FSSAI launches project to address microplastic contamination in Indian food

New FSSAI initiative aims to develop detection methods & assess prevalence of microplastics in Indian food

New Delhi, Aug. 18 (PIB)

The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) launched an innovative project to tackle the growing concern of microplastic contamination in food in New Delhi today. Recognising microplastic pollution as an emerging threat that requires immediate attention, the project - 'Micro-and Nano-Plastics as Emerging

Food Contaminants: Establishing Validated Methodologies and Understanding the Prevalence in Different Food Matrices' - was started in March this year to develop and validate analytical methods for detecting micro and nano-plastics in various food products, as well as assess their prevalence and exposure levels in India.

The primary

objectives of the project include developing standard protocols for micro/nano-plastic analysis, conducting intra- and inter-laboratory comparisons, and generating critical data on microplastic exposure levels among consumers. This study is being implemented in collaboration with leading research institutions across the country, including the CSIR-Indian Institute of

Toxicology Research (Lucknow), ICAR-Central Institute of Fisheries Technology (Kochi), and the Birla Institute of Technology and Science (Pilani).

In a recent report, the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) highlighted the presence of microplastics in common food items such as sugar and salt. While the report underscores the global

prevalence of microplastics, it also emphasizes the need for more robust data to fully understand the implications for human health and safety, particularly in the Indian context.

As the food safety regulator of the country, FSSAI is committed to ensuring that Indian consumers have access to safe and healthy food. This project will help

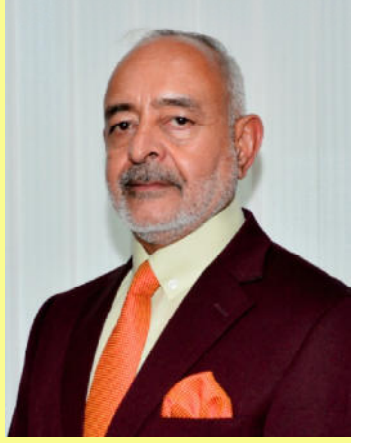

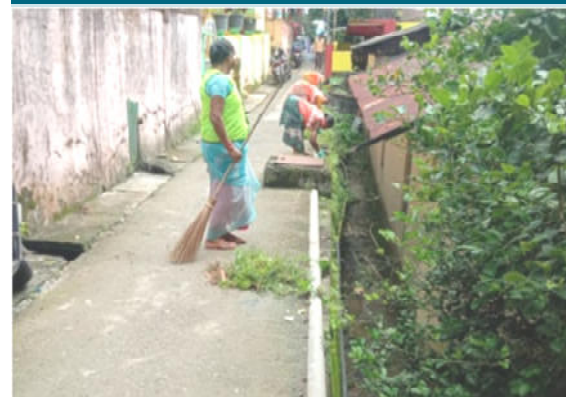

- ◆ Breed Improvement technology and Breed Multiplication Farm.
- ◆ Setting up of Veterinary Vaccine and Drugs Manufacturing facilities.
- ◆ Animal Waste to Wealth Management (Agri Waste Management).

In the present scheme, Dairy Cooperatives can also avail benefits of Credit Guarantee and interest subvention of 3% under AHIDF for 8 years. The Dairy Cooperatives will also get Credit Guarantee facility from the scheduled Banks in addition to NABARD and NCDC.

Applicants including the Dairy Cooperatives can now submit their proposals through the portal www.ahidf.udyamimitra.in for availing loan and interest subvention benefits under AHIDF. As the scheme is credit linked, credit can be availed from the scheduled banks, NCDC, NABARD, NDDB which are already on-boarded and have access of the portal for smoother sanctioning process. All other related documents and current status of applications are available to the beneficiaries on www.ahidf.udyamimitra.in or they can visit the nearest Veterinary Institution for further information.
