### District Administration, SA conducts Camp Court at GP Namunagar to address local concerns & development initiatives



Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 28

In a focused effort to tackle critical infrastructure challenges and promote sustainable development, a Camp Court was organized at the Gram Panchayat, Namunagar, led by Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Deputy Commissioner of South Andaman.

During the meeting, the Pradhan of the Gram Panchayat presented a range of issues affecting the local community,

including poor road conditions, inconsistent power supply, water management concerns, healthcare access, and the need for improvements in educational infrastructure. These concerns were formally brought to the attention of the Deputy Commissioner, who discussed potential solutions to enhance the overall quality of life for the residents. Key issues highlighted



included deteriorated rural roads, frequent power outages, the need for toilet construction and infrastructural upgrades at the Community Hall in the Fishermen's Colony, establishment of a 30-meter buffer zone for roads and power lines in areas near forests, the installation of a Floating Jetty at Mithakhari, and the upgradation of Government Senior Secondary School at

Namunagar, including adequate playground facilities. Additionally, concerns were raised about healthcare accessibility, irregular water supply, inadequate water tankers, the maintenance of sluice gates, the relocation of a high-risk transformer, the installation of benches and eco-huts, unlocking tourism potential at Viper Island, and repair of the Dundas

## Advanced cancer surgeries performed successfully at GB Pant Hospital/ ANIIMS



Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 28

Only over one week, two major cancer surgeries have been performed in two senior citizens using laparoscope ensuring minimal access by Surgery Department of GB Pant Hospital, ANIIMS. The first case was of a 67 year old lady, who was presented with recurrent pain in abdomen and vomiting. She was diagnosed with a

condition wherein one part of the intestine slides into the adjacent part of the intestine. Further, her condition was assessed using State of Art diagnostic procedure at GB Pant Hospital itself, which revealed a large tumour growth in large intestine. On 16<sup>th</sup> September, a team of Super Specialist Surgeons, headed by Dr. Saji Varghese performed an



advanced surgery using a laparoscope to remove the tumour ensuring minimum surgical incision.

The second case was of a 74 year old man, who was presented with bleeding from anus. The patient was found to be normal on clinical examination. The doctors in GBPH/ANIIMS conducted colonoscopy, which revealed a large

growth in the large intestine, approximately 16 cm from the anal verge. The tissue was taken from the growth for biopsy. The biopsy was conducted in Pathology Department of ANIIMS, which revealed a well differentiated cancer of large intestines. The contrast enhanced CT scan evaluation further confirmed that the tumour had only local presence

## First-ever Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Station inaugurated in Sri Vijaya Puram

Station will provide timely and accurate data on air pollution levels, enabling better environmental management

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 28

The first-ever Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Station (CAAQMS) in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands was inaugurated at VIP Road near ITF Ground, Sri Vijaya Puram, South Andaman. This Station is part of a nationwide initiative by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), New Delhi to install CAAQMS in all States and Union Territories (UTs) to monitor real-time air quality. The initiative aims to provide timely and accurate data on air pollution levels, enabling better environmental management.

The Station was inaugurated by Shri



A.S.P.S Raviprakash, IAS, Secretary (Science and Technology) -cum-Chairman (ANPCC), in the presence of Shri Abhishek Bhukal, Director (Science and Technology) cum-Member Secretary (ANPCC) on Sept. 25, 2024.

During the inauguration, the Secretary, Science and Technology -cum-Chairman (ANPCC) appreciated the efforts of the Department in setting up the CAAQMS, highlighting the Station's capability to provide real-time ambient air quality

24x7 throughout the year. The project in Sri Vijaya Puram has been made possible with financial assistance and technical support from the CPCB, New Delhi. The Andaman and Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) has procured the CAAQMS for Sri Vijaya Puram, South Andaman, with financial and technical support provided by the CPCB for the procurement and installation. ## District Administration, SA takes compassionate stand against Vagrancy and Begging

In a compassionate and determined effort to restore dignity to the lives of the most vulnerable, the District Administration, South Andaman has initiated a far-reaching anti-vagrancy and beggary drive across Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council area. Special focus was given to the safety and rehabilitation of children, women, and differently-abled individuals found begging-people who often find themselves without a voice or support system. The teams spoke with shopkeepers, transport

operators, and residents, encouraging them to become part of the solution by reporting any further cases of begging.

The drive extended to some of the most frequented and busy areas, such as Chakkar Gaon, Corbyn Chowk, Garacharma, Junglighat, Delanipur, Haddo, and Chatham. Even in places of worship-temple and mosques, the team connected with the community, sharing insights and urging collaboration in identifying those in need.

The general public have been requested to be the Administration's eyes and ears in this mission of compassion. Key Helplines, such as the District Control Room (1075) and the Child Helpline (1098), were

shared widely, so citizens can report instances of vagrancy, especially when it involves vulnerable children or differently-abled individuals.

The District Administration reminds all, the power of unity and compassion in making our city beggar-free, while also ensuring that no one is left behind in the shadows of poverty. Through continued drives, this initiative will focus not only on removing vagrancy but on bringing hope and new beginnings to those who need it most. ## Two new Khelo India Centres under Khelo India Scheme approved for UT of A&N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 28

In the 47<sup>th</sup> Departmental Project Approval Committee (DPAC) meeting for Khelo India Scheme held on 20.09.24 under the chairmanship of Smti. Sujata Chaturvedi, IAS, Secretary (Sports), Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, two New Khelo India Centres (KICs) under the flagship Khelo India Scheme have been approved for the UT

of Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

The two Khelo India Centre will be opened at IRBn, Port Mout and Armed Police Unit (APU), Police Line for Boxing and Kayaking respectively. With this, the A&N Police has become the first in India to open Khelo India Centres in its premises.

In the Khelo India Centres, training will be imparted to general

public by Past Champion Athletes (PCA). Under this, a total funding of Rs 10 lakhs as non-recurring and 17 lakhs as recurring grant will be provided by Sports Authority of India (SAI), Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports to Andaman & Nicobar Police.

SAI Khelo India Nodal Officer, A&N Islands has congratulated the whole team of Sports Authority of India, MYAS, New

Delhi for their constant support and expressed gratitude to the Director General of Police and Superintendent of Police (APU), A&N Police for their collaboration. ## ICMR-National Institute of Nutrition, Hyderabad granted in principle approval for conducting Diet and Biomarkers Survey in A&N Islands

Findings along with recommendations to be shared with Administration to improve nutritional conditions in the UT

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 28

The Andaman and Nicobar Administration, through the Department of Health Services (DHS), has given its in-principle approval for the 'Diet and Biomarkers Survey in India (DABS-I)' to be conducted by the ICMR-National Institute of Nutrition (NIN), Hyderabad. The survey, which aims to assess the nutritional status and health bio markers of the

local population, has been officially endorsed by A&N Administration.

This extensive survey, which covers all 28 States and Union Territories of India, including the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, was formally inaugurated on 08/07/2024. The initiative, led by the ICMR-NIN, Hyderabad, a reputed institution under the Department of Health Research (DHR), Ministry

of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, seeks to provide comprehensive insights into the nation's nutritional health.

The survey is being conducted by two dedicated teams led by Junior Medical Officers, Dr. Ayasha Umera Khan and Dr. Shweta with Dr. Anoop Gautam as the DABS Andaman Incharge, while Dr. Sai Ram, Scientist-E and DABS

State Coordinator will oversee the project's execution.

The survey has already been completed in 31 Primary Sampling Units (PSUs) in the South Andaman district. Now, from 29<sup>th</sup> September, the Survey will continue in North & Middle Andaman District and will further be extended to the Nicobar District starting from 1<sup>st</sup> November.
