New Delhi, Sept. 5 (PIB)

The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu conferred National Awards on teachers from across the country at a function held in New Delhi today on Teachers' Day. Smt K Suma, presently working as a teacher in GMS Dugnabad from A&N Islands was one among the recipients, who received the National Award for Teachers. The award was presented to teachers for their commitment not only in improving the quality of school education but also enriching the lives of their students. The award carries a Certificate of Merit, a cash award of Rs. 50,000 and a silver medal.

Addressing the gathering, the President said that teachers have

to prepare such citizens who are not only educated but also sensitive, honest and enterprising. She stated that moving ahead in life is success, but the meaning of life lies in working for the welfare of others. We should have compassion. Our conduct should be ethical. A successful life

lies in the meaningful life. Teaching these values to the students is the duty of teachers. The President said that teachers play the most important role in success of any education system. Teaching is not just a job. It is a sacred mission of human development. If a child is not able to perform

well, then the education system and teachers have a bigger responsibility. She pointed out that often teachers pay special attention only to those students who perform well in exams. However excellent academic performance is only one dimension of excellence. A child may

be a very good sportsperson; some child might have leadership skills; another child enthusiastically participates in social welfare activities. The teacher has to identify the natural talent of each child and bring it out.

The President said that the status of women in any society is an important criterion for its development. She stated that it is the responsibility of teachers and parents to educate children in such a way that they always behave in accordance with the dignity of women. She emphasised that the respect of women should not be only in 'words' but also in 'practice'.

category. The Hon'ble JERC has further directed in Tariff Order FY 2024-25 'In case Domestic (Bed & Breakfast), having higher tariff, uses are found in a premise having Domestic connection, such connection shall be treated as unauthorized under

section 126 of the Electricity Act, 2003 as such premises should have higher tariff i.e. Domestic (Bed & Breakfast Tariff)'. Therefore, all Bed & Breakfast establishments have been informed to change their category and requested to

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Idol makers & Puja Committees directed to follow guidelines for idol immersion as per Andaman and Nicobar Idol Immersion Rules 2018

Port Blair, Sept. 5

The Andaman and Nicobar Idol Immersion Rules 2018 were published in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette No. 23 dated 05-03-2018 in compliance of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal order dated 06-10-2017 in O.A 51/2016/EZ. The Rules framed covers the general guidelines idol making, ban on use of synthetic colors, height of super structures and idols. In this connection, all the Idol makers and Puja Committees have been directed to follow the guidelines for idol immersion as mentioned below:

- Idols should be made from natural materials as described in the holy scripts. Use of traditional clay for idol making rather than baked clay, Plaster of Paris (POP) etc. shall be encouraged, allowed and promoted.
- There shall be a complete ban on the use of POP in idol making till it is established that the POP has no negative impact on the water quality and aquatic bio-diversity.
- Painting of idols should be discouraged. In case idols are to be painted, water soluble and non-toxic natural dyes are to be used.
- There shall be a complete ban on the use of synthetic colour for painting of idols that would require immersion as part of final ritual of the festival.
- The height of the super structure of the idol shall be less than 40 ft. and the idol also shall not exceed 20ft in height.
- Materials used in worship like flowers, vastras (clothes), decorative materials (made of paper and plastic) etc. should be removed before immersion of idols. Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting at designated sites whereas the non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills or as prescribed by the local Municipal Authority or local body. Clothes may be sent to local orphanage(s).
- Idol Immersion should be done between low tide line and high tide line (irrespective of its depth) in identified places with permission of District Administration only.
- Single use plastic should not be used during celebration.

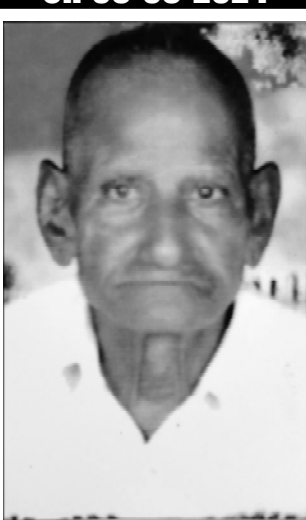
