The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the National PM Vishwakarma Program in Wardha, Maharashtra today. The Prime Minister launched the 'Acharya Chanakya Skill Development' scheme and 'Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Women Startup Scheme'. Shri Modi laid the foundation stone of PM Mega Integrated Textile Regions and Apparel (PM MITRA) Park at Amravati, Maharashtra. The Prime Minister took a walkthrough of the exhibition showcased on the occasion.

### Rededication of the vessel stands testament to meticulous planning and perseverance of Shipping Department: CS

#### Vessel set to make its maiden sailing to Strait Island on Sept. 23

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS, today rededicated the service of MV Shompen as Hospital Ship during a function organized by the Directorate of Shipping Services, A&N Administration at Phoenix Bay Jetty here this morning. The Secretary, Shipping, Ms Purva Garg, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Director, ANIMS, Dr. Pragya Sharma, Director, Health Services, Dr. Suja Antony, Director, Shipping, Capt.

Atul Kumar Singh and other senior officials from Directorate of Shipping Services, Health Services were present on the occasion. Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Secretary while complementing the efforts of DSS stated that with the dedication and a novel thinking, something could be revived which was almost gone. **Raksha Mantri flags-in first-of-its-kind Open Water Swimming Expedition to 21 Islands of Andaman & Nicobar archipelago named after Param Vir Chakra awardees**  
**Shri Rajnath Singh lauds the team for overcoming numerous challenges & bringing the stories of valour & sacrifice of the Param Virs to the people**  
**11 Service & Coast Guard personnel carry out over 300 kms of 'Unassisted Open Water Swim' for five months & unfurled the National Flag at each Island**

New Delhi, Sept. 20 (PIB)  
Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh, today, flagged-in, in New Delhi, a first-of-its-kind Open Water Swimming Expedition to the 21 Islands of the Andaman & Nicobar archipelago named after the Param Vir Chakra (PVC) Awardees. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi had named 21 largest unnamed Islands of Andaman & Nicobar after the PVC awardees on January 23, 2023 on Parakram Diwas commemorating the birth anniversary of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose.

To commemorate the first anniversary of the renaming, the Tri-service Andaman & Nicobar Command launched 'Expedition Param Vir', wherein a team of personnel from the Indian Army, Indian Navy, Indian Air Force and Indian Coast Guard undertook swimming to all the 21 Islands as a tribute to the valour & sacrifice of the 21 gallantry awardees and unfurled the National Flag at each Island. The 11-member expedition team was led by the acclaimed open water swimmer and Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Awardee Wing Commander Paramvir Singh.

In his address, the Raksha Mantri commended the courage & ability of the team, which successfully completed the expedition by overcoming numerous challenges at sea, and brought the stories of valour & sacrifice of the Param Virs to the people. He stated that the expedition was in line with the Government's efforts towards ensuring that the gallant deeds of our soldiers, who sacrificed themselves in the service of the nation, are known to the people, especially the youth, and that these bravehearts become their heroes. He expressed hope that the Armed Forces personnel will continue to bring glory to the nation and be a source of inspiration for the youth.

During the event, the Expedition Flag was handed over to the Raksha Mantri by the team. The flag was witness to the entire expedition, its challenges, camaraderie and finally the successful completion. It represents the cause and stirs emotions of patriotism and pride. Chief of Defence Staff General Anil Chauhan, Chief of the Army Staff General Upendra Dwivedi, Commander-in-Chief of the Andaman & Nicobar Command (CINCAN) Air Marshal Saju Balakrishnan and other senior officials were present during the flag-in ceremony.

The expedition was formally flagged-off by CINCAN on the occasion of World Water Day on March 22, 2024 from Sri Vijaya Puram, with an inaugural swim to the Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Dweep. The team swam to all 21 Islands, more than 300 kms, over a period of five months. The expedition culminated on 78<sup>th</sup> Independence Day on August 15, 2024. The final swim was undertaken by 78 personnel from the Armed Forces and the Coast Guard, swimming from the Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Dweep to the Sri Vijaya Puram.

All the swimmers undertook the expedition as per the International standards and regulations for the category of 'Unassisted Open Water Swim', which mandate that swimmers can be attired only in swim trunks, goggles and caps. During the expedition, the swimmers faced a number of challenges, which included severe exhaustion, extreme dehydration, sunburns and turbulent sea conditions. There were also multiple encounters with deadly marine life in the area. The entire expedition was undertaken without a single mishap, a stupendous achievement considering the fact that a majority of the participating personnel were undertaking an Open Water Sea Swim for the first time.

The Ministry of Women & Child Development, GoI circulated National Minimum Standards and Protocol for Creches (Operation & Management) for the active participation and leadership of women which are vital for women in labor force participation. The institutionalization of care services is crucial for enhancing female workforce participation. Suggestive standards and protocol have been formulated for setting up Creches by any Individual/Service Agencies/Corporations/Companies/Universities/Hospitals/Care Service Providers/Government Organizations/Non-Governmental Organizations, etc., addressing the minimum essential requirements. These standards and protocol aim to provide comprehensive childcare in a safe and secure environment, fostering the overall development of children. Additional facilities may be incorporated to further enhance the well-being of children. Ministry of Women and Child Development, GoI has issued comprehensive Minimum Standards for establishing UT Creches. The Administrations have also been advised to adopt these standards and protocols for setting up and managing Creches. Accordingly, Ministry of Women and Child Development, GoI has issued comprehensive Minimum Standards for establishing concerned individual or organization, who are operating Creches shall download 'the National Minimum Standard and Protocol for Creches' from the Ministry's website: wcd.nic.in for necessary action, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

**Bar and POL owners directed to strictly comply with due dates for VAT remittance**

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 20  
It has been observed that some Bar owners and POL (Petroleum, Oil & Lubricant) owners are not remitting their Value Added Tax (VAT) on a monthly basis within the due dates as notified vide F.No.1-1/DC (SA)/VAT (PF)/2017-18/5974 dated 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020 issued by the Commissioner (VAT), A & N Islands. This non-compliance constitutes a gross violation of VAT Rules and results in a significant loss to the Government exchequer. Therefore, all Bar owners and POL owners have been once again directed to strictly comply with the due dates as per the aforementioned notification provided as under:

Sl. No.	Particular	Time Prescribed	Due Date
1.	Payment of Tax	Monthly	21 <sup>st</sup> day of each succeeding month
2.	Submission of Return	Quarterly	28 <sup>th</sup> day of each succeeding Quarter

Further, it is clarified that, henceforth all the Value Added Tax Returns shall be submitted at the Office of the Value Added Tax Officer (HQ) situated at RCS Office, VIP Road, Sri Vijaya Puram. This directive is issued in the interest of maintaining proper tax compliance and ensuring the financial health of the Government exchequer, a press release from VATO (HQ), RCS Office said.

traditional skills as a roadmap to propel India to be a developed country. Pointing out that our age-old traditional skills were the basis of many glorious chapters of India's prosperity, he said that our art, engineering, science and metallurgy was unmatched in the entire world. "We were the world's largest textile manufacturer", highlighted Shri Modi. "There was no match to pottery and the buildings designed back in the day", added the Prime Minister. Carpenter, blacksmith, goldsmith, potter, sculptor, cobbler, carpenter-mason and many such professionals used to be the foundation of India's prosperity and spread this knowledge and science to every home, said Shri Modi. Remarking that the Britishers hatched many conspiracies to wipe out these indigenous skills, Shri Modi said from this very land of Wardha, Gandhiji promoted rural industry.

Highlighting that the present Government resolved to bring new energy to traditional skills after 70 years of independence, the Prime Minister mentioned that 'Samman, Samarthya, Samridhi', ("Respect, Capability and Prosperity) make for the spirit of PM Vishwakarma Yojana". The Prime Minister said our objective is respect for the traditional crafts, empowerment of artisans and prosperity for Vishwakarmas.

The Prime Minister drew attention to the large-scale and unprecedented collaborations of different Departments to make PM Vishwakarma a success and informed that more than 700 districts, 2.5 lakh Gram Panchayats, 5000 urban local units are giving momentum to the scheme. In the last year, Shri Modi added, more than 20 lakh people with 18 different traditional skills have been connected to PM Vishwakarma Yojana. Skill training and upgradation have been provided to more than 8 lakh artisans and craftsmen with the introduction of modern machinery and digital tools. More than 60,000 people have received skill training in Maharashtra alone. Prime Minister Modi informed that more than 6 lakh Vishwakarmas have been provided with modern equipment to help boost productivity and the quality of produce, an e-voucher of Rs 15,000, and loans up to Rs 3 lakh without guarantee to expand their businesses. The Prime Minister expressed satisfaction that loans worth Rs 1400 crore have been given to Vishwakarmas within a year.

Noting the contributions of the SC, ST and OBC communities towards traditional skills, the Prime Minister shed light on the statistics of the previous year and said that the SC, ST and OBC communities are taking the maximum benefit of Vishwakarma Yojana. Expressing his desire for the people of the Vishwakarma community to not only remain mere artisans but become entrepreneurs and business owners, the Prime Minister mentioned providing MSME status to the work done by Vishwakarmas. He spoke about efforts like One District One Product and Ekta Mall where traditional products are being marketed to make Vishwakarmas a part of the supply chain of big companies.

PM Modi touched upon ONDC and GEM which have become a medium for artisans and craftsmen to expand their businesses. He underlined that the societal class which lagged in economic progress will now play a crucial role in the world's third-largest economy. "Skill India Mission is strengthening it further", he said. Under the skill development program, Shri Modi informed that crores of youth in the country have received training according to today's needs. Underlining that India's skills are being recognized around the world with programs like Skill India, Shri Modi informed with pride that India won multiple awards at a huge event on world skills organized in France earlier this year.

Highlighting the pace of the work being done on PM Mitra Park, Shri Modi remarked that the willpower of the double engine Government was displayed. "7 PM MITRA Parks will be established across India", exclaimed Shri Modi. He said that the vision included a complete cycle of Farm to Fibre, Fibre to Fabric, Fabric to Fashion, Fashion to Foreign, meaning that the high-quality fabric would be made from Vidarbha's cotton and the clothes made out of the fabric according to fashion will be exported to foreign countries. He explained further that this would stop the losses incurred by farmers and enable them to fetch good prices for their crops as there will be value addition. Highlighting that there was a possibility of an investment of 8-10 thousand crores from PM Mitra Park alone, Shri Modi said that it would help create more than one lakh new employment opportunities for the youth in Vidarbha and Maharashtra along with a boost to other industries as well. He added that New supply chains would be created which will help the country's exports leading to an increase in income. Shri Modi also emphasized that Maharashtra was gearing up for the modern infrastructure and connectivity needed for this industrial progress. He added that this included new highways, expressways, Samruddhi Mahamarg along with expansion of water and air connectivity. "Maharashtra has geared up for a new industrial revolution", exclaimed Shri Modi.

Expressing confident that this ship will be able to go to the areas where it is very difficult for the patients to come and especially by road if they have to travel, they have to face inconveniences, the Chief Secretary said, "This ship will be a great relief for all those who would not be able to travel by road and also proactively this ship can go to different areas and cater to the needs of all those tribal populace and the general public of this archipelago."

The Chief Secretary further stated that with the first voyage set for Strait Island where the Andamanese tribe lives, this endeavour would immensely benefit all of them especially in terms of medical support and help. The Chief Secretary concluded his address by congratulating the crew members, the entire team of Shipping Services and all those who made it possible to see this day and bestowed his best wishes to doctors as they prepare to deliver services as per the needs and desires of the community.

Earlier, welcoming the gathering, the Director, Shipping stated that the rededication ceremony of the vessel MV Shompen today, marks an important step in the Shipping sector. This vessel will once again serve as a Hospital Ship for the Andaman and Nicobar Administration.

Sharing a brief history of the vessel, the Director informed that among the foreshore vessels, MV Shompen was the first one procured by the Administration in 2001. Following its



acquisition, this vessel was dedicated to healthcare services as a Hospital Ship. During the devastating tsunami of 2004, she played a crucial role, ensuring that even the most remote areas of these Islands received adequate medical coverage, he said. However, due to the shortage of vessels in the foreshore sector over the years, DSS was forced to halt her service as a Hospital Ship. Since then, she primarily operated as a passenger vessel, particularly in the Campbell Bay area.

The Director further remarked that, in the past two years, DSS has seen an increase in operational vessels within the foreshore sector. Today, the Directorate of Shipping Services has 10 fully operational vessels. With this capacity, it is now in a strong position and has made the decision to re-dedicate MV Shompen as a Hospital Ship. He said, the vessel has the capacity to carry 16 patients who are not on stretchers, and 4 patients who are on stretcher. In addition, with the cooperation of DHS, ANIMS staff, the crew will support the medical teams during the trips to conduct medical camps in different parts of the Island. He said, arrangements have also been made for doctors to be on board, along with essential hospital equipment. In the coming months, DSS aim to establish a small operation theatre on this vessel.

He further informed that the primary role of MV Shompen will be as a healthcare vessel. Medical camps will be held at various remote locations, and DSS will begin this effort with a mission to Strait Island this coming Monday (Sept. 23). A full medical team from ANIMS will conduct health check-ups for all the tribals residing there. In addition, the vessel will continue to transport passengers from North and Middle Andaman. Importantly, it will also be on standby for emergencies, ensuring swift and reliable medical response when needed, the Director added.

Soon after rededicating the vessel, the Chief Secretary and others inspected the facilities onboard the vessel. The function concluded with the vote of thanks.

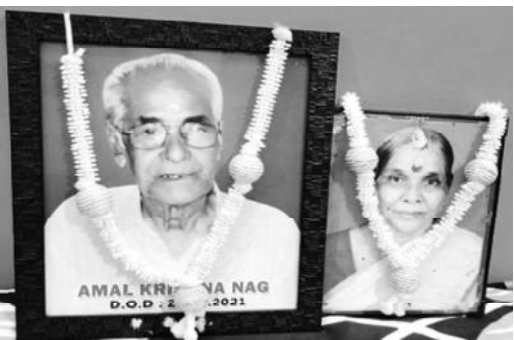
