## AAI upgrades category of Veer Savarkar International Airport from Grade III to Grade II Instrument Landing System at VSI Airport to be operational from April 18

Port Blair, Mar. 15

Airports Authority of India (AAI) has upgraded the category of Veer Savarkar International Airport from Grade III to Grade II Airport vide Corporate HRM circular number 7/2024 dated 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2024. The classification of various airports categories is done for the purpose of deciding the level of executive to head the airport and it has been decided based on the parameters such as passengers traffic, development activities, state capital, profitability



and number of employees etc. Veer Savarkar International Airport at Port Blair which was Grade III category airport and headed by Joint General Manager level executive after its

upgradation to Grade II category will be headed by General Manager level executive who will be having more powers to execute works as per the Delegation of Powers by Airports Authority of India.

This is a very positive move by management of Airports Authority of India towards strengthening the administrative framework of the airport for the decision making and

execution of passenger's facilitation centric works.

The New Integrated Terminal Building of Veer Savarkar International Airport, Port Blair was inaugurated on 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi via video conferencing. The commencement of the flight operations from New Integrated Terminal Building has started from 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2023. With a total built up area of 40,837 sqm., the new terminal building is

As part of the ensuing General Elections - 2024, a meeting was held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands, Shri B S Jaglan, IAS in the Mini Conference Hall of the Secretariat today regarding implementation of Model Code of Conduct, monitoring of freebies and illegal cash etc.

Initiating the meeting, the CEO urged the Enforcement Agencies to be on high alert so as to restrict the flow of cash, freebies and drugs through legal channels that is Airports, Ports and by sea routes by small boats. He made a special mention of

fishing boats through which such movement can take place and urged the concerned Departments especially Coast Guard, CISF, Police, Defence and Shipping to be on high alert to check the movement of cash, freebies and drugs, if any, during the election period.

The CEO also urged the Police Marine Force, Defence including Coast Guard and Fisheries Department to make extra efforts and increase surveillance during the Election period to restrict and intercept the movement of cash, freebies and drugs.

During the meeting, the Nodal Officer (IT), Shri Shishir Kumar Mishra

capable of handling 1200 passengers during the busiest operational hour. The passenger volume from April to February this year is more than 13 lakhs and achieved a fairly good growth of 12.5% in comparison to the passenger volume of previous year.

The Instrument Landing System (ILS) at Port Blair Airport will also be operationalized from 18.04.2024. The validation of ILS procedures has been already completed on 22.02.2024 by Vistara flight UK 747 and sent for promulgation to Aeronautical Information Service.

The promulgation NOTAM (notice to airmen) for ILS has already been issued by Aeronautical Information Service vide respective Golf series on 05.03.2024.

The disseminated information under Golf series NOTAM depicts the details of the ILS on Runway 04 facility to be operationalized. The date of commencement of the facility is stated as 18.04.2024 with effect from 0000 GMT (0530 IST). Further, it explains operational characteristics of the facility essential for users. Operationalization of ILS will be a game changer for Civil Aviation in Andaman & Nicobar Islands and a major enabler for monsoon tourism, flight operations in night and bad weather conditions. Year 2024 will be turning point for Civil Aviation in Andaman & Nicobar Islands, a press release from Airport Director, VSI Airport said.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard oneself against hoax pink WhatsApp:

> Do not install pink WhatsApp.  
> If installed immediately uninstall the fake app downloaded on your mobile (go to setting



> Apps > WhatsApp (pink logo) and uninstall it.  
> Never click on links received from unknown sources without proper verification/authentication.  
> Always install apps through official app store of Google/IOS or legitimate website.  
> Do not forward the links or messages to others without authentication/verification.  
> Never share your personal details or financial information like login credentials/passwords/credit or debit card details and other such information online with anyone, as it can be misused.  
> Be aware and alert about such attempts of cyber criminals by keeping track of the latest news and updated on activities of Cyber Fraudsters.

30 days of declaration of election results. Further, it was also appraised that during the election campaigning period, the candidate is required to produce the register either in person or through his election agent or any other person duly authorized by him before the Expenditure Observer/designated officer for inspection at least three times during the campaign period. The gap between two inspections shall be at least three days. This schedule shall be given wide publicity through the press. The last inspection shall be fixed not before 3 days from the day of poll.

The Nodal Officer Training (EEM) gave a detailed presentation explaining the election expenditure monitoring machinery functioning under DEO, S/A and also imparted training on the maintenance of election expenditure account in the prescribed performa provided by ECI. Section 171B, 171E, 171C, 171F, 171 H and 171 I of IPC were also explained in detail to the party functionaries. It was informed that currently the maximum limit prescribed for a candidate for election expenditure is Rs. 75 lakhs.

During the meeting, it was also appraised to them that the candidates have to open a separate bank account for election expenditure. The details of various registers to be maintained by the candidates were also explained to them. The party functionaries were also briefed about the procedure to seek permission for holding public rallies/meetings etc.

The Section 127 A of RP Act, 1951 which mandates submission of declaration by the publisher for printing of Election pamphlet/poster etc. disclosing the identity of the publisher was also explained.

The party functionaries were informed that expenditure exceeding Rs 10,000/- in connection with the election, consisting of a single transaction or an aggregate of transactions, entered into with a single person/entity during the entire poll period shall not be incurred by a candidate/political party unless the payment in respect of the same is made by way of an account payee cheque or draft on a bank or account payee bank draft or by RTGS/NEFT or any other electronic mode linked to the bank account of the candidate.

The Nodal Officer (EEM) circulated the copies of draft rates proposed to be notified for various items pertaining to Election Expenditure. The party representatives also raised certain issues related to facilitating smooth election campaign by contesting candidate for consideration by the appropriate authorities. These include connectivity, permissions and cautious execution of enforcement activities, a press release from Nodal Officer (EEM)/ADM (SA) said.

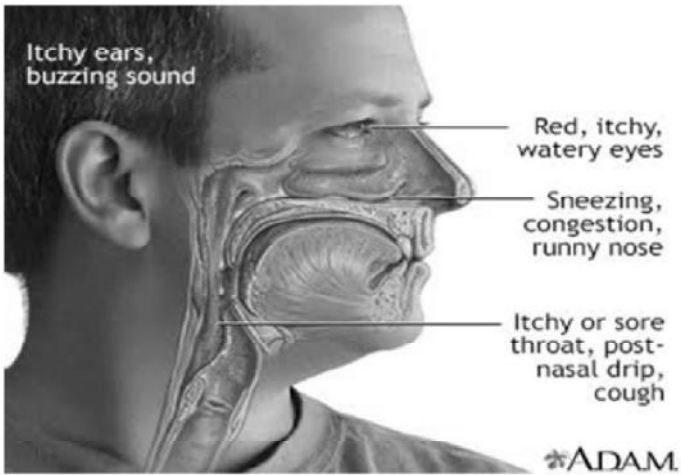

## Scope Of Homoeopathy in Allergic Rhinitis



Allergic Rhinitis, of which the seasonal type is called hay fever, is a type of inflammation in the nose that occurs when the immune system overreacts to allergens in the air. ### Causes

When your body comes into contact with an allergen, it releases histamine which is a natural chemical that defends your body from the allergen. This chemical can cause allergic rhinitis and its symptoms. Inherited genetics and environmental exposures contribute to the development of allergies. The underlying mechanism involves IgE antibodies that attach to an allergen and subsequently result in the release of inflammatory chemicals such as histamine from mast cells. It causes mucous membranes in the nose, eyes and throat to become inflamed and itchy as they work to eject the allergen. Pollen is often considered as a cause of allergic rhinitis, hence called hay fever. Predisposing factors to allergic rhinitis include eczema (atopic dermatitis) and asthma. These three conditions can often occur together which is referred to as the atopic triad.

### Symptoms

You'll usually feel one or more of these symptoms immediately after coming into contact with an allergen. Common symptoms of allergic rhinitis include - sneezing, a runny nose, stuffy nose, watering of eyes, redness of eyes, headache, a sore or scratchy throat.

### Homoeopathic treatment

Homoeopathy is a system of natural medicine that treats the total nasal allergic symptom picture - physical, mental & emotional. It is best for treating all sorts of allergies or allergic disorders. 5 best homoeopathic medicines for allergic rhinitis are -

- 1) Alliumcepa - The watery discharge from the nose is thin and acrid, discharge from the eyes is bland. The patient feels better in the open air.
- 2) Arsenic album - Intense thirst and the patient feels worse in open air. There is copious watery and excoriating discharge from the nose.
- 3) Natrummur - Excessive sneezing and intense dryness of the mouth and mucous membranes. The discharge from the nose is thin and watery and resembles the white of an egg.
- 4) Merc sol - When there is increased sensitivity to both heat and cold and the patient cannot tolerate either. There is a lot of sneezing and watery discharge from the nose.
- 5) Arundo - When the episode begins with intense itching in the palate and the nose. There is a lot of burning and itching in the nose, eyes and roof of the mouth.

Homoeopathic medicines are very safe and do not have any side effects when taken under the supervision of an expert homoeopathic doctor.

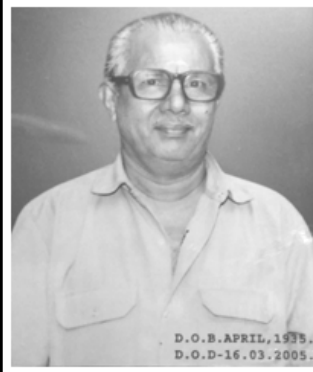

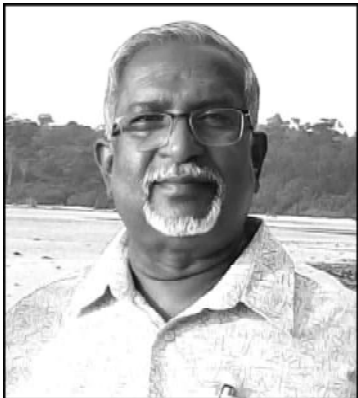
