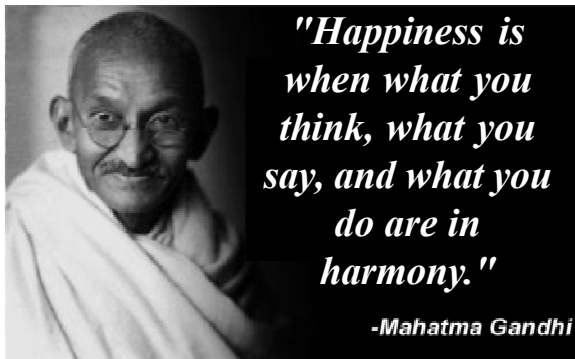

7th Anniversary of Ayushman Bharat -PM-JAY celebrated by State Health Agency

30,895 families (82,215 members) registered under AB PM-JAY scheme in isles and are eligible for cashless benefits

2,535 beneficiaries referred to empanelled hospitals in mainland

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 25

Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY) and Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) are two flagship initiatives of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, aimed at transforming the healthcare landscape of the nation by providing secure, reliable, and enhanced healthcare services to all citizens.

The State Health Agency (SHA), A&N Islands, the implementing body for AB PM-JAY and ABDM in the Union Territory celebrated the 7th anniversary of AB PM-JAY on Sept. 23 and will be celebrating the 4th anniversary of ABDM on Sept. 27. As



part of the anniversary celebration of AB PM-JAY, the Programme Management Unit (PMU), ABDM, A&N Islands, organized an awareness programme for students of

the Department of Political Science, JNRM. The event included an orientation session on ABDM and an essay competition. An ABHA card generation drive was also conducted, during

which, 61 new ABHA cards were created for participating students.

Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY) was launched on 23rd September, 2018. AB PM-JAY aims to provide cashless treatment up to Rs. 5 lakh per family per year for secondary and tertiary hospitalizations. As of now, 30,895 families (82,215 members) have been registered under the AB PM-JAY scheme in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands and are eligible for cashless benefits. As on date, 2,535 beneficiaries from the UT have been referred to empanelled hospitals in mainland under this scheme.

drains and garbage sites contributes to the spread of flies, mosquitoes, and other vectors, thereby increasing the risk of epidemics like dengue, malaria, and diarrhoeal diseases. The accumulation of waste from Pig Sheds further aggravates these risks by contaminating the local environment.

Apart from public health concerns, stray pigs roaming on roads create traffic hazards, often leading to accidents, congestion, and damage to civic infrastructure. Such practices also lower the quality of life for residents and hinder the collective efforts towards achieving a clean, healthy and liveable city.

In light of these pressing concerns, the Municipal Council has issued the following instructions for strict compliance:

- ◆ All pig sheds, pens, or enclosures within residential areas or within the Municipal limits must be removed or relocated to designated pig shed, Brookshabad within 3 days from the date of this press release.
- ◆ Pig owners must ensure that their animals do not stray on to public roads, drains, footpaths, vacant plots, or neighbouring premises.

In the event of non-compliance, the Municipal Council shall be constrained to capture, remove, and relocate the pigs to designated sheds at the risk and cost of the owners. The Council shall not be held liable for any loss or damage to the animals during such operations. Violations of these directives will invite suitable action against the owners of pigs in accordance with the Municipal Bye-Laws and other applicable legal provisions.

The Municipal Council appeals to all residents to extend full cooperation in this matter. The general public have been requested to pass the information of the pig owners who rears pigs in the city. Civic responsibility rests not only with the authorities but also with every individual in the community.

This initiative is being undertaken in the larger public interest of safeguarding public health, maintaining traffic safety, and ensuring that the city remains clean and healthy, a press release from SVPMC said.
