The Electricity Department, A&N Administration, encourages all residents of the islands to come forward and avail the benefits of this transformative scheme. Under the PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana, a subsidy of up to ₹2,02,800 is provided for rooftop solar installations of up to 3 kW capacity.

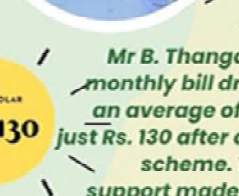

Dr. Dilip Kumar Jha, Officer-In-Charge, NIOT-ACOSTI and Dr. K. Gopal, Joint Director (Fisheries).

The chief guest, Ms. Jyoti Kumari, in her address, underlined the Department's consistent efforts, with the technical support of NIOT, to promote seaweed cultivation through trainings, workshops, and field studies. She noted that six months of preparatory work by NIOT had culminated this initiative and announced the Department's plans to take seaweed cultivation further towards processing and commercialization. She urged students and SHG members to build on this initiative by creating knowledge on seaweed cultivation in the Islands. She also pointed out that scaling up the harvest will be crucial to making seaweed processing a viable industry in the near future.

The SHG members, students from JNRM and Pondicherry University, and officials from the Fisheries and Rural Development Departments also attended the inaugural session.

Speaking on the occasion, Director of Fisheries, Ms. Jagtap Kalyani Rajendra, appreciated the participation of SHG members and students, describing the initiative as a milestone towards commercial seaweed cultivation in the Islands. She expressed gratitude to NIOT for its technical support, acknowledging their research studies and workshops that have laid a strong foundation for this venture. Encouraging SHG members to make the most of this opportunity, she remarked that the training would serve as an important step in promoting seaweed farming at a commercial scale by empowering local communities.

Welcoming the gathering, Officer-In-Charge, NIOT-ACOSTI highlighted the training's focus on practical aspects such as raft preparation, mooring, deployment, and cultivation techniques. He emphasized that seaweed cultivation holds immense potential as an alternative livelihood for the Island community, providing both economic opportunities and ecological benefits.

The inaugural day programme featured a series of insightful technical sessions, where Dr. K. Gopal, Joint Director (Fisheries) spoke on the Prospects of Fisheries and Mariculture, Dr. T. Ganesh, Associate Professor, Pondicherry University, elaborated on the importance of seaweeds, and Dr. Dipon Sharmah, Assistant Professor, JNRM, connected seaweed cultivation to the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda, Dr. J. Santhanakumar, Scientific Officer, NIOT covered aspects on safety measurement for seaweed farming, Dr. M. Savurirajan, Dr. Aron Santhosh Kumar and Dr. R. Karuna Kumari Project Scientists of NIOT, detailed about culture techniques with special reference to Gracilaria edulis. Their talk emphasised the economic, ecological, and livelihood potential of seaweed farming, inspiring SHG members to explore opportunities for tapping into mainland markets in the future.

The programme was attended by over 30 prospective employers, aimed to raise awareness about the Government of India's Rs. 1 lakh crore initiative to generate over 3.5 crore jobs nationwide from August 1, 2025, to July 31, 2027.

Shri Vishakh O.T, Assistant Labour Commissioner, briefed the participants on the objectives and key features of the PM-VBRY, a landmark Rs.1 lakh crore initiative of the Government of India aimed at generating over 3.5 crore jobs across the country between August 1, 2025, and July 31, 2027. He explained that the scheme will help achieve the Government's Viksit Bharat @2047 vision by promoting large-scale employment creation, particularly benefiting first-time job seekers. Key features of the PM-VBRY include:

♦ **Benefits for Employees:** First-time workers registered with EPFO, earning up to Rs.1 lakh/month, will receive up to Rs.15,000 in two installments via Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) after 6 and 12 months of continuous service, upon completing a Financial Literacy Course.

♦ **Benefits for Employers:** Monthly incentives of Rs.1,000- Rs. 3,000 per new hire, based on wage brackets, for two years (four years for manufacturing). Employers with fewer than 50 employees must hire at least 2 new workers annually, while those with over 50 must hire at least 5.

♦ **Eligibility:** Employees require Aadhaar-linked bank accounts, a Universal Account Number (UAN), and EPFO registration. Employers must be EPFO-registered and file monthly Electronic Challan cum Return (ECR).

♦ **Implementation:** Managed by the Ministry of Labour & Employment and EPFO, with registration available via the PMVBRY portal (pmvbry.epfindia.gov.in) or UMANG app.

During the programme, Shri Vishakh O.T. urged employers to make full use of the scheme to expand employment opportunities and support economic growth. He also addressed participants' queries and clarified procedural aspects. The session was also attended by Ms. Vijita Devi, Labour Inspector, Labour Department, and Ms. Nalini, Enforcement Officer, EPFO.

NAAT (Nucleic Acid Amplification Test) investigations be cleared at the earliest. He highlighted that timely testing and confirmation of cases are critical to prevent delay in treatment initiation and to break the chain of transmission.

The Deputy Commissioner also underlined that screening alone cannot achieve the objective of TB elimination. He emphasized the need for ensuring prompt treatment initiation, strict adherence to the prescribed regimen and full course completion by patients, as these remain the cornerstones of the TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan. He instructed Programme Officials and Medical Officers to put in place robust mechanisms for treatment follow-up, counselling of patients and their families and community-level awareness generation, to counter stigma and enhance compliance.

He further stressed on the importance of inter-departmental coordination and convergence with other line Departments, such as Education, Rural Development and Social Welfare, for creating a supportive ecosystem for TB patients. Special emphasis was laid on community engagement, with the Deputy Commissioner calling upon NGOs, Self Help Groups, Panchayati Raj Institutions and civil society to actively participate in spreading awareness, supporting TB patients, and promoting nutritional support through schemes like Nikshay Poshan Yojana.

The meeting also discussed the need for sustained monitoring and periodic review at every level, including village, block and district, to ensure that gaps in service delivery are addressed promptly and real-time progress is tracked effectively.

Concluding the meeting, the Deputy Commissioner reiterated the Administration's commitment to achieving the vision of a TB-free South Andaman well ahead of the national target year. He called upon all stakeholders to remain proactive, committed and united in their efforts, so that South Andaman can emerge as a model district in the fight against tuberculosis, a press release from DC (SA) said.
