional power sources but also promotes clean and sustainable energy.

The Electricity Department, A&N Administration, encourages all residents of the islands to come forward and avail the benefits of this transformative scheme. Under the PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana, a subsidy of up to ₹2,02,800 is provided for rooftop solar installations of up to 3 kW capacity.

Beneficiary's Stories

Mr M. Abdul Majeed, used to pay about Rs 3,782 per month on electricity. With solar, his bill has come down to less than Rs 312. This saving will recover his investment in just a few years.

Mr B. Thangam family's monthly bill dropped from an average of Rs. 2400 to just Rs. 130 after availing this scheme. The subsidy support made installation very affordable.

Before installing the rooftop solar, Mr Jag Jeevan Lal's monthly electricity bill was around Rs 4000. Now, with solar generation, it has reduced to an average of Rs 1200 saving him nearly Rs 2800 every month.

Mayabunder, Sept. 2

Acting on credible intelligence inputs, the A&N Police launched a large-scale anti-poaching operation on 24/08/2025 to curb illegal poaching activities in the vulnerable areas of the North & Middle Andaman district.

Dedicated teams from Police Stations Diglipur, Kalighat, Mayabunder, personnel of LOPs, staff from IRBn, PMF, APU etc. were swiftly mobilized and deployed to conduct



intensive combing operations across sensitive forest areas and vulnerable coastal belts, with the primary objective of dismantling organized poaching networks operating in the region.

During the sustained

search operations, the teams achieved a significant breakthrough by apprehending 14 Myanmarese poachers from the dense jungles of Nappi Ghope. In addition, the teams seized two engine-



powered dinghies and approximately 550 kg of sea cucumbers, thereby crippling the poachers' logistics, mobility, and capacity for the illegal exploitation of marine wealth. The search and combing operations are still ongoing in the

remote forested stretches of N&M District to ensure that no remnants of these poaching groups remain undetected and that the fragile marine and forest ecosystems of the region are

The global economy fluctuated based on how much petroleum was extracted from these wells. However, he emphasized that the power of the 21st century is now concentrated in the small chip. Though tiny in size, these chips possess the potential to accelerate global progress significantly. Shri Modi highlighted that the global semiconductor market has already reached \$600 billion, and in the coming years, it is expected to surpass \$1 trillion. He expressed confidence that, given the pace at which India is advancing in the semiconductor sector, India will hold a significant share in this \$1 trillion market.

Stating that he wished to highlight the speed at which India is progressing, Shri Modi recalled that in 2021, the Semicon India programme was launched. He added that by 2023, India's first semiconductor plant had been approved, in 2024, several more plants received approval and in 2025, five additional projects were cleared. He further stated that in total, ten semiconductor projects are now underway, involving an investment of over eighteen billion dollars -more than ₹1.5 lakh crore. The Prime Minister emphasized that this reflects the growing global trust in India.

Emphasising that in the semiconductor sector, speed matters, Shri Modi said, "the shorter the time from file to factory, and the lesser the paperwork, the sooner wafer work can begin". He stressed that the government is working with this very approach. The National Single Window System has been implemented, enabling all approvals from both the Centre and States to be accessed on a single platform. As a result, investors have been freed from extensive paperwork, he further added. The Prime Minister highlighted that semiconductor parks are being developed across the country under a plug-and-play infrastructure model, which offer facilities such as land, power supply, port and airport connectivity, and access to a skilled worker pool. He remarked that when such infrastructure is combined with incentives, industrial growth is inevitable. Whether through PLI incentives or Design Linked Grants, India is offering end-to-end capabilities. This is why investment continues to flow in, he emphasised. Affirming that India is moving beyond backend operations and progressing towards becoming a full-stack semiconductor nation, Shri Modi reiterated that the day is not far when India's smallest chip will drive the world's biggest change. He stated, "Our journey began late... but nothing can stop us now." The Prime Minister informed that CG Power's pilot plant commenced operations on August 28, just 4-5 days ago. He added that the pilot plant of Kaynes is also about to begin. Test chips from Micron and Tata are already in production. He reiterated that commercial chip production will begin this year, underscoring the rapid progress India is making in the semiconductor sector.

Emphasizing that India's semiconductor success story is not confined to a single vertical or a single technology, Shri Modi stated that India is building a comprehensive ecosystem-one that encompasses designing, manufacturing, packaging, and high-tech devices, all within the country. He clarified that the Semiconductor Mission is not limited to establishing a single fab or producing a single chip. Rather, India is creating a robust semiconductor ecosystem that will make the nation self-reliant and globally competitive, the Prime Minister added.

Deptt. of CS&CA initiates process of mandatory e-KYC

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 2

It is for the information of all ration card holders registered in this UT that in compliance to the Targeted Public Distribution System Amendment Order, 2005 made by the Govt. of India implemented with immediate effect by the Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs and initiated the process of e-KYC which is mandatory to be done in every five years. No members shall be eligible to hold a separate

ration card before attaining the age of eighteen years, Aadhaar number shall be captured for children below five years of age and e-KYC shall be performed for children to be updated within one year after turning five years.

The State Government shall temporarily disable ration cards of beneficiaries who haven't availed their entitled benefits during the last six months as

well as those beneficiaries who have been identified as duplicate within or outside the State/UT. Such disabled ration cards will be given a window of three months to revalidate or prove their eligibility by providing documents and e-KYC for activation. This is in compliance to the aforementioned amendment notification 2025 issued by the Govt. of India, a press release from Deptt. of CS&CA said.

US Open: Novak Djokovic reaches quarterfinal

Washington, Sept. 2

In the men's singles pre-quarterfinals at the US Open Tennis, Novak Djokovic beat Jan-Lennard Struff of Germany 6-3, 6-3, 6-2 to reach his record-extending 64th Grand Slam quarterfinal.

Djokovic has now reached the quarterfinals at every major in a year for the ninth time in his career, breaking a tie with Roger Federer for the most of any man or woman in the Open era.

In another Singles match, World No. 2 and former champion Carlos Alcaraz of Spain beat Frenchman Arthur Rinderknech 7-6, 6-3, 6-4 to advance to the quarterfinal. In the Women's Singles, defending champion Belarusian Aryna Sabalenka beat Spain's Cristina Bucsa 6-1, 6-4 to advance to the quarterfinals of at Flushing Meadows last night.

In another match, world no. 4 seed Jessica Pegula, the 2024 US Open runner-up, advanced to the quarterfinals for a second straight year by defeating fellow American Ann Li 6-1, 6-2 in just 54 minutes yesterday.

Earlier, in men's doubles, India's Yuki



Bhambri and New Zealand's Michael Venus secured a straight-sets victory over the American pair Marcos Giron and Learner Tien, winning 2-0 in the first round.

In another standout result, Indian duo Anirudh Chandrasekar and Vijay Prashanth upset the eighth-seeded American team of Christian Harrison and Evan King in a thrilling 2-1 win. This marks their maiden Grand Slam victory, achieved in just their third major appearance.

Promoting sustainable livelihoods for dairy farmers in Isles

Deptt. of AH&VS conducts dairy farming training at Humphreygunj

The Department of AH&VS in collaboration with the Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA) and ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute (CIARI), conducted a two-day training program on 'Scientific Rearing and Management of Dairy Cattle' at Indira Nagar, Gram Panchayat Humphreygunj, South Andaman, on Aug. 30 & 31. The initiative aimed to enhance milk production, improve animal health, and promote sustainable livelihoods for dairy farmers.

Thirty-seven dairy farmers participated, receiving expert guidance on modern cattle management. Dr. Ajay Verma, Joint Director (AH&VS), Dr.



Prakash Bala, Principal Scientist, CIARI, Dr. P. Perumal, Senior Scientist, CIARI, Dr. Subhash Palve, Senior Veterinary Officer, Livestock Farm Complex, Dollygunj, Dr. Satish Kumar, Senior Veterinary Officer, Dollygunj, Dr. Lawhale Ninad Sahebrao, Senior Veterinary Officer, Manglutan, Shri Abdul Majeed, Senior Veterinary Compounder, and Ms. Shabana Kulsoom, Veterinary Compounder spoke on various aspects of dairy farming during

the training.

Indira Nagar, with approximately 236 cattle and 50 dairy farmers, contributes 800-1000 liters of fresh milk daily to the local economy. The training equipped farmers with scientific methods to enhance efficiency and productivity. Smt. New Delhi to host Badminton World Championships 2026

New Delhi, Sept. 2

New Delhi will host the Badminton World Championships in August next year. The announcement was made by the Badminton World Federation (BWF) during the closing ceremony of the 2025 Championships in Paris yesterday. The competition will return to India after 17 years and to Asia after four years. In 2009, the World Championships were held in Hyderabad. The last time an Asian city hosted the championships was in 2018, when it was held in China's Nanjing.

Over the years, a host of Indians have secured medals at the



Badminton World Championships, with PV Sindhu being the most successful campaigner, winning five medals, including a gold, two silver and two bronze. In the recent editions, the men's doubles pair of Satwiksairaj

Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty, and ace singles player H S Prannoy have bagged medals. Prakash Padukone, JWala Gutta and Ashwini Ponappa have also won medals for India in the World Championships.
