

A&N Administration launches Online Services on National Single Window System to enhance 'Ease of Doing Business'

Investors, entrepreneurs & public users encouraged to utilize portal for all applicable services

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 11

A&N Administration has made thirty essential Government services available exclusively through the National Single Window System (NSWS) Portal (<https://www.nsws.gov.in/portal/andamans>). This integration marks a significant step toward achieving the objectives of digital governance, compliance reduction, and improving the Ease of Doing Business (EoDB) in the Union Territory. The NSWS Portal, an initiative by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Government of India, is a one-stop platform for accessing Central and State/UT-level approvals and clearances. Stakeholders including investors, entrepreneurs, service providers, and members of the general public can now avail services through a unified interface without the need for



multiple physical visits or departmental interactions. In a communication, the District Industries Centre (DIC), Department of Industries, has informed that the services currently on-boarded span across seven Departments, covering regulatory and operational requirements for tourism, power, education, fire safety, labour compliance, consumer affairs, and fisheries. The

Directorate of Information, Publicity and Tourism now offers online permission for film shooting, registration of parasailing and sea kart services, registration for tour and travel agents, tourist transport operators, and home-stay accommodations under the Bed and Breakfast scheme. Additionally, scuba diving centres and sea walk service providers can also register through this platform. The Department of Electricity has made applications for new electric connections-both low-tension and high-tension-available online. The Directorate of Education facilitates provisional recognition for schools, while the Fire Department processes online fire clearance certificates. The Labour Department has enabled digital submission for factory layout approvals, construction and expansion permissions, licensing under the

Govt. land measuring 2000 Square Meters reclaimed across multiple locations by District Administration, SA

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 11

As part of its continued and determined efforts to safeguard public land and ensure its rightful utilization, the District Administration, South Andaman, conducted a series of coordinated anti-encroachment operations at multiple locations today. These enforcement actions carried out by the Revenue Department with the active support of local police and enforcement teams resulted in the restoration of significant stretches of Government land to official revenue records. At North Bay, the



Revenue team unhindered public access and safeguarding public property. Later in the day, during a routine field inspection at Calicut village, the Revenue officials detected fresh instances of encroachment in the form of barbed wire fencing over three contiguous patches of Government revenue land. The fencing was immediately dismantled on-site

and an area measuring approximately 0.10 hectares was reclaimed and recorded back into Government possession. At Nayashahar village, a temporary hut found under construction on Government land was dismantled. The illegal structure was removed and approximately 0.02 hectares of land was cleared and restored to the revenue records. All of the above eviction operations were carried out under the relevant provisions of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Land

District Administration, SA acts against illicit liquor sale at Shore Point

Continuing its vigilant enforcing against illegal sale and possession of liquor, the District Administration, South Andaman through its Excise Department conducted a joint inspection with the local Police authorities at Chunna Bhatta, Shore Point following credible information regarding illicit liquor activity in the area. During the inspection, a gumti being operated at Shore Point was found to possess

liquor bottles suspected to be stored and sold in contravention of the Excise Rules. The accused along with the seized liquor was handed over to the Police authorities on the spot for necessary legal action. In connection with the seizure of illicit liquor and unauthorized possession, an FIR has been registered under the relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, along with applicable provisions of the



Excise Regulation. The matter is under active investigation and strict legal action will follow as per law. The District Administration will continue with strict

District Administration, SA imposes fines against illegal extraction and dumping of earth

The District Administration, South Andaman has taken strict action against violators who were indulged in illegal extraction and were dumping earth in contravention of Land Revenue Regulations and Mines and Mineral Rules. During a recent field inspection at Pahargaon village, revenue officials detected unauthorized activities involving the extraction and transportation of earth, which was subsequently dumped at Garacharma village. Approximately, 30

cubic meters of earth had been illegally extracted without obtaining the necessary permissions. A fine of Rs. 18,000 was imposed on the violators.

The Deputy Commissioner has issued a stern warning to all such unscrupulous elements indulging in illegal mining, earth transportation and

Factories Act, and various registrations under the Contract Labour and Inter-State Migrant Workmen Acts. Shops and Establishments registration, registration for building workers, and contractor licensing can now be completed digitally through the NSWS Portal. The Directorate of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs offers dealer and repairer licenses under the Legal Metrology Act, as well as registration for packers, manufacturers, and importers of commodities. Applications for the verification and calibration of weights and measures, as well as new Fair Price Shop allotments, are also available online. From the Department of Fisheries, sport fishing permits, permit for transporting fish from mainland, and registration of fish traders, cooperatives, and Self-Help Groups can all be processed on the NSWS Portal.

To access the portal, applicants must begin by registering using their email address and mobile number and PAN verification through DigiLocker credentials or DSC (Digital Signature Certificate), simplifying identity verification and linking personal details to the applicant profile. After successful registration, users create a business profile by entering essential details such as the nature of the enterprise, its legal structure, proposed activity, and location. This profile becomes the base for all subsequent applications.

The NSWS portal also features an integrated Know Your Approvals (KYA) module, where users can input information about their planned business or service. Based on the provided details, the system automatically generates a customized list of required approvals and licenses across relevant Government Departments. This intelligent system removes uncertainty and provides a clear compliance path. Applications for services are submitted through the dashboard by filling in structured forms, uploading supporting documents, and making necessary payments online where applicable. Users can monitor the real-time status of applications and receive updates directly through the portal interface. Once approvals are granted, certificates and licenses can be downloaded digitally without any manual intervention.

To support applicants at every stage, NSWS has published official guidance documents in the portal (<https://www.nsws.gov.in/portal/user-guide>). These include detailed instructions on registering and creating a business profile, understanding and applying for state approvals, and onboarding via DigiLocker, etc. The guides are publicly accessible through the NSWS website and are designed to help new and existing users transition to the digital system with ease.

Investors, entrepreneurs, and public users have been encouraged to utilize the portal for all applicable services. Departmental websites are also being updated to redirect users to the NSWS platform for a streamlined experience. Unauthorized taxi operations at VSI Airport premises to be stopped from today

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 11 As per Airports Authority of India Operational Circular No. 5 of 2020, commercial activities at Airport without permission is a punishable offence with penalty amount of Rs.500/- per instance. However, it has been observed that some taxi operators (Walk-in) are operating in Airport premises without permission from Airports Authority of India despite the availability of authorized platform of Pre-paid operated by A&N Traffic Police. A meeting in this regard was held today between Airport Authority of India representatives, A&N Administration, A&N Police and Taxi Operators' representatives wherein it has been decided that all unauthorized (walk-in) taxi operation shall be stopped with effect from 12.06.2025 and any violation in this regard will attract penalty of Rs. 500/-per instance, a press release from Airport Director, VSI Airport said.

Revenue and Land Reforms Regulation, 1966. The drives were conducted peacefully with full coordination between Revenue officials, local Police and enforcement staff and without any law-and-order disruptions.

Additionally, in compliance to the order passed by the Hon'ble Court of the Estate Officer under the Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Act, 1971, the District Administration undertook the eviction of an unauthorized occupation from Government land situated at Dairy Farm, Sri Vijaya Puram.

The land, measuring 0.064 hectares, had been under illegal possession despite multiple notices and proceedings. Following due process and inquiry, the Estate Officer passed a formal eviction order. Acting upon this, the



Revenue authorities, in coordination with local Police, carried out the eviction in a peaceful and systematic manner. The cleared land has now been formally handed over to the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Integrated Development Corporation (ANIIDCO) for the operational and developmental use of its Milk Plant facility.

The District Administration reiterates its firm commitment to act against illegal encroachments and appeals to the general public to refrain from occupying Government land without proper authorization. Citizens have been encouraged to cooperate with the District Administration in preserving public resources and maintaining the rule of law. The District Administration, South Andaman reiterates that such operations will continue unabated in all areas where illegal occupation is identified.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman has cautioned the general public that the District Administration has zero tolerance towards encroachment on Government land and uphold the rule of law.

# Only Aadhaar authenticated user can book Tatkal tickets on IRCTC Website & App from July 1

New Delhi, June 11 (PIB) With an aim to ensure fair and transparent access to Tatkal tickets and to safeguard the interests of genuine passengers, Indian Railways has announced key modifications in the Tatkal ticket booking system. These changes are aimed at enhancing user authentication and reducing misuse of the scheme. The new provisions are as follows: 1.Aadhaar Authentication for Online Tatkal Bookings: Effective 1st July 2025, Tatkal tickets booked through IRCTC's official website and mobile app will be available only to users authenticated with Aadhaar. Further, Aadhaar-based OTP authentication will become mandatory for Tatkal

bookings made online starting 15th July 2025. 2. System-Based OTP Authentication at PRS Counters and Agents: Tatkal tickets booked at computerised Passenger Reservation System (PRS) counters and through authorised agents will require OTP authentication sent to the mobile number provided by the user at the time of booking. This provision will also come into effect from 15<sup>th</sup> July 2025. 3. Booking Time Restriction for Authorised Agents: To prevent bulk bookings during the critical opening period, authorised ticketing agents of Indian Railways will not be permitted to book opening-day Tatkal tickets during the first 30 minutes of the booking window. For AC classes, this restriction applies from 10:00 AM to 10:30 AM, and for non-AC classes, from 11 am to 11:30 am. These changes are being implemented to improve transparency in Tatkal bookings and to ensure that the benefits of the scheme reach genuine end users. CRIS and IRCTC have been instructed to make necessary system modifications and inform all Zonal Railways and concerned departments accordingly. The Ministry of Railways urges all passengers to take note of these changes and encourages everyone to ensure Aadhaar linkage with their IRCTC user profiles to avoid inconvenience.

# India's social security coverage jumps to 64.3%, ranks 2nd globally: ILO

New Delhi, June 11 India's social security coverage has increased from 19 per cent in 2015 to 64.3 per cent in 2025. According to the latest data from the International Labour Organisation's ILOSTAT, the coverage reflects a 45 percentage point surge over the past decade. Recognizing these efforts, the ILO acknowledged India's achievement and officially published on its dashboard that over 94 crore people are now covered under at least one social protection benefit. In terms of beneficiary count,

India now ranks second in the world, providing social protection to around 94 crore citizens. The Director General ILO, Gilbert F. Houngbo, praised India's focused welfare policies for the poor and labour class under Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's leadership. While holding a bilateral discussion with the DG, ILO on the sidelines of the International Labour Conference in Geneva, Labour and Employment Minister, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya highlighted the pro-poor and labour welfare schemes

undertaken by the Modi Government over the past eleven years. He said, this remarkable achievement stands as a testament to the visionary leadership of Shri Modi and the relentless efforts of the Government in building an inclusive and rights-based social protection ecosystem. He said the increase marks the fastest expansion in social protection coverage worldwide, reflecting the Government's unwavering commitment to empowering the last mile and fulfilling the promise of leaving no one behind.
