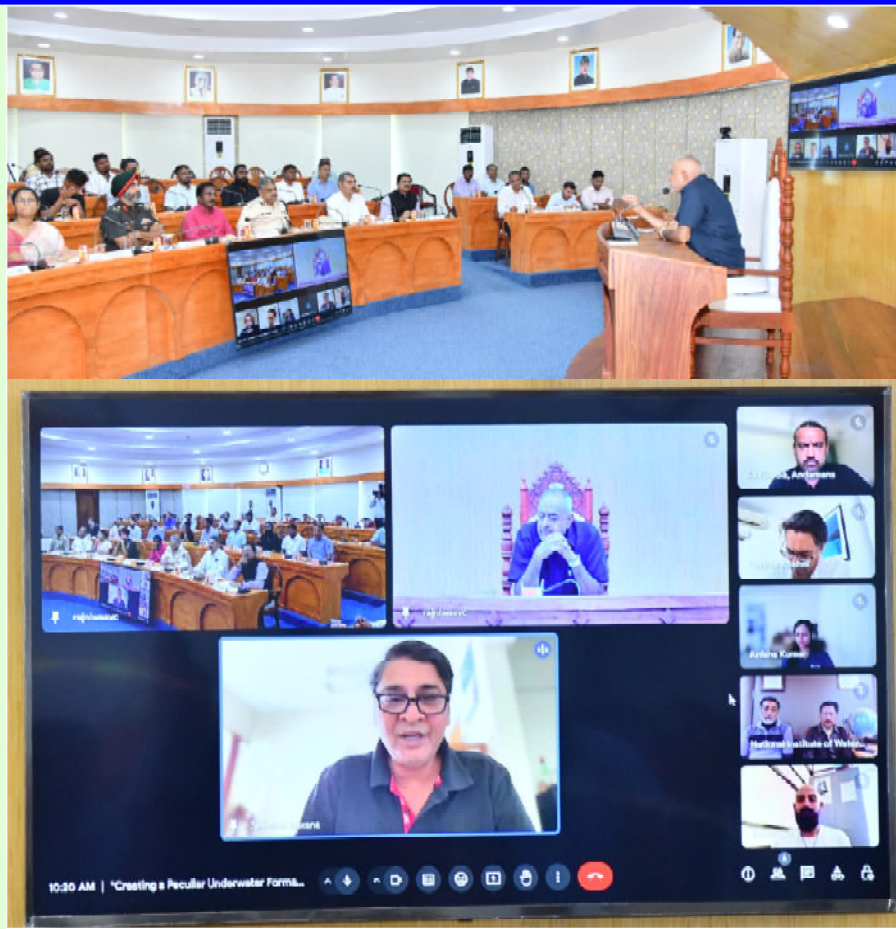

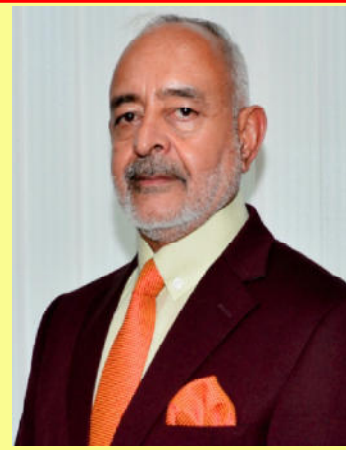

social elements to disrupt or influence the upcoming elections.

This collaborative endeavour between local Police and the CAPF underscores a shared commitment to uphold the sanctity and integrity of the electoral process. Paramount importance has been placed on safeguarding the safety and security of every citizen during this pivotal period.

District Superintendents of Police in all three districts have been entrusted with the responsibility of deploying CAPF teams alongside local police for intensive patrolling in sensitive areas. This proactive measure ensures a visible and responsive presence to address any potential incidents, particularly those related to the election. Recent patrols conducted in areas such as Bambooflat, Billiground, and Diglipur serve as a testament to the unwavering dedication of the A & N Police in ensuring a transparent and orderly General Election 2024.

The deployment of CAPF in tandem with local police signifies a steadfast commitment to upholding democratic principles and maintaining public safety. These proactive measures reflect the proactive approach of the A & N Police in fostering an environment conducive to democratic participation, while simultaneously preserving peace and order.

The District Police across all three districts are currently engaged in extensive raids aimed at curbing the illicit distribution of liquor, a tactic often used to influence the voting process. Simultaneously, efforts are underway to clamp down on the illegal sale of liquor by bootleggers throughout the entire Andaman & Nicobar Islands. In these efforts, Andaman & Nicobar Police has succeeded in recovering 151.725 Ltrs of IMFL, 17 Ltrs of illicit liquor, 20 Kgs of Handiya and 524 gms of Ganja during the period from 01/03/2024 to 13/03/2024. Besides, 141 Preventive Challans have been chalked out throughout the Islands.

In addition to these enforcement measures, the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Police are prioritizing the capacity building of all police personnel involved in election security. Various training sessions focusing on the essential do's and don'ts are being conducted for police officers deployed at Polling Stations, Sector Police Officers, as well as police staff assigned to flying squads and static surveillance teams. Supervisory officers are also receiving specialized training to enhance their oversight capabilities during this critical period. The State Police Nodal Officer has also attended a training programme on General Election 2024 at New Delhi.

The general public have been requested to promptly report any instances of anti-social activities that may undermine the integrity of the electoral process by contacting the police at 100, 112, or 1077. The confidentiality of informants will be rigorously protected, a press release from PHQ, A&N Police said.

Workshop on Sustainable Plant Protection Strategies for ANI to be jointly organized by ASA & ICAR- CIARI

Port Blair, Mar. 14

Agriculture in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands faces unique challenges that arise from the region's geographical and climatic characteristics. Though many of the dreadful pathogens and insect pests of various commercial crops do not occur in the Islands, the crops suffer from the pest/ pathogen damage in the absence of a sustainable plant protection measures. Some of the biotic stresses faced by the crops in Andaman and Nicobar Islands include Rhinoceros Beetle in coconut, Banana Bunchy Top Virus (BBTV), bacterial wilt and Phytophthora blight in vegetables, quick and slow wilt in black pepper, bacterial leaf blight and yellow stem borer in rice, pod borer in pulses and polyphagous pests such as mealy bugs, leaf miner, whitefly etc. Further, introduction of new crops without following appropriate quarantine measures could also pose the

risk of inadvertent introduction of new pests in these Islands. Increased awareness among the stakeholders spread across the scattered Islands, early detection of diseases and pests, integrated pest management practices and designing appropriate policy measures are essential to safeguard the Island agriculture.

In order to address this issue, Andaman Science Association (ASA) and ICAR- CIARI will be jointly organizing a Workshop on 'Sustainable Plant Protection Strategies for Andaman and Nicobar Islands (SPPS- 2024)' on March 21 & 22, 2024 at its Garacharma Research Complex. The objective of the workshop is to create awareness about the emerging plant protection challenges in the Islands, to bring out recommendations on sustainable disease and pest management practices appropriate for Island grown crops and to facilitate knowledge exchange

and networking among farmers, agricultural experts, and extension functionaries. The event would include talks by the invited experts on both the days besides an exclusive interaction session involving various stakeholders on island specific pest and disease issues.

Interested stakeholders including Scientists, academicians, progressive farmers, relevant officials of various departments, students and research scholars of Agriculture, Horticulture, Life Sciences background, and gardening enthusiasts may register for the event by 18.03.2024. While sextortion can be perpetrated by individuals, organized crime is often behind it when the blackmailer demands money. The blackmailer may be based in India or outside the country. Both men and women can be victims of this crime.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard oneself: > Avoid replying to unknown video calls, unknown friend requests,



messages from unknown numbers. Similarly avoid sending friend requests to people you do not know. > Avoid sharing your phone number online with anyone unless you know the person well. > Avoid sharing intimate photos or videos with others on social media or other messaging apps, as these may be used for blackmailing. > Keep a record of all contacts from the

blackmailer(s), particularly any demands or threats and make a note of everything you know about them for reporting purposes. No.1-61/Estt/DAH/RR/2019- In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the GOI, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No.14-3/60-ANL dated the 11.04.1960 and in partial modifications of the Andaman and Nicobar Administration's Notification No.1/2010/F.No.1-61/Estt/DAH/RR/ 2009 dated 31.12.2009 and all the other previous Notifications of the posts mentioned below, the Lieutenant Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Group 'C' Digital Machine Operator of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services Department, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, namely:-

1. Short Title and Commencement: -

i. These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration Digital machine Operator in the Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services) Recruitment Rules, 2024.

ii. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay:-

The number of posts, its classification and scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in paras 2 to 4 of the Schedules I annexed hereto.

3. Method of Recruitment, Age limit, Qualifications: -

The method of Recruitment, Age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the post shall be specified in paras 5 to 13 of the said schedules.

4. Disqualification: -

No person-

a. Who has entered into a contracted marriage with a person, having a spouse living, or

b. Who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

Shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the provision of these Rules,

5. Power to Relax: -
