International Literacy Day celebrated at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi

Let's resolve to make at least one person literate; this will be a spinal contribution for Viksit Bharat, stresses VP

Literacy liberates the individual, gives dignity, helps in self discovery

New Delhi, Sept. 8 (PIB)

The Vice-President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar called upon everyone to resolve today to make at least one person literate. "When we make someone literate, we liberate him or her, we help that person discover himself or herself, we make him or her feel dignity, we cut down dependence, we generate independence and interdependence. It enables a person to help himself or herself. It is a supreme facet of handholding", he added

Addressing the International Literacy Day celebrations as chief guest at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi today, the Vice-President underlined, "The joy and happiness you provide by educating a person, whether a man, a woman, a child, or a girl, is beyond measure. You can't imagine the happiness it will bring you. It will spread in a positive manner. It will be the greatest affirmative action you can take in Human Resource Development".

In his address, he called upon everyone to promote literacy, he remarked "time for



us to be in mission mode with commitment and passion to ensure 100% literacy at the earliest but I am sure this is achievable sooner than we think. Let each one make one literate, this will be a spinal contribution for Viksit Bharat".

He further asserted that "Education is something that no thief can take away from you. No Government can snatch it from you. Neither relatives, nor friends can take it away from you. There can be no reduction in it. It will grow and continue to grow as long as you keep sharing it". He also expressed confidence that if literacy is pursued passionately, India can reclaim its ancient status as a centre of learning, like Nalanda

and Takshashila.

Appealing to the States that are yet to adopt the National Education Policy (NEP) to rethink, revisit their stance, he emphasised that this policy is a game-changer for the nation. "This National Education Policy empowers our youth to fully exploit their talent and energy, giving due importance to all languages," he remarked.

Highlighting the special significance of mother tongue, Shri Dhankhar stated that it is the language in which we dream. Shri Dhankhar emphasised on India's unparalleled linguistic diversity. Shri Dhankhar stated that, "There is no country in the world like India. We are a unique nation when it comes to the richness of language, with several languages".

Reflecting on his experiences as Chairman of the Rajya Sabha, he shared, "I afford members the opportunity to speak in 22 languages. When I hear them speak in their language, I listen to the translation,

World Ozone Day 2024 to be observed on Sept. 16

ZSI to organize exhibition on Island Faunal Diversity from Sept. 10 to 14

World Ozone Day also recognized as the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer, is a yearly event observed on 16th September. The date was designated by the United Nations General Assembly in 1994, commemorating the date in 1987 when nations signed the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer. This special day aims to draw attention of everyone on this planet towards the usefulness of ozone

layer, how it protects us from UV rays and how we need to protect it from damaging chemicals. The theme of World Ozone Day 2024 is 'Ozone for Life,' underscoring the beneficial outcomes of the Montreal Protocol in fostering the recovery of the ozone layer and mitigating climate change.

In this connection, the EIACP Centre on Island Biodiversity, Zoological Survey of India, Port Blair will be organizing an exhibition at its premises at Haddo on Island Faunal Diversity from Sept. 10

to 14 as part of celebration of World Ozone Day 2024 through preserved faunal specimens, posters, pamphlets and videos. The EIACP Centre has invited the student, teachers, and public to witness the exhibition and see the unique animal diversity. 3045 beneficiaries received benefits during FY 23-24 under this scheme in A&N Islands

Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakaram (JSSK) is an initiative to provide completely free and cashless services to pregnant women including normal deliveries and caesarean operations and sick new born (up to 1 year after birth) in Government health institutions in both rural & urban areas.

Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India has launched the JSSK on 1st June, 2011 in view of the difficulty being faced by the pregnant women and parents of sick new-born alongwith high out of pocket expenses incurred by them on delivery and treatment of sick- new-born. The scheme is to benefit pregnant women who access Government health facilities for their delivery. Moreover it will motivate those who still choose to deliver at their homes to opt for institutional deliveries.

According to data received from Directorate of Health Services, entitled



benefits were extended to institutional deliveries under JSSK and altogether, 3045 beneficiaries received benefits during (April 2023 to March 2024) under this scheme in A&N Islands. The scheme has eliminated out of pocket expenses incurred by the pregnant women and sick new borne while accessing services at Government health facilities.

The following are the Free Entitlements for pregnant women:

- Free and cashless delivery
- Free C-Section
- Free drugs and consumables
- Free diagnostics
- Free diet during stay in the health institutions
- Free provision of blood
- Free transport from home to health institutions
- Free transport between facilities in case of referral
- Free drop back from Institutions to home after 48 hrs stay

The following are the Free Entitlements for Sick new borns till 1 year after birth:

- Free treatment
- Free drugs and consumables
- Free diagnostics
- Free provision of blood
- Exemption from user charges
- Free Transport from Home to Health Institutions
- Free Transport between facilities in case of referral
- Free drop back from Institutions to home.

A&N Police issues public advisory on fake stock market investment Website/Apps

Sponsored Advertisements featuring deep fake videos and images of prominent individuals are currently being disseminated across platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, and Google which are redirecting users to fraudulent WhatsApp/Telegram groups operated by cyber fraudsters, falsely presented as legitimate trading groups, investment advice platforms, or financial advisors. Within these groups, cyber fraudsters disseminate information regarding Stock Market, Stock Tips, Live Classes, and lure citizens to open Institutional Accounts with them to gain maximum profit through confirm Initial Public Offering (IPO) allotments. Cyber criminals share Play store/Appstore links or apk files of fake trading applications with potential victims for trading purposes. Indian mule bank accounts are

• Avoid sharing sensitive financial information like bank details or login credentials with unknown entities.
• Stay aware of common investment scams and remain sceptical of offers that seem too good to be true like promising unrealistically high returns.
