Under the guidance of Shri Amit Kale, IAS, Secretary, PBMC, this initiative aims to safeguard the health of the Council's Safai Mitras. By prioritizing their health, the campaign seeks to ensure that these essential workers, who play a pivotal role in maintaining the cleanliness and hygiene of the

## District Administration, SA conducts raid in compliance with COTPA Act, 2003

### Significant quantity of banned tobacco products seized from vendors flouting the law



Port Blair, Sept. 9

In a concerted effort to ensure the implementation of Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA), 2003, a raid was carried out within the designated 100-yard perimeter of Educational Institutions in the village of Haddo. The operation, led by the area Patwari in coordination with other

Revenue field officials, specifically targeted vendors illicitly indulged in trading prohibited tobacco products.

As per the legal mandate of COTPA, 2003, the sale of tobacco and related products within a 100-yard radius of schools and educational institutions is strictly forbidden. This raid forms part of

the District Administration's ongoing initiatives to protect the health and wellbeing of students and the younger population.

During the enforcement action, a significant quantity of banned tobacco products was seized from vendors flouting the law. The seized items, deemed harmful

to public health, were confiscated by the enforcement team to prevent further circulation.

The District Administration of South Andaman reiterates its commitment to rigorously enforcing laws that protect public health, especially those aimed at safeguarding children and youth from
