





Shri Modi expressed happiness over the fact that Indian culture is earning glory all over the world. He cited the example of Turkmenistan where the 300th birth anniversary of that country's national poet was celebrated in May this year. On the occasion, the President of Turkmenistan unveiled the statues of 24 famous poets of the world. One of these statues is that of Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore.

Prime Minister also highlighted that this month, two Caribbean countries -Suriname and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines- celebrated their Indian heritage with zeal and enthusiasm. The Indian community in Suriname celebrates 5th of June every year as Indian Arrival Day and Pravasi Din. Shri Modi said that Bhojpuri is also widely spoken there, along with Hindi.

Touching upon the subject of Yoga, Prime Minister said that the whole world celebrated the 10th International Day of Yoga with enthusiasm. He stated that new records are being made every year as the observance of Yoga Day is progressing. The Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration is implementing a component 'Motorization of Traditional Craft' under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme-'Blue Revolution' wherein subsidy is provided for purchase of DHS to observe STOP Diarrhoea ... outboard/inboard marine engine fishing gear & propeller. The pattern of subsidy and eligibility criteria for the programme of the scheme are as under:-

Pattern of Subsidy Category 40% of the unit cost with a ceiling engine, fishing gear and propeller for

General Pattern of Subsidy for ST/SC Women Category

60% of the unit cost with a ceiling of Rs.48,000/- per inboard, outboard Rs.72,000/-per inboard outboard engine, fishing gear and propeller for unit cost of Rs. 1.20 Lakh. unit cost of Rs. 1.20 Lakh. **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Applicant should be a bonafide fisherman of A&N Islands possessing registered non-motorized or motorized fishing craft, holding valid fishing license continuously for 02 years including the current year. The Pandemic Covid relaxation is applicable.
- The engine to be purchased should not be of more man 30 Horse Power
- The eligible subsidy for procurement of engine shall be up-to 10 HP.
- The fishermen possessing motorized fishing crafts, whose engines are of more than 05 years old and are unserviceable, are also eligible to replace
- The fishermen seeking replacement of 05 years old and unserviceable engine should produce -a certificate issued by an Authorized Marine Engineer stating that the engine is beyond economical repair.
- The type / size of gear allowed to purchase are Gill net not below 25 mm mesh (knot to knot diagonally). Hook & Line. Shore seme/drag net of mesh size not below 25mm, Fish traps.
- The Applicant should not have availed the assistance for purchase of engine, fishing gear and propeller from the Department of Fisheries or any other Government Department during the last 5 years

Applications have been invited from eligible beneficiaries interested in the procurement of outboard/inboard marine engine/fishing gear & propeller to extend subsidy by the Department during 2023-24. Application form and detailed terms & conditions of the scheme can be obtained from the Directorate of Fisheries/Fisheries Zonal Offices/Fisheries Sub Stations. The applications complete in all respect should reach the nearest Fisheries Zonal Office/Sub-Stations by 31st July, 2024, a press release from Directorate of Fisheries said.


