## EPS Pensioners to get pension from any bank, any branch, anywhere in India from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2025: Minister of L&E

### Centralized Pension Payments System for Pension under EPS 1995 approved; more than 78 lakh EPS Pensioners to be benefitted

New Delhi, Sept. 4 (PIB)

Union Minister of Labour and Employment and Chairperson, Central Board of Trustees, EPF has approved the proposal for a Centralized Pension Payment System (CPPS) for Employees' Pension Scheme, 1995. The CPPS marks a major shift by establishing national-level centralized system, enabling pension disbursement through any bank, any branch across India.

Speaking about this landmark decision, Union Minister, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya said, "The approval of the Centralized Pension Payment System (CPPS) marks a significant milestone in modernization of the EPFO. By enabling pensioners to receive their pensions from any bank, any branch, anywhere in the country, this initiative addresses the long-standing challenges faced by pensioners and ensures a seamless and efficient disbursement mechanism. This is a crucial step in our ongoing efforts to transform the EPFO into a more robust,



responsive, and tech-enabled organization, committed to serving the needs of its members and pensioners better."

The Centralized Pension Payment System is expected to benefit more than 78 lakh EPS pensioners of EPFO. By harnessing advanced IT and banking technologies, it will offer a more efficient, seamless, and user-friendly experience for pensioners.

The CPPS would also ensure disbursement of pension throughout India without any need for transfer of Pension Payment Orders (PPO) from one office to another even when the Pensioner moves

from one location to another or changes his bank or branch. This would be a great relief to pensioners who move to their hometown after retirement.

This facility will be launched as part of EPFO's ongoing IT modernization project Centralized IT Enabled System (CITES 2.01) from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2025. In the next phase, CPPS will enable a smooth transition to Aadhaar-Based Payment System (ABPS).

The CPPS is a paradigm shift from the existing pension disbursement system that is decentralized, with each Zonal/Regional Office of EPFO maintaining separate agreements with only 3-4 banks. There will also be no need for pensioners to visit the branch for any verification at the time of commencement of pension and the pension shall be immediately credited upon release. In addition, EPFO expects a significant cost reduction in pension disbursement after moving to the new system.

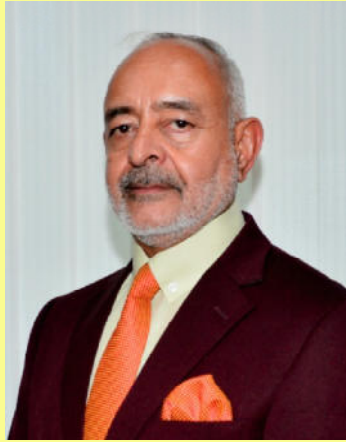
## MESSAGE

## Deptt. of AH&VS undertakes ear tagging in cattle & buffaloes of N & M Andaman District

### 241 cattle & buffaloes ear tagged so far

The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services has taken up ear tagging in cattle and buffaloes of North and Middle Andaman District. The yellow tamper proof ear tag with 12-digit unique identification number will not only help to keep the track record of

livestock and owner but will also effectively help in dealing with the problem of cattle roaming free on road by identifying the owner who let their cattle free and by imposing fine by the local bodies (Panchayat).

Under the Jurisdiction of Mayabunder, till date 241 numbers of cattle

and buffaloes have been ear tagged. The process will continue till all the villages under Mayabunder Jurisdiction are covered.

The ear tagging system has been initiated as part of the National Digital Livestock Mission of the Government of India. By tagging every

individual details of the cattle/buffalo and livestock is captured such as breed, age, sex, owner's name, village, Aadhaar number and other details. The ear tag will also help in tracking of the animal details during natural calamity. This unique tag number will also be used for recording

Cyber Crime Police Station cracks down on cyber criminal

Port Blair, Sept. 4

In a significant breakthrough, the Cyber Crime Police Station has successfully arrested a cyber criminal masterminded behind a sophisticated online scam. The accused had created a fake Facebook profile, illicitly using a local resident's personal information and photographs, causing harm to their reputation and identity.

A resident of Haddo, Port Blair, reported a distressing case of identity theft and online harassment to the Cyber Crime Police Station. An imposter had created a fake Facebook profile using her personal information and images, posting

inappropriate content that severely impacted her family life and reputation within the community.

Promptly, a thorough investigation was initiated by a team of Cyber Crime Police Station comprising Inspr. Sahil Shamsuddin, SHO, CCPs, Inspr. Mohd. Sameer, SI Devraj, Constable Sangeeta Mazumdar and Kayan Mohammed to gather digital evidence related to the fraudulent account's creation, login activities, and content uploads. Collaborating with Meta Platforms, crucial details about the account and its associated IP addresses were obtained.

Through continuous surveillance, the offender was identified and located. A strategic trap was set, resulting in the successful apprehension of the suspect on September 3, 2024.

During interrogation, the offender confessed to uploading the explicit photographs with the intention of humiliating the victim. PS Kalighat cracks theft case

Diglipur, Sept. 4

A resident of Srinagar, under the jurisdiction of PS Kalighat, reported the theft of his ATM Card, which resulted in unauthorized withdrawals totalling Rs. 3,17,000/- from his bank account on Sept.2, 2024. The incident came to light when the victim attempted to withdraw cash and discovered that his ATM Card was missing. Realizing the magnitude of the unauthorized transactions, the victim immediately reported the matter to PS Kalighat.

In response, a case of theft was promptly registered under the relevant sections of the BNS, 2023, at PS Kalighat. Under the leadership of SI Ashok Kumar Baghel, SHO of PS Kalighat, a dedicated team was constituted comprising

PCs Subrato Biswas, Rippan, Hazarat Kumar, and Irenious. The team quickly swung into action, gathering inputs and conducted technical surveillance to identify the suspect.

Through their diligent efforts, the team successfully apprehended the culprit namely Sernu Ram, S/o Late Amar Ram, 31 yrs, R/o Parangara, Kalighat, who confessed to the crime during interrogation.

Within 24 hours, the team recovered a significant portion of the stolen amount and other valuable articles from the accused. This swift and effective operation underscores the dedication and efficiency of PS Kalighat in safeguarding the rights of citizens, a press release from SP, N&MA said.

Cybercriminals send text messages pretending to be from trusted sources to get targets to click on links that install malware or steal personal & banking details. It has been observed that cyber fraudsters have started duping people in the name of unpaid electricity bill. The fraud campaign is being aggressively spread using SMSs. Users tend to be less sceptical of text messages, so smishing is often lucrative to attackers looking for credentials, banking information, or private data.
