'Mann Ki Baat' will continue to discuss India's rich culture, history & efforts towards making a developed India: PM

New Delhi, June 30
Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today expressed gratitude to the people for reiterating their faith in the Constitution and the democratic systems of the country in the Lok Sabha elections. Addressing the nation in his Mann ki Baat programme on Akashvani this morning, the Prime Minister highlighted that the 2024 General Elections were the biggest elections in the world in which 65 crore people cast their votes. He said this has never happened in any other country in the world. Shri Modi congratulated the Election Commission and everyone involved in the voting process.

Prime Minister noted that the 30th of June is an important day as 'Hool Diwas' is celebrated today. He said, this day is associated with the courage of Veer Sidhu and Kanhu, who opposed the atrocities of the British rulers. Veer Sidhu and Kanhu united thousands of Santhal people to fight against the British in 1855 in Santhal Pargana of Jharkhand. Shri Modi said Veer Sidhu and Kanhu attained martyrdom while displaying bravery in this struggle. He added that the supreme sacrifice of these sons of Jharkhand inspires people even today.

Shri Modi spoke about the special campaign launched on World Environment Day this year- 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam'. He appealed to people from all over the world to plant a tree along with their mothers or in their mothers' names. He was happy to note that people are sharing pictures of

planting trees with their mothers or with their photographs. He said this campaign has provided everyone with an opportunity to express affection towards their mothers, by sharing their pictures on social media with #Plant4Mother and #Ek_Ped_Maa_Ke_Naam. He added that this campaign will also benefit and protect Mother Earth.

Prime Minister elaborated that during the last decade, there has been an unprecedented expansion of forest area in India. During the Amrit Mahotsav, more than 60 thousand Amrit Sarovars have also

been created across the country. Speaking about the Monsoon season, Shri Modi mentioned a special umbrella made in Kerala - 'Karthumbhi Umbrella'. These special umbrellas are crafted in Attappady of Kerala. Prime Minister praised the tribal women of Kerala for making these colourful umbrellas and expressed happiness that the demand for these umbrellas is rising across the country. Discourse on 'Religion and Philosophy in Vedas and Vedang' organized by Chinmaya Mission

"Vedas" are a treasure house of knowledge and reflect age old traditions and cultures: CS

Port Blair, June 30
Vedas and Upanishads offer profound insight into the nature of existence, the purpose of life and the interconnectedness of all living beings, said the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS while delivering a discourse on 'Religion and Philosophy in Vedas and Vedang' at a programme organized by Chinmaya Mission, Port Blair in its auditorium here today. Describing Vedas as a treasure house of knowledge, he said, they reflect age old traditions and cultures. The word Veda signifies Knowledge and is derived from the Sanskrit root word 'Vid' which means 'to Know'. Vedas are a collection of sacred text comprising of four divisions viz. the Rig-Veda, Yajur-Veda, Sama-Veda and Atharva-Veda. Stating that Rig-Veda is the longest and oldest of the four



Vedas with over 10000 verses, he said, it is the home of all mantras. He said, the old Indian tradition of Vedic teachings was primarily oral. It was based on Guru-Shishya parampara. Under that system, the correct interpretation of Vedic Literature was handed down from Guru to his Shishya from one generation to another, he said. Elaborating on Karma, he stated that it is the sequence of action. If the actions are in line with your duties, the Karma will be positive. If the action is not in line with your duties, the Karma will be negative. Karma is attached to the soul and after death, karma determines what one's next life will be. He said, the process is transmigration which means the passing

of a soul from one body to another after death. He spoke on the three stages of psychology viz. Unconscious, Subconscious and Conscious. He also elaborately spoke on Upanishad. Dwelling upon Vedang, the Chief Secretary said, there are six Vedangs viz. Siksha, Chanda, Vyakarana, Nirukta, Jyotisha and Kalpa. Jyotisha Veda is Astrology and is divided into three parts viz. Rashi, Graha and Nakshatra. There are 12 Rashis, 9 Grahas and 27 Nakshtras. He said, Indian Astrology is based on Nakshatra. The Chief Secretary concluded his talk by stating that at the heart of the Vedas lie a profound exploration of metaphysical concepts, ethical principles and the nature of the divine. The 1st Late T Mohan Rao Memorial Open Chess Tournament 2024 which commenced yesterday at Andhra Association Hall, Port Blair concluded successfully today. The event was organized by Andaman Nicobar Chess Association (ANCA) in collaboration with Andhra Association Port Blair. The final day of the game was inaugurated by Smti Nandini Maharaj, IAS, ADM (SA), who attended the inaugural session of the final day of play this morning as the chief guest. She made the ceremonial first move at the top boards against J. S. Virat to start the final day's games.

Around 210 players participated in this two-day event, which was played over 9 rounds in the Swiss Rapid format. R Kashthuri Bhai emerged as the winner of the tournament, scoring 8 points from 9 rounds with a better tie-break Buchholz Cut 1 than J S Virat, who also scored 8 points and remained unbeaten in the

India defeats South Africa in ICC Men's
T20 Cricket World Cup 2024 Finals,
ends 11-year wait for a global trophy



New Delhi, June 30
India ended their 11-year wait for a global trophy when Rohit Sharma led Team India clinched the ICC Men's T20 Cricket World Cup 2024 defeating South Africa by seven runs in a classic final at Kensington Oval last night. Opting to bat first, Virat Kohli's 76 and Axar Patel's 47 led India to a strong 176 for 7 in 20 overs, the highest score by any team in the final of a men's T20 World Cup. Chasing the target of 177 runs, South

Africa could only score 169 runs losing eight wickets with the help of Heinrich Klaasen's 52 runs. For India, Hardik Pandya picked up three wickets while Jasprit Bumrah and Arshdeep Singh bagged two wickets each. Virat Kohli bagged the Player of the Match award for his fabulous innings. Pacer Jaspreet Bumrah was awarded the Player of the Tournament for picking up 15 wickets in eight games with a bowling economy rate of below six. This is India's second T20

World Cup victory after they had won it in 2007 and first since winning the Champions Trophy in 2013.

Two of India's greatest ever cricketers - Virat Kohli and Rohit Sharma - announced their retirement from T20 International after the side's second T20 World Cup win. While Kohli announced his retirement minutes after the triumph, India captain Rohit Sharma announced it in the official post match press conference.

beneficiaries for subsidy under Motorization of
Traditional Craft component

Port Blair, June 30

The Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration is implementing a component 'Motorization of Traditional Craft' under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme-'Blue Revolution' wherein subsidy is provided for purchase of outboard/inboard marine engine fishing gear & propeller. The pattern of subsidy and eligibility criteria for the programme of the scheme are as under:-

Pattern of Subsidy for General Category	Pattern of Subsidy for ST/SC Women Category
40% of the unit cost with a ceiling Rs.48,000/- per inboard, outboard engine, fishing gear and propeller for unit cost of Rs. 1.20 Lakh.	60% of the unit cost with a ceiling of Rs.72,000/-per inboard outboard engine, fishing gear and propeller for unit cost of Rs. 1.20 Lakh.
Eligibility Criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applicant should be a bonafide fisherman of A&N Islands possessing registered non-motorized or motorized fishing craft, holding valid fishing license continuously for 02 years including the current year. The Pandemic Covid relaxation is applicable.• The engine to be purchased should not be of more man 30 Horse Power (HP).• The eligible subsidy for procurement of engine shall be up-to 10 HP.• The fishermen possessing motorized fishing crafts, whose engines are of more than 05 years old and are unserviceable, are also eligible to replace the engines.• The fishermen seeking replacement of 05 years old and unserviceable engine should produce -a certificate issued by an Authorized Marine Engineer stating that the engine is beyond economical repair.• The type / size of gear allowed to purchase are Gill net not below 25 mm mesh (knot to knot diagonally). Hook & Line. Shore seme/drag net of mesh size not below 25mm, Fish traps.• The Applicant should not have availed the assistance for purchase of engine, fishing gear and propeller from the Department of Fisheries or any other Government Department during the last 5 years.	

Applications have been invited from eligible beneficiaries interested in the procurement of outboard/inboard marine engine/fishing gear & propeller to extend subsidy by the Department during 2023-24. Application form and detailed terms & conditions of the scheme can be obtained from the Directorate of Fisheries/Fisheries Zonal Offices/Fisheries Sub Stations. The applications complete in all respect should reach the nearest Fisheries Zonal Office/Sub-Stations by 31st July, 2024, a press release from Directorate of Fisheries said.

the significance of prevention, cleanliness, and appropriate treatment.

These activities mainly include-intensification of advocacy & awareness generation activities for diarrhoea management, strengthening service provision for diarrhoea case management, establishment of ORS-Zinc corners, prepositioning of ORS and Zinc by ASHA in households with under-five children and awareness generation activities for hygiene and sanitation.

The focus areas of the campaign include strengthening health infrastructure, improving access to clean water and sanitation, enhancing nutritional programs, and promoting hygiene education. The campaign aims to create a holistic approach to managing and preventing diarrhoea, ultimately reducing child mortality and improving overall public health, a press release from DHS said.
