Prime Minister to lead 11th International Day of Yoga celebrations from Visakhapatnam today

Theme for IDY 2025 - "Yoga for One Earth, One Health" echoes India's vision of global wellness

New Delhi, June 20(PIB)

The stage is set for the 11th International Day of Yoga (IDY) to be celebrated with grandeur on 21st June, 2025, with the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi leading the national event from Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh, performing the Common Yoga Protocol (CYP) alongside over 3 lakh participants at the main venue. He will be joined by Union Minister of State (IC) Ayush and Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare, Shri Prataprao Jadhav, and Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister, Shri N. Chandrababu Naidu, in a massive demonstration of India's global wellness vision.

The Prime Minister will perform the Common Yoga Protocol (CYP) with over 3 lakh participants at the Visakhapatnam venue, synchronised with over 10 lakh locations across the country under the 'Yoga Sangam' initiative. The mass



demonstration will be held from 6:30 AM to 7:45 AM, and is expected to witness unprecedented participation from all corners of the country.

In an unprecedented mobilisation, more than 2 crore people are expected to participate in Yoga sessions at over 1 lakh locations across the state.

This year's IDY 2025, "Yoga for One Earth, One Health," reflects the integrated vision of well-being. It emphasizes the interconnectedness of human and planetary health, drawing from the Indian ethos of "Sarve Santu Niramaya" (May all be free from disease).

To ensure the inclusive reach of yoga's benefits, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has addressed a letter to all Gram Pradhans, noting, "It is a matter of pride that yoga has positively transformed lives not only in India but across the world." As in previous editions of IDY, the Prime Minister's message has infused Gram Panchayats with renewed enthusiasm, resulting in a significant rise in yoga-related activities at the grassroots level, particularly in Panchayats, Anganwadis, and Community Health Centers.

The introduction of 10 Signature events to garner public participation for IDY 2025 has resulted in unprecedented response from across the country and abroad. Against the target of 1 lakh registrations for the 21st June event in the country, more than 11 lakh organizations and groups have registered for the Yoga Sangam event at their respective places through the Yoga portal of the Ministry of Ayush.

Andaman to get 5-star resorts, yacht marina in tourism overhaul: Chief Secretary

Kumar said the ambitious plan focuses on infrastructure development, heritage promotion, eco-tourism, and sustainable growth

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 20

Andaman and Nicobar Islands Chief Secretary, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar has said that a comprehensive roadmap has been prepared to transform the archipelago into a world-class tourism destination.

Talking to PTI, Kumar said the ambitious plan focuses on infrastructure development, heritage promotion, eco-tourism, and sustainable growth.

Emphasising the strategic importance and unique appeal of the islands, he added, "The Andaman and Nicobar archipelago, comprising 836 islands, is a rare blend of natural beauty, historical depth, and adventure tourism. We aim to elevate it to international tourism standards."

Kumar said that under the guidance of the Union Ministry of Home Affairs, approvals have been given for the construction of four

five-star resorts on select islands, marking a key step towards premium tourism infrastructure.

Additionally, a dedicated yacht marina is in the pipeline, with an Expression of Interest (EoI) already floated.

"The marina will be instrumental in attracting cruise tourism and private yachts, enhancing the Islands' profile as a luxury destination," Kumar added.

On the heritage front, Kumar said efforts are underway to obtain UNESCO World Heritage Site status for the Cellular Jail, which is already on the tentative list.

"We want visitors to truly connect with the legacy of India's freedom struggle," he

added.

To deepen this experience, a tourism circuit is being developed connecting the Cellular Jail, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island and Viper Island. The circuit will offer light and sound shows, guided tours, and immersive experiences to connect with India's freedom struggle, he added.

Recognising the island's vast coastal potential, accounting for over 25 per cent of India's coastline, the administration is promoting water sports and eco-adventures. Activities like scuba diving,

Road from Old CCS Jn. to Dairy Farm via Vijay Baugh declared One-Way Route

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 20
In exercise of the powers conferred under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act No. 59 of 1988), read with the Administration's Notification No./2008/F.No.32-95/2008-TR dated 10th March, 2008, the District Magistrate, South Andaman has notified for the information of all concerned, that the stretch of road from Old CCS Junction to Dairy Farm via Vijay Baugh Road has been declared a One-Way Route with immediate effect, subject to the following restrictions:

- ◆ All Buses and Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs), except those with 12 wheels or more shall be diverted via Vijay Baugh route with entry from Dairy Farm an exit at Old CCS, Junglighthat.
- ◆ No vehicle, except two-wheelers, shall be permitted entry from Old CCS Junction towards Dairy Farm via Vijay Baugh Road.

This order shall remain in force until further notice and is issued in the interest of public safety, a press release from Additional District Magistrate, South Andaman District said.

Road from Old PS Satellite Colony to Austinabad main to be closed for all vehicular movements from June 23 to 25

In exercise of the power conferred under M.V. Act 1988 (Act No. 59 of 1988) read with Administration's Notification No./2008/F.No.32-95/2008-TR dated 10th March, 2008, the District Magistrate, South Andaman District has notified for the information of all concerned that for the resurfacing of the existing road starting from Old Police Station Satellite Colony to Austinabad Main road via Andal Basti will be closed for all vehicular movements for 03 days w.e.f. 23.06.2025 to 25.06.2025.

During this period, all the vehicles will be diverted through alternate routes namely from route near Type-II Quarter Complex, route near E&M Junior Engineer's Office, route near Triple Stories Type-III Quarters and two connecting routes from Andal Basti to Austinabad. All concerned have been directed to ensure strict compliance with this notification in the interest of public safety, a notification issued by Additional District Magistrate for District Magistrate, SA said.

snorkelling, and game fishing are being expanded with strict safety regulations and professional operators, he said.

The Chief Secretary also unveiled plans for astro-tourism, leveraging the region's unpolluted skies.

"Tourism is no longer confined to Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep. New destinations like Baratang Island, known for its mud volcanoes and limestone caves, are gaining popularity," he said.

The Chief Secretary said skill development programmes are being implemented for local youth to promote employment in tourism, hospitality, fisheries, and support services.

According to the tourism department, the Islands witnessed a significant rise in tourist footfall over the past three years.

In 2022, the archipelago recorded 2,35,061 domestic and 4,461 foreign tourists. In 2023, the numbers rose to 3,23,619 domestic and 9,025 foreign travellers.

The upward trend continued in 2024, with 7,10,397 domestic and 11,497 foreign tourists visiting the islands.

Fire Mock Drill conducted at Haddo Wharf

The drill commenced with a simulated fire scenario, following the simulated events, Departmental teams carried out safe evacuation procedures. Search and rescue operations were conducted efficiently, and first aid was promptly administered to the injured. The communication team played a vital role by immediately alerting the State Emergency Operation Center (SEOC-1070), District Emergency Operation Center (DEOC-S/A-1077), Emergency Response Support System (ERSS-112), and other concerned Departments, including Fire and Health services. Fire



tenders and ambulances reached the scene swiftly, ensuring timely management of the situation and delivery of medical assistance. The drill highlighted the readiness and inter-agency coordination crucial for effective disaster response.

A debriefing session was held after the completion of the drill. During the session, the Observers from Resource Departments briefed the staff on their findings and identified gaps. They appreciated the staff's adherence to the mock drill procedures and also recommended updating resources to effectively handle emergencies, a press release received from Directorate of Disaster Management said.
