## Bharat has emerged as the most buoyant economy in the world that has 8% growth prospects for decades to come: VP

New Delhi, Sept. 25 (PIB)

The Hon'ble Vice-President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar today stated that Bharat is now one of the most buoyant economies in the world and a favorite destination for global investment. Delivering the inaugural address at the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition of the Uttar Pradesh International Trade Show 2024, held in Greater Noida today, Shri Dhankhar highlighted, "Today, Bharat is a near \$4 trillion economy that has 8% growth prospects for decades to come. India is now a global happening place and Uttar Pradesh, the state bubbling with activity".

Praising the country's infrastructure development, Shri Dhankhar cited addition of 8 new airports annually, rapid expansion of metro systems, and the daily construction of 28



kilometres of highway. Shri Dhankhar pointed to the 12 new industrial zones taking shape under Prime Minister Modi's leadership, which will boost manufacturing and position India to capitalize on emerging technologies like AI, electric mobility, and semiconductors.

The Vice-President emphasized the significant advancements in India's

infrastructure, stating, "We now have the world's second-largest metro network, and the number of cities with airports has doubled from 70 to 140. India is the largest connected nation globally, with over 800 million broadband users." He further highlighted the impact of digital technologies, which have enabled housing for 170 million people, health coverage for 60

million, and loans for 58 million small businesses annually.

"In terms of digital financial transactions, India records the highest globally, with 13 billion transactions per month. Additionally, we boast the world's third-largest startup ecosystem, featuring 117 unicorns and the third-largest purchasing power in the world," he noted. Shri Dhankhar also underscored the

importance of the semiconductor industry, stating, "This industry, which is critical to our growth, is projected to surpass \$55 billion by 2026. I have no doubt this century belongs to Bharat", he noted.

Additionally, the Vice-President highlighted Bharat's remarkable leap from "Make in India" to "Conceptualize, Design, and Make in India." He noted that India is now engaged in its own concept evolution, with both multinational corporations and Indian companies adopting a synergetic stance.

This event, Shri Dhankhar remarked, aligns with Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's vision of an 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' and embraces the motto of 'Local to Global.' "First, it was 'Vocal for Local,' and

## DHS in collaboration with DSS conduct Multi-Specialty Health Camp for Andamanese Tribe onboard Hospital Ship MV Shompen



Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 25

The Directorate of Health Services, in collaboration with the Directorate of Shipping Services (DSS) organized a Multi-Specialty Health Camp for the Andamanese Tribe on September 23, 2024. This initiative took place onboard the newly inaugurated hospital ship, MV Shompen, which was officially launched by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra,

IAS, on September 20, 2024.

The ship embarked on its maiden sailing to Strait Island on Sept. 23 at 6 am and reached the Island after three & half hours. A dedicated medical team comprising of two Doctors, an Ophthalmic Assistant, a Lab Technician, a Clinical Psychologist, an Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (ANM), and a Yoga Instructor was onboard to provide comprehensive health

services.

Upon arrival, the team met the local health workers and encouraged tribal members to attend the Super Specialty Clinic for thorough medical examinations onboard. The team examined 20 tribal members, including 13 male and 7 female. Common health issues identified included hypertension, diabetes, chronic kidney disease (CKD), trauma, lower back pain, and skin

infections such as tinea versicolor etc.

Additionally, 13 individuals underwent vision tests, out of which, 7 cases were recommended glasses. The Clinical Psychologist provided a general talk on mental health issues and ill effects of addiction and also counseling for four individuals seeking help with addiction. The Yoga Instructor also conducted a session to promote a

ORDER

WHEREAS, It has come to the notice of the undersigned that certain private medical practitioners/doctors are issuing medical rest/medical leave certificates with malafide intent without adequately verifying the factual details of the cases which creates unnecessary hindrances in government operations.

AND WHEREAS, many of such certificates issued with malafide intentions by private doctors have been rejected by the Medical Board of Government Hospitals. Moreover, many government doctors have also raised the issue time and again at different forums. Moreover, such unethical/wrong practices also tend to tarnish the reputation of the entire medical fraternity.

AND WHEREAS, It is essential that all medical practitioners should meticulously verify the reasons provided by individuals seeking medical leave and ensure that certificates issued by them are based on accurate and genuine assessment. Certificates issued without proper verification, especially those with malafide intentions, compromise the integrity of medical documentation and contribute to operational inefficiencies both in public and private sector activities.

NOW THEREFORE, keeping in view the reports and findings, I, Arjun Sharma, IAS, Chairman, District Registering Authority, South Andaman under the powers conferred upon me by the Clinical Establishment (Registration and Regulations) Act, 2010 and Andaman and Nicobar Islands Clinical Establishment (Registration and Regulations) Rules, 2013 hereby warn that if any case is brought to the knowledge of the undersigned wherein medical certificates have been issued with malafide intentions by private doctors and have been subsequently rejected by the Medical Board of a Government Hospital, stringent action will be taken against such medical practitioners. Such actions may inter-alia include, cancellation of their registration under the Clinical Establishment Act also. The government doctors are also advised to report any cases of incorrect or false medical leave certifications to the undersigned for further action in accordance with the Clinical Establishment Act.

This order be disseminated in general public for awareness and to all medical practitioners for taking note.

This Scheme is a sub scheme under Rashtriya Gokul Mission, a Government program designed to enhance livestock productivity and improve the genetic quality of cattle in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Approximately 90% of calves conceived using this method are female, which aims to significantly increase overall milk production. This effort supports national objectives to enhance dairy farming efficiency and achieve self-sufficiency in milk supply. Farmers can easily access this service by reaching out to their nearest Veterinary Hospital. The adoption of sex-sorted semen not only boosts the number of female calves in the Islands but also promotes the selective breeding of high-quality livestock, enhancing the genetic diversity of local cattle, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

- ♦ Minimizing the usage of heavy electrical appliances during energy peak hours to avoid overloading.
- ♦ Usage of generators or other alternate power sources for large scale lighting and decorations to reduce the load on the main grid.

This practice will help to avoid no light situations, if any and contribute to the smooth functioning of the power grid during the festive period. ORDER

Whereas, it has been made to appear to me that there is an apprehension that anti-social elements may make their hideous clandestinely in the residential/commercial areas of the South Andaman District. If suitable measures to prevent the same are not taken, the unlawful activities of these people can cause breach of peace and tranquility besides posing grave danger to human life and safety and injury to public property.

Now, therefore, I, Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, am of the opinion that some check vigil is necessary on landlords/owners/managers of the residential/commercial establishments while renting out or sub-letting the premises so that anti-social elements in the guise of ordinary tenants, domestic servants & Paying Guest may not cause harm to the citizen and that immediate action is necessary for prevention of the same.
