Online awareness session on three new criminal laws organized by OSC

One Stop Centre (OSC) under the Directorate of Social Welfare organized an online awareness session on three new criminal laws namely, the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita replaces the Indian Penal Code, the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita replaces the Criminal Procedure Code of 1973 and the Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam replaces the Indian Evidence Act.

Dr. Nitin Shakya, Director (SW), emphasized the importance of the session in his address, these new laws are

designed to better align with the current needs, ensuring a more efficient and fair criminal justice system. Smti M. Janagi Savuriyammal, Case Worker, One Stop Centre briefed about the objectives of One Stop Centre, which provides integrated support and assistance to women affected by violence during distress in private and public spaces.

The resource person, Smti Nandini, Sub-Inspector, PS Aberdeen elaborated on the three new Criminal Laws and the key changes in the laws. Bhartiya Nyaya

Sanhita replaces the Indian Penal Code which retains the provisions of the IPC, reduces the number of sections from 511 to 358, increases penalties for several offences, and introduces many new offences, including hate crimes, mob lynching, terrorism, organized crime and hate speech and redefines sedition as Acts.

She further briefed about the sections that deal with offences against women and children which includes misbehavior by husband upon his wife during separation,

Major drug bust by South Andaman Police; over 2 kg of heroin worth Rs 14 crore seized and seven arrested

Port Blair, Sept. 11

In a major operation highlighting the unwavering commitment to the war on drugs, South Andaman District Police seized 2.075 kg of heroin. The operation was led by team of PS Bambooflat ably led by DySP Brij Mohan Meena and SHO Insp Rizwan Hasan. The seized contraband, with an estimated international market value exceeding Rs. 14 crores, led to the arrest of seven individuals. This marks the first time such a substantial quantity of heroin has been confiscated in the region.

The operation was initiated based on confidential information. On Aug.24, 2024, secret information was received regarding the matter and information shared with senior officers. Acting on the information, the Police team intercepted one



Athish Kumar, S/o Late Jaswant Lall, 42 yrs, Pvt. Contractor, R/o Prothrapur and a total of 1.295 kg of Heroin was recovered & seized from his possession and this resulted in the arrest of Athish Kumar. Upon his arrest, a case was registered under the relevant sections of

the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985 at PS Bambooflat and investigation of the case was entrusted to SI Manoj Lal of PS Bambooflat.

In an effort to bust the entire racket, further investigation revealed a broader network of

individuals involved in the illicit drug trade. Athish Kumar's revelation led to the identification and arrest of three additional suspects viz. Krishna Kumar Yadav, 46, LGC, Andaman Labour Force Office, residing in Bhatubasti; Vincent Lakra, 40, a teacher with Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, posted in Mayabunder and Shaiju P. Thomas, 45, Deck Petty Officer with DSS, residing in Garacharma.

The investigation uncovered that the seized heroin had been transported from Campbell Bay to Port Blair by Vincent Lakra, with the transit facilitated by Krishna Kumar Yadav. Further, Saiju P. Thomas & Athish Kumar retained some packets of contraband in Port Blair and sent two packets of heroin to Kolkata with plans to dispose it off at a lucrative price in mainland. When they failed to sell it off on their visit to Kolkata, they kept it in a sealed cover with one of their friend in Kolkata. They misled him by

The Ministry further informed that the following order of priority has been prescribed for allocation of aforesaid MBBS seats to the spouse or children of Civilian Victims of Terrorism:

- (a) Priority-I: Children whose both parents have been killed by terrorists.
- (b) Priority-II: Children of families whose sole bread earners has been killed by terrorists.
- (c) Priority-III: Wards of victims with permanent disability and serious injury caused by terrorist operations.

The eligibility Criteria are as under:-
(i) Candidate must either be spouse or children of the deceased/disabled civilian victim of terrorism.

(ii) He/She has completed 17 years of age at the time of admission or will complete that age on or before 31st December of the year of his/her admission to the first year of the Undergraduate Medical Course and is an Indian National.

(iii) Educational Qualification :The candidate must have passed in subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks (40% for SC-PWD/ST-PWD/OBC-PWD (Persons with Disability) category candidates) taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology at the qualifying examination of 12th Class.

(iv) Qualifying Percentile in NEET (UG)- 2024 :As per Graduate Medical Education Regulations of National Medical Commission, it shall be necessary for the candidates to obtain minimum marks at 50th percentile at NEET (UG)-2024. For SC, ST & OBC, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of candidates with special disability, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile.

Accordingly, applications in the prescribed format (Annexure-I), in duplicate enclosing all necessary documents have been invited from interested/eligible candidates for allocation of said MBBS seats earmarked from the Central Pool for spouse and children of Civilian Victims of Terrorism.

saying that the sealed cover contains hard disk and they will collect it whenever they come back to Kolkata. Based on this, SI Samiran Mridha was deputed to Kolkata, where he collaborated with SI Manish Narayan, who was in Kolkata on duty, and successfully seized 780 gms heroine.

Subsequent interrogations revealed the involvement of two more individuals namely Chinnaiah, 40, DRM (driver in Campbell Bay), who facilitated the transportation of the heroin and Vikram Singh Gill, 30, an Accountant in Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, residing at Shadipur, who had purchased heroin from Vincent Lakra. Chinnaiah revealed that the heroin had initially been found drifting ashore by Cosmas Lakra, 53, a DRM in the Campbell Bay Panchayat. Cosmas Lakra who has also been arrested in the case, had handed over the contraband to Vincent, marking the start of the illegal supply chain that was ultimately busted by the Police.

This large-scale seizure of heroin marks a significant victory for law enforcement in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, disrupting a well-organized drug trafficking network that spanned multiple regions and involved multiple actors from suppliers to distributors.

The investigation team consisted of SDPO Bambooflat, Shri Brij Mohan Meena, SHO Bambooflat, Insp Rizwan Hasan and included SI Manoj Lal, SI Samiran Mridha, HC Zubair, PC Suresh Kumar, PC A. Ali, LPC Naw Seesa, driver Constable M. Mohd. Basheer of PS Bambooflat.

The entire operation was carried out under the leadership of Smti Niharika Bhatt, IPS, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District with the supervision of Smti Sindhu Pillai, IPS, IGP (L&O) and Smti Varsha Sharma, IPS, DIGP (L&O) and overall guidance of Shri Hargobinder Singh Dhaliwal, IPS, Director General of Police, A&N Islands.

Combination of 'Siddha' Drugs Reduces Anemia in Adolescent Girls: Study

New Delhi, Sept. 11 (PIB)

A recent study published in the reputed Indian Journal of Traditional Knowledge (IJTK) by researchers conducting the PHI-Public Health Initiative claims the drug reduces anaemia among adolescent girls. The initiative was undertaken to mainstream the use of 'Siddha' drugs to combat anaemia.

The group of researchers from eminent Siddha institutions of the country, including the National Institute of Siddha (NIS), Ministry of Ayush; Xavier Research Foundation, Tamilnadu; and Velumailu Siddha Medical College & Hospital, Tamilnadu. The researchers found that ABMN (Annapeticenturam, Bavana katukkay, Matulai manappaku and Nellikkay lekiyam), a combination of Siddha drug treatment can improve the level of Haemoglobin as well as PCV-Packed cell volume, MCV-Mean Corpuscular Hemoglobin and MCH-Mean Corpuscular Hemoglobin in the anaemic adolescent girls.

The study observed 2,648 girls, of which 2,300 completed the standard 45-day programme. Reportedly, before the start of the programme, researchers dewormed the participants with Cuntaivarral curanam, and then a 45-day treatment of Annapeti centuram, Bavana katukkay, Matulai manappaku and Nellikkay lekiyam (ABMN) was given to all participants under observation.



The study noted that the presence of clinical features like breathlessness, fatigue, giddiness, headache, anorexia, and pallor was evaluated by the investigators before and after completion of the programme, along with Hemoglobin evaluation and biochemical estimations. Following the WHO guidelines, the cut-off point for anaemia was set as 11.9 mg/dl, haemoglobin level below 8.0 mg/dl considered as severe, between 8.0 to 10.9 mg/dl as moderate and mild between 11.0 to 11.9 mg/dl.

Further, the study reports that a laboratory investigation was done for haemoglobin, packed cell volume (PCV), mean corpuscular volume (MCV), mean corpuscular haemoglobin (MCH), red blood corpuscles (RBC), platelets, total WBC, neutrophils, lymphocytes and eosinophils in a randomly selected subset of 283 girls. The researchers found that ABMN significantly lowered the clinical

features of anaemia like fatigue, hair loss, headache, loss of interest and menstrual irregularities and significantly improved the level of Haemoglobin and PCV, MCV and MCH in all anaemic girls. While talking about the impact and importance of the study findings, Dr. R. Meenakumari, Director, National Institute of Siddha, also among the senior authors of the study, said, "Siddha medicine plays a notable role in Public Health Initiatives of the Ministry of Ayush. The awareness created among adolescent girls, dietary advice and preventive care provided to them and the treatment through Siddha drugs provided therapeutic benefits to the anaemic patients. Hence Siddha drugs for anaemia can contribute to public health by providing cost-effective and accessible treatment in various settings".

- > **Reducing Personal Impact:** Taking personal steps to reduce our carbon footprint and environmental impact, such as minimizing energy consumption and waste generation.

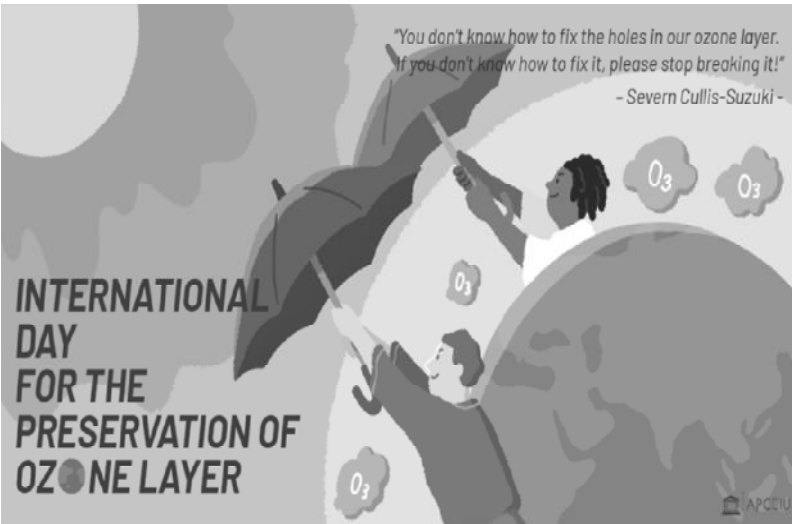
Don'ts:

(Hons) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons) Forestry, B.Sc. (Hons) Co-operation & Banking, B.Tech Biotechnology and B.Sc. (Hons) Climate Change and Environmental Science, the candidates should have passed in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or examination recognised equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together are eligible, will be calculated as the sum of marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and that for the course of B.Tech (Agri. Engg) and B.Tech (Food Technology) courses will be the sum of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics in the qualifying i.e. Plus Two examination. If there is tie in Science/ Mathematics marks, then the marks of English and then the marks of Additional language/second language will be considered.

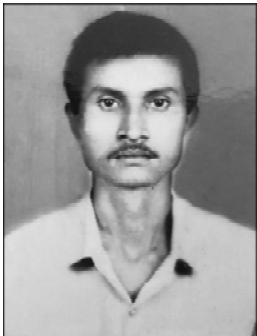

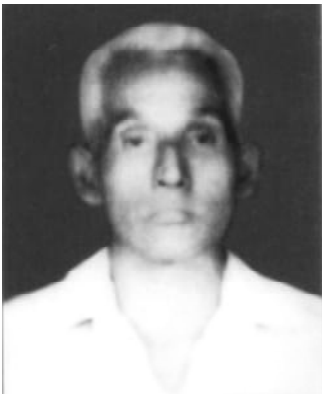
