RO, ANIPC holds meeting with Political Parties

Political Parties advised to adhere to MCC for smooth conduct of election in Isles

Port Blair, Mar. 18

The District Election Officer (South Andaman)/ Returning Officer, A&NI Parliamentary Constituency, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS held a meeting with the representatives of Political Parties in the conference hall of DC Office here today. At the outset, the RO informed the Political Parties about the Election Schedule declared by the ECI on Mar. 16, 2024. The RO further informed that with the announcement of election schedule on March 16, the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) has come into force with immediate effect which has to be strictly adhered to by the Political Parties and the Contesting candidates. He said, any violation of these guidelines shall be strictly dealt with.



Candidates and they can apply for permissions to carry out political activities such as gathering, taking out rallies and use of loudspeaker etc. As per the guidelines of the ECI, the Political Parties have to apply for permission 48 hours before they carry out their activities so that the RO Office can check the requisition properly for the grant of permission. Apart from the Suvidha Portal of the ECI, 'Permission Cells' have been created in all the 3 District Offices. If any Political Party/ candidate desires to carry out political activity, the 'Permission Cell' will facilitate for the same, the RO said adding that there are different types of permissions which Political Parties/ candidates have to take before they start their political activities adhering to the MCC in place. Apart from the MCC, the ECI also focuses on Election Expenditure Monitoring, the RO said adding that all the expenditure for campaigning by the Political Parties is accounted for. The limit of the Election Campaigning by the Political Parties in ANIPC is Rs. 75 lakh. An Expenditure Observer will be deputed for A&N Islands who will co-ordinate with the Expenditure Team to monitor Expenditure, the RO said. He said that the candidates have to

RO, ANIPC briefs Mediapersons on General Election-2024

Urges for strict adherence to MCC to provide a level playing field during elections

Port Blair, Mar. 18

As part of the General Election-2024, the Returning Officer, ANIPC, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS today held a meeting with the mediapersons in the conference hall of the DC Office. Chairing the meeting, the RO informed that the Election Commission of India on March 16, 2024 has announced the schedule of General Elections to 18th Lok Sabha which will be held in 7 phases. As per the schedule, the lone Parliamentary Constituency of Andaman & Nicobar Islands will be going to polls in the First Phase on April 19, 2024.



Giving the details of the election schedule, the RO said as per the declaration of Election, the Gazette notification will be issued on March 20, 2024 which will pave the way for the contesting candidates to file their nominations. The last date for making the

nominations is March 27, 2024. The date of scrutiny of nomination papers is March 28, 2024 while the last date for withdrawal of candidature is March 30, 2024. The date of polling is April 19, 2024. The date of counting is June, 4 while the date before which election shall be completed is June 6, 2024, the RO added. The RO further informed that with the announcement of election schedule on March 16, the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) has come into force with immediate effect and any violations of these guidelines shall be strictly dealt with.

The MCC is a set of guidelines issued by the ECI to regulate the activities of political parties and candidates prior to elections to provide a level playing field to the candidates and for conducting free, fair and transparent elections, he said. For the implementation of MCC in letter and

spirit, Flying Squad, Static Surveillance, Video Surveillance and Video Viewing, Excise, Expenditure teams with Police Personnel have been formed in all the 3 districts to check the MCC violations. All these teams are on their job and the daily reporting to the ECI

Printing Press Units asked to clearly indicate the name and address of publisher and printer on all election pamphlets / posters

Port Blair, Mar. 18

A meeting was held today in the Conference Hall of District Office, South Andaman under the Chairmanship of Returning Officer, A&N Islands, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS with the owners of Printing Presses to sensitize them on the ECI's instructions on restrictions on the printing of related pamphlets, posters during conduct of election.



At the outset the Returning Officer, A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency welcomed the owners of Printing Presses present in the meeting. The RO at the outset informed that the Election Commission of India has announced the schedule of General Elections on 16/03/2024 thereby, enforcing the Model Code of Conduct with immediate effect. He said, consequent upon

announcement of General Election-2024, attention of all concerned has been invited towards the envisaged provisions provided under Section 127-A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 which states that: "> No person shall print or publish, or cause to be printed or published, any election pamphlet or poster which does not bear on its face the names and addresses of the printer and the publisher thereof. > No person shall print or cause to be printed any election pamphlet or poster

(a) Unless a declaration as to the identity of publisher thereof, signed by him and attested by two persons to whom he is personally known, is delivered by him to the printer in duplicate...." He urged the owners of Printing Presses that the envisaged provisions provided under Section 127-A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 need to be adhered to carefully while printing of pamphlets, posters and other election related materials used in

electioneering. The RO urged the owners of the Printing Presses to be careful while printing of pamphlets, posters and other election related materials used in electioneering. He said that the Printing Press Units have to clearly indicate in the print line the names and addresses of publisher, name of the printer on all election pamphlets or posters, such other materials printed. Printing Press Units have to send the copies of the printed

about MCC have also started. All the MCC teams have been briefed about the SoP pertaining to seizure of any cash, liquor or any freebies, gifts used for inducement of voters and the teams were sensitized about the important responsibility they carry to ensure a free and fair election. Any violations of MCC will be dealt with seriously and no mercy will be shown on this count, the RO cautioned.

The RO further informed that some orders pertaining to section 144 have been promulgated related to use of loudspeakers, Arms licenses which are in force. The gathering for political activities will only be allowed with the permission of the RO for which 'Permission Cells' have been created in all the 3 District Offices. If any Political Party/candidate desires to carry out political activity, the 'Permission Cell' will facilitate for the same, the RO said adding that apart from District Offices, the ECI has also made available all these facilities in online mode through its portal <https://www.eci.gov.in/suvidha-candidate>. Apart from this, for the facilitation of Political Parties and Candidates, a 'Nomination Cell' has been established in RO Office so as to facilitate the candidates while filing their nominations.

Giving the basic Electoral information of the ANIPC, the RO said, A&N Islands have 412 Polling Stations covering all the 3 Districts, out of which, 223 is in South Andaman, 57 in Nicobar and 132 in North & Middle Andaman. As per the guidelines of ECI, it will be ensured that every Polling Station is equipped with Assured Minimum Facilities (AMF) like drinking water, shed, toilet, ramp for the physically challenged voters etc. on the poll day.

The RO informed the formation of Media Cell and also about the Media Certification & Monitoring Committee (MCMC) to check the Paid News and also to pre-certify the advertisements in electronic and print media prior to its publication. The RO informed that 'Paid News' has been defined by the Press Council of India as 'any news or analysis appearing in any media (print and electronic) for a price in cash or kind as consideration'. The Media Certification and Monitoring Committee (MCMC) shall be keeping an eye on all the newspapers, print media, electronic media, etc., and keep record of the advertisements, advertorials, messages, discussions and interviews relating to the candidates and parties so as to monitor any surrogate advertisements/paid news being published to favour any particular party/contesting candidates, he said. It is mandatory to pre-certify all the advertisements from MCMC on the poll day and the day prior to poll day, the RO said.

The RO said, to increase the voting percentage in A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency, SVEEP activities are being carried out in a broad scale so that people take part in our democratic process in large numbers. The SVEEP team is very active and conducted 'Nukkad Natak' at various places. 'Electoral Literacy Clubs have been formed in schools and colleges which are very active and paved way for incorporating more young voters. BLOs have also ensured that those attained 18 years of age are not left behind in voting, the RO added.

The RO said, for the first time, an all women Polling Booth has been created which will be manned by all women polling personnel. A total of 9 such polling booths have been set up covering A&N Islands and as per the guidelines of the ECI, it has been named as 'Pink Polling Stations'. Apart from this, Model Polling Stations will also be created with additional facilities like IEC activities, availability of information regarding Elections, with better upkeep and beautification.

The RO further stated that this time the ECI has provided a detailed guideline for Postal Ballot. To facilitate the Service Voters, the ECI has made electronic ballots for Service Voters. The facility of Postal Ballot has also been made available for absentee voters which covers senior citizens (above 85 years), persons with disability and persons affected by COVID. Election Duty Certificate will be issued to the Election staff and Police Personnel on duty to enable them to cast their votes without any problem at the Polling Stations where they are on duty.

In his closing remarks, the RO urged the mediapersons to adhere to the MCC in letter & spirit in order to provide a level playing field for the political parties and contesting candidates during the elections and sought the co-operation of all the mediapersons in the conduct of free, fair and transparent elections in ANIPC.

In her address, Smt. Niharika Bhatt, IPS, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman said that as part of the General Election 2024, stringent security measures have been implemented in South Andaman District. To enhance better vigil and to further strengthen the law & order, one Company of the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) has been strategically deployed across various Police Stations in the district. Flag marches, area patrolling and establishing checkpoints (Nakas) are being done to ensure anti-social elements don't influence or adversely affect the upcoming elections. Paramount importance is placed on safeguarding the safety and security of the general public during this crucial period.

materials (alongwith three extra copies of each such printed material) within three days of printing to the Nodal officer, Election Expenditure Monitoring (EEM), South Andaman.

Any contravention of the provision of Section 127-A of the Representation of People Act, 1951 shall be viewed seriously, which may attract penal provisions including revocation of the license of the printing press under the relevant provisions provided under the Statute, the RO cautioned.

submit their final accounts 30 days before the date of Counting failing which as per election Rules & Election Manuals, action will be taken by the ECI, to the extent of disqualification of the candidature of the Candidate.

The RO urged the Political Parties to get the advertisement pre-certified to be circulated in Print/Electronic Media by the MCMC formed for this purpose. The RO said a 24X7 Call Centre 1950 is operational from where required information can be gathered. The maximum number of vehicles allowed within the periphery of 100 meters of Returning Officers'/Assistant Returning Officers' Office on behalf of a candidate visiting the said office to file his nomination paper in a procession/ convoy of vehicles, shall be only three, the RO said adding that during the period of election, no private vehicles shall be allowed to enter the campus of Returning Officer without valid permit. He also urged the contesting candidates to open a Bank Account which will only be meant for Election Expenditure purpose. The candidates have to take oath before the RO soon after filing the nomination papers. Security deposit by the contesting candidates through Treasury Challan is preferred, the RO said.

The RO urged the Political Parties to send their representatives as per the election norms during the process of EVM commissioning, preparation of polling kits, despatch of EVMs so that everyone is sure & confident that Election is conducted in a free, fair and transparent manner.

Concluding the meeting, the RO said, for the implementation of MCC in letter and spirit, Flying Squad, Static Surveillance, Video Surveillance and Video Viewing, Excise, Expenditure teams with Police Personnel have been formed in all the 3 districts to check the MCC violations. He urged the Political Parties to adhere to the MCC for the smooth conduct of the election which is very important for the country's democracy.

Sailing of MV Bharat Seema on Mar. 20 cancelled

Little Andaman bound passengers those who are holding the tickets of MV Bharat Seema for March 20 sailing have been advised to cancel their tickets and get full refund, a press release from DSS said.

CID team busts gambling den; 8 persons arrested

Port Blair, Mar. 18

Keeping its commitment of zero tolerance against illegal activities, on March 16, 2024, team of PS Central Crime Station conducted raid at Attam Pahar behind Industrial Estate where some people were found to be involved in gambling. The Police team successfully caught all the gamblers who tried to flee from the spot on seeing them. All the 8 people involved were arrested and Rs. 20,530/- in cash was recovered from their possession with board money of Rs.16,240/-. They have been prosecuted under Sections 5/7 of Andaman and Nicobar Gambling Regulation, 1951.

AND, WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India has issued specific instructions vide letter No. 3/8/2000 J.S.II Dt. 26/12/2000, underscoring the emergent need to regulate the unfettered use of loudspeakers during election campaigning by the Political parties/Candidates/Supporters which is not only creates noise pollution in the locality but also causing annoyance to the General public, discomfort to the sick and elderly persons and in particular interrupts the student community;

AND, WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India in pursuance to the Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order Dt. 18/07/2005 has restricted the timing for use of loudspeakers or any sound amplifier, by substituting the earlier specific provisions promulgated vide letter No. 3/8/2005/JS-II Dt. 26/12/2000 with letter No. 3/8/2005/JS-I Dt. 26/09/2005, relevant portion of substitution is reproduced as under:

"3(1) A public address system or loudspeaker or any sound amplifier, whether fitted on vehicles or any kind whatsoever, or in static position used for public meetings for electioneering purposes, shall not be used at night between 10.00 p.m. and 6.00 am.

AND, WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India has laid down specific guidelines inter-alia to regulate the procedures for seeking permission for use of Loudspeakers from the Authorities during electioneering to be adopted by the Political parties/Candidates for strict compliance;

AND, WHEREAS, there is sufficient ground to invoke the provisions provided under Section 144 of Cr. PC, 1973 for stricter adherence of the Instructions issued by the Commission for use of Loudspeakers for electioneering:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Dilkhush Meena, IAS, District Magistrate, North & Middle Andaman District in exercise of the powers conferred upon me u/s 144 of Cr. Pc do hereby prohibit the use of Loudspeakers from 2200 Hrs to 0600 Hrs with the enforcement of Model Code of Conduct during campaigning of General Elections-2024;

Any violation of this Order shall attract penal provisions provided u/s 188 of IPC and other relevant provisions of law;

The present situation warrants immediate attention which involves large public interest owing to emergent nature of case where the serving circumstances do not permit of the serving in due time a notice upon the concerned, hence, this Order is passed ex-parte under section 144 (2) of the Cr. PC, 1973 calling upon all the Stakeholders for strict adherence.

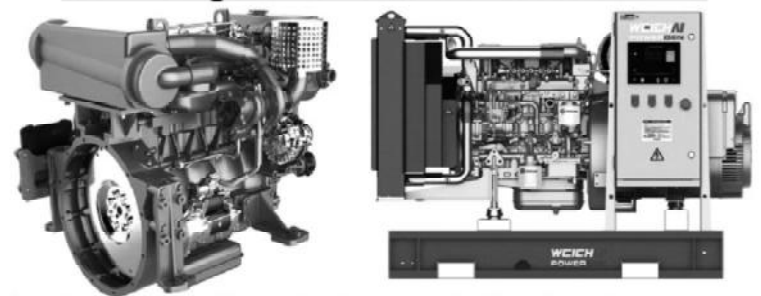

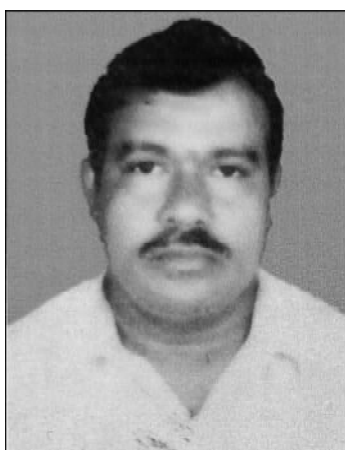
