

RO, ANIPC issues Notices for MCC violations All contesting candidates and parties asked to refrain from violating guidelines of MCC during election campaigning

The Office of the Returning Officer, Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency has received complaints regarding violation of Model Code of Conduct (MCC) guidelines by ways of distribution of free ration kits and cash by certain parties to woo the electors in their favour in the forthcoming General Elections. Acting on the complaints, the Returning Officer, ANIPC has taken strict action and Show Cause Notices have been issued to the defaulters. The defaulters have been put on notice and further action as per laws will be taken.

The Returning Officer, ANIPC has asked all the contesting candidates and parties that they should ensure/refrain from any such violation of the guidelines of MCC during the election campaigning and further reiterated that strict action shall be initiated against anyone, if found violating the same, a press release from RO, ANIPC said.

In order to uphold the integrity of the electoral process to achieve the predominant objective by ensuring level playing field towards conduct of free, fair, peaceful and inducement-free elections, the Election Commission of India has issued strict Poll Day instructions on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near Polling Stations & Candidate Election Booth, which have been summarised as under:

◆ Each contesting candidate, on the Poll Day will be entitled for one vehicle for his own use in respect of the entire constituency. In addition, one vehicle for use of his election agent is allowed. The Poll Day permission of respective vehicles to be displayed prominently on the wind-screen of the vehicles meticulously. Moreover, illegal hiring of vehicles for the conveyance of voters during Poll Day is a corrupt practise and an electoral offence.

General Elections-2024 CEO, A&N Islands & State Police Nodal Officer inspect Checkpoints in South Andaman District FST, SST & Police team to intensify frisking/screening of vehicles both public and private; general public urged to cooperate

In view of the General Elections to Lok Sabha-2024, the Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands, Shri B S Jaglan, IAS, alongwith State Police Nodal Officer, Ms. Monika Bhardwaj, IPS, inspected some checkpoints in South Andaman District yesterday to ensure that the Flying Squad Team (FST), Static Surveillance Team (SST) alongwith Police teams are actively working at checkpoints.

The FST, SST and Police team have been asked to intensify frisking/screening of vehicles both public and



private, so that nobody uses any unfair practices to woo the voters and to ensure that free, fair and transparent elections are conducted in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency.

The CEO directed the teams to take special care and humane approach while checking vehicles carrying aged persons, women carrying children and cases with medical emergency.

The CEO further urged to check the MCC violation as per the guidelines issued by ECI, especially the movement of cash, drugs, liquor, freebies etc. to lure the voters and directed for their immediate seizure without any hesitation. He also directed teams to ensure no harassment to public is caused during checking. He further directed that people carrying legal cash should also not be harassed.

He also requested the general public to cooperate with the teams and advised them to use the cVIGIL mobile App to report any violations of the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) during elections, a press release from CEO, A&N Islands said.

- Do not accept bribe in favour of your vote. Bribery is an offence.
- Do not impersonate for someone else. Impersonation is an offence
- Do not cause any disturbance in the poll process. You may land up in prison.
- Do not cause damage/ tamper with poll material including EVM/VVPAT. You may land up in prison.
- Do not obstruct the polling team in performing election duty. You may land up in prison.
- Do not litter/spit in and around the polling station. It is an offence.

inviting strict action.

- ◆ More than 5 persons in a vehicle including driver is not allowed.
- ◆ Private vehicles utilised by owners for themselves/family members for going to Polling Booth to cast vote is allowed upto a radius of 200 meter of Polling Station.
- ◆ Act of canvassing for votes, soliciting the vote of an elector, persuading any elector not to vote for any particular candidate, persuading any elector not to vote at the election, exhibiting any notice or sign relating to the election are strictly prohibited within 100 meters radius of the Polling Station.
- ◆ Candidate Election Booth is allowed to be set up beyond a distance of 200 meters from the Polling Station with one table and two chairs for the use of their agents/workers for distribution of unofficial identity slips to voters. Moreover, to protect from sun/rain, they may use an umbrella or a piece of tarpaulin over their head.

The electorate of A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency have been appealed to be informed voters and to contribute their share for upholding the democratic principles of free, fair and transparent elections. The Date of Poll (Phase-I) in this constituency is on 19/04/2024 (Friday) and Hours of Poll from 7 am to 6 pm, an order to this effect issued by RO, ANIPC said.

CCS cracks down on illegal gambling; nine arrested with seizure of Rs. 1.2 lakh

WHEREAS, the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) in collaboration with Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) has prepared and released a Joint Action Plan on "Prevention of Drugs and Substance Abuse among Children and Illicit Trafficking".

AND WHEREAS, it is imperative to issue necessary directions to all the medical shops who are selling the schedule "H", "H1" and "X" drugs for monitoring their sale.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise the power conferred upon me under section 133 Cr. P.C, I, Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District hereby direct the following for strict compliance.

1. All the Medical Stores/ Chemist/ Pharmacy shops under the jurisdiction of South Andaman District who are selling schedule "H", "H1" and "X" drugs are hereby directed to install CCTV Camera inside and outside their shops.
2. Time period of one month is being given to all the Medical Stores/Chemist/ Pharmacy shops owner for installation of CCTV Cameras.
3. Footage of such cameras shall be randomly checked by State Drug Controller Authority (DHS, Port Blair) and the Child Welfare Police Officer at any time.
4. In case any Medical Shop Owner fails to Comply as with these directions appropriate legal action shall be initiated against him/her.

Concerned designated Officers shall execute this order with the respective jurisdiction with the help of Police and Drug Inspector and submit their reports accordingly.

Whereas, in the exercise of powers conferred under Section 25 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 read with MHA's Notification No.2/6/57-J dated 17.12.1957 and in pursuance of Section 135B of the Representation of People Act, 1951 read with letter No.78/EPS.2024 dated 16th March, 2024 of Election Commission of India, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands is pleased to declare a public holiday on the day of Poll i.e. 19.04.2024 (Friday) vide Notification No. E-231/25/2024-Accts.Sect-Election/AN/397 dated 01.04.2024 for all Public Offices, Local Bodies and Educational Institutions and a paid holiday for all Commercial Establishments/Undertakings in the UT of A&N Islands and also instructed the Secretary (Labour & Employment) to declare paid holiday on the day of poll i.e. 19.04.2024 (Friday) under the Factories Act, 1948 and the A&N Islands Shops & Establishments Regulation, 2004 read with the provisions laid down in Section 135-B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

Whereas, Section 135B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 provides that:-

1. Every person employed in any business, trade, industrial undertaking or any other establishment and entitled to vote at an election to the House of the People or the Legislative Assembly of a State shall, on the day of poll, be granted a holiday.
2. No deduction or abatement of the wages of any such person shall be made on account of a holiday having been granted in accordance with sub-section (1) and if such person is employed on the basis that she/he would not ordinarily receive wages for such a day, she/he would have drawn had not a holiday been granted to her/him on that day.
3. If an employer contravenes the provisions of sub-section (1) or sub-section (2), then such employers shall be punishable with fine, which may extend to five hundred rupees.
4. This section shall not apply to any elector whose absence may cause danger or substantial loss in respect of the employment in which he is engaged.
5. The daily wage/casual workers are also entitled for a holiday and wages on the poll day.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 135 B of the Representation of People Act, 1951 read with Notification No. E-231/25/2024-Accts.Sect-Election/AN/397 dated 01.04.2024, issued by the A&N Admn, it is hereby directed that all Business Establishments including Shops, Hotels, Restaurants, Resorts etc., Trade, Industrial Undertakings or any other Establishments which fall under the A&N Islands Shops & Establishments Regulation, 2004 and all Factories covered under the Factories Act, 1948 shall observe the day of poll i.e. the 19th April 2024 (Friday) as a paid holiday for their employees so as to enable them to exercise their franchise.

vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near polling
stations & candidate election Booth.**

In order to uphold the integrity of the electoral process to achieve the predominant object by ensuring level playing field towards conduct of free, fair, peaceful and inducement-free elections, the Election Commission of India has issued strict **Poll day instructions** on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near polling stations & candidate election booth, which are been summarised as under:-

1. Each contesting candidate, on the poll day will be entitled for one vehicle for his own use in respect of the entire constituency. In addition, one vehicle for use of his election agent is allowed. The poll day permission of respective vehicles to be displayed prominently on the wind-screen of the vehicles meticulously. Moreover, illegal hiring of vehicles for the conveyance of voters during poll day is a corrupt practise and an electoral offence, inviting strict action.
2. More than 5 persons in a vehicle including driver is not allowed.
3. Private vehicles utilised by owners for themselves/family members for going to polling booth to cast vote is allowed upto a radius of 200 meter of Polling station.
4. Act of canvassing for votes, soliciting the vote of an elector, persuading any elector not to vote for any particular candidate, persuading any elector not to vote at the election, exhibiting any notice or sign relating to the election are strictly prohibited within 100 meters radius of the polling station.
5. Candidate election booth is allowed to be set up beyond a distance of 200 meters from the polling station with one table and two chairs for the use of their agents/workers for distribution of unofficial identity slips to voters. Moreover, to protect from sun/rain they may use an umbrella or a piece of tarpaulin over their head.

The electorate of A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency are hereby appealed to be informed voters and to contribute their share for upholding the democratic principles of free, fair and transparent elections. The Date of Poll (Phase-I) in this constituency is on 19/04/2024 (Friday) and Hours of Poll from 07.00 AM to 06.00 PM.

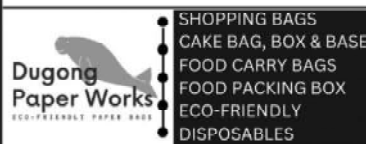

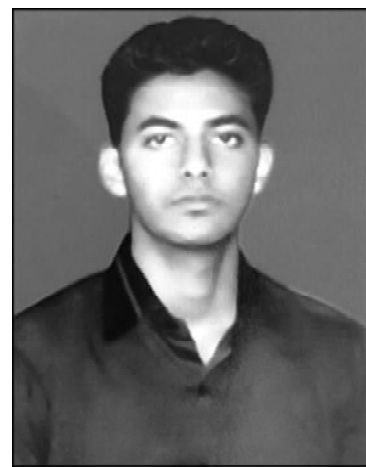
