South Andaman Police strike hard against narcotics; three peddlers nabbed in three different cases

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 5 In a determined and well-coordinated effort to combat the drug menace, Police Station Aberdeen has successfully arrested three (03) drug peddlers in three (03) separate cases and seized a total of 8.705 kgs of ganja and 1.68 grams of Methamphetamine during a series of targeted operations conducted last week.

A special team comprising of SI Samiran Mridha, HC Sunil Singh Yadav, PCs K. Jayraj, P. Mohd. Rafique, Jagdish Babu, Surender Singh Yadav and Anup Majh was constituted under the leadership of Insp. Vishal Ram, SHO PS Aberdeen. The team executed meticulously planned raids at multiple locations under the jurisdiction of PS Aberdeen.

On 28/08/2025, acting on credible intelligence, the team intercepted Alapati Mani Raju (27yrs) R/o Dollygunj near the Fisheries Training Centre, Sea Shore Road, Dignabad and recovered 8.120 kilograms of ganja from his possession. On 29/08/2025, another raid was carried out at Joggers Park area near Forest Nursery, Sri Vijaya Puram, resulting in the arrest of Kuldeep Singh (27 yrs), a private worker, R/o Goal Ghar with 585 grams of ganja. On 30/08/2025, the team continued its decisive action by raiding the backside of ITF Ground, Sri Vijaya Puram and apprehended C. Sathyapriya (26 yrs), S/o N. Chandran R/o Dairy Farm, with 1.68 grams of methamphetamine from his possession.

Subsequently, all individual accused have been booked under relevant section of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act 1985 at PS Aberdeen and further investigation of the cases are underway.

All the raids were conducted under the command of Shri Ajay Kumar Rai, SDPO South Andaman and over all supervision of Shri Manoj Kumar Meena, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District, a press release from SSP (SA) said.

It is brought to the Notice of the General Public and all concerned that Hinterland Seaman Union, Crusade House, Phoenix Bay, Sri Vijaya Puram Tehsil, South Andaman District is my client. That after collecting money from the members of the union the land bearing Survey No. 1624/1 alongwith building was purchased by the union in the year 2009 for a sale consideration in the name of the union, after demolishing the old building, the union collected funds from the members of the union and started constructed of a new building followed by obtaining loan. That after the construction of the building was completed, in December 2011 the part of the said building was let out on rent and in one part the office of the union was constructed. After the construction of the said building there were several issues pertaining to the monetary part by the earlier General Secretary of the union and as a consequence of which the union has decided to file a suit and as such in the month of August 2025, the union has filed Title Suit No. 81/2025 (Hinterland Seamen Union-vs-Shri P. Abdul Samad) before the Court of Civil Judge, Senior Division, South Andaman District at Port Blair against the earlier General Secretary, Shri P. Abdul Samad seeking a decree directing him to handover the physical possession of the subject land alongwith the triple storeyed to the union and to furnish all the accounts of the said building and rent collected and to deposit the same to the union.

That subsequently my client came to know that the earlier tenant who was running the business of hotel and restaurant vacated the said premises and Shri P. Abdul Samad is illegally intend to let out the said building to a third party though admittedly the property belongs to the union, as such on 11/08/2025 my client moved an application under Order XXXIX, Rule 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking an ad-interim injunction restraining P. Abdul Samad from letting out the part of the suit premises for running the business of hotel and restaurant to third party till the disposal of the suit and vide Order dated 11/08/2025, the Hon'ble Court allowed the said injunction application and directed the parties to maintain status quo till 11.09.2025.

Therefore, by means of the present Notice, I warn the General Public at large not to enter / involve into any agreement with P. Abdul Samad former General Secretary of the union in respect of the bar and restaurant in the building in land bearing Survey No. 1624/1, measuring an area of 135 Sq. mtrs. classified as house site situated at Phoenix Bay, Sri Vijaya Puram, South Andaman stand recorded in the union and if anyone is doing so, he / she / they will be doing so at his / her / their own risk and cost and will accordingly have to face the consequences thereof.




