

NTPC Green Energy Invites EoI for 5 MW Solar and BESS Project At Great Nicobar Island

NTPC Green Energy Limited (NGEL), a subsidiary of NTPC Limited, has invited Expressions of Interest (EoI) from Indian companies, their consortiums, affiliates, or representatives. The purpose of this invitation is to develop and install a solar photovoltaic (PV) plant with a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) on Great Nicobar Island (GNI), India. The project is part of the government's holistic development plan for the island and aims to promote clean and renewable energy solutions in one of India's remotest regions.

The EoI was published on 11th March, 2025. NGEL is seeking partners to explore the development of a solar PV plant with a capacity of up to 5 MW and a BESS with a capacity of



up to 4 MW/12 MWh. The final capacity and technical specifications will be determined based on the responses received through this EoI. Interested parties are encouraged to submit their proposals in soft copy via email, with an optional submission of hard copies either in person or by registered post. The last date for the submission of the EoI is 18th April, 2025. Queries and requests for clarifications must be

submitted by 30th March, 2025. The EoI responses will be opened on 1st May, 2025. Proposals must remain valid for six months from the last date of submission, ensuring the applicants' commitment during the evaluation process.

NGEL has not mentioned any specific Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) requirement for this EoI stage. This is typical for an Expression of Interest phase, where initial

proposals are solicited to gauge market interest and technical capabilities rather than formal bids. However, any further bidding process following this EoI may include EMD requirements, depending on the tender terms.

For the Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG), while it is not explicitly mentioned in this EoI document, subsequent stages of the project that involve formal bidding and contract awards

generally require the submission of PBGs. This ensures the selected bidder's commitment to executing the project according to the agreed terms.

The EoI specifically calls for proposals from applicants who have experience executing solar PV plants and battery energy storage systems, either separately or as integrated projects. Applicants must provide documentary evidence, such as work orders of completed or ongoing projects, preferably for central government, state government, or public sector undertakings. The applicants are also expected to submit detailed technical proposals, including energy storage technologies, project cost optimization

With the Notification of Inland Vessel Rules, 2022, it had become mandatory for all Inland Vessel Owners and its crew component to get themselves registered on the Central Database Application Portal developed by Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI). The Port Management Board was accordingly mandated by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration to coordinate with IWAI and organize a sensitization program for all stakeholders. This issue was deliberated with IWAI



and accordingly a virtual workshop was conducted on 13.03.2025 in the presence of Secretary (Shipping), Cdr. Sanjay Verma, Senior Consultant (M), IWAI and his team made a detailed presentation and explained the nitty-gritty on use of the Central Database

such training programmes would be conducted periodically to promote seaweed cultivation across the Islands. He also introduced the technical team of NIOT to the participants and assured technical assistance in Seaweed cultivation.

Ms. Gurjeet Kaur thanked the Department of Fisheries and NIOT- ACOSTI for organizing such training programme and extended support of RD Department for taking up commercial seaweed farming through SHG Members.

Dr. K. Gopal, Joint Director of Fisheries, provided insights into the various applications of seaweed in day to day life, such as in textiles, chocolates, confectionery, and fertilizers. He motivated the participants to take up seaweed production as a livelihood option which could eventually attract market in mainland India once a marketable quantity is produced.

The programme included both technical and practical sessions, covering the basic concepts and cultivation techniques of seaweed, with a special focus on Gracilaria edulis led by NIOT scientists.

The participants were also taken to the inhouse NIOT laboratory for a demonstration on post harvest and processed products development techniques of seaweeds. Additionally, participants were taken on a field visit to Chidiyatapu for a demonstration on seaweed raft fabrication by tube-net method and seed inoculation by the NIOT team, a press release from Fisheries Department said.

Health Care facilities in A&N Islands urged to ensure strict compliance of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 14

The Health Care Facilities in Andaman & Nicobar Islands have been urged to ensure strict compliance of Biomedical Waste Management Rule, 2016. Under schedule - II of Biomedical Waste Management(BMWM) Rules, 2016 as amended thereof, all the Government and Private Healthcare facilities need to ensure the implementation of Rules as well as the strict compliance with respect to the following points:

- ♦ Installation of Online Continuous Emission Monitoring System (OCEMS) by Health Care facilities having captive treatment facilities-incinerators and transmission of real time data to CPCB server.
- ♦ Existing deep burials pits should be authorized as per BMWM Rules, 2016 and designed in line with standards prescribed under Sr. No. 5 Schedule-II of BMWM

Rules, 2016.

- ♦ The standards for liquid waste prescribed under Biomedical Waste Management Rules 2016 and its amendments to be compiled by Healthcare Facilities:

- The limits mentioned under Schedule II of Bio-medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 are applicable to the occupiers of Health Care Facilities (bedded) which are either connected with sewerage network without terminal sewage treatment plant or not connected to public sewers:

- HCFs required to comply with limits under Schedule II at S.No.08 (CPCB guidelines for Management of Healthcare Waste as per BMWM Rules, 2016 may be referred).

- For discharge into public sewers with terminal facilities, the general standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986)

shall be applicable: HCFs required to comply with general discharge standards for public sewers.

- HCFs having less than ten beds shall comply with the output discharge standards for liquid waste as mentioned under Schedule II at S.No.8.

- Non-bedded occupiers shall dispose infectious liquid wastes only after treatment by disinfection as per Schedule-II (6) of the principal rules: CPCB guidelines may be referred.

All the Health Care facilities in Andaman and Nicobar Islands have been requested to ensure strict compliance of the above stipulated conditions under BMWM Rules, 2016.
