Workshop aims at organizing and presenting various aspects of Sri Vijaya Puram City

A workshop on the theme 'Curating City Experience' was held in the Conference Hall of the Directorate of Disaster Management here today. Organised by the Tourism Department, the workshop was inaugurated by the Secretary, Tourism, Ms. Jyoti Kumari, IAS, as the chief guest. 'Curating City Experience' in tourism involves organizing and presenting aspects of a city, like attractions, events, and local culture, in a way that is engaging, relevant, and inspiring for visitors.

In her address, the Secretary, Tourism said that the workshop is the outcome of the two-days UT Level Conference held last month, during which, one theme which cropped up was whether we were able to give the tourists the real feel of A&N Islands. "Our Islands are famous for nature and adventure and there is need to weave things around in a story format

South Andaman Forest Division seizes illegal hand sawn padauk timber

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 16

In the morning hours of 16th May, 2025, the Forest Officials of the Mobile Squad Range conducted a successful routine patrolling operation in coordination with Garacharma Range. The operation resulted in the detection and seizure of illegally possessed hand sawn timber of Padauk wood, category I(A) from M/s Raju Furniture Mart, Dollygunj.

The operation was led by Smti Abida Bibi, Forest Guard, Mobile Squad Range in active coordination with team members Shri John Chrisostom, Forest Guard, Mobile Squad Range, Shri Jagdeep Lall, Forest Guard, Garacharma Range, Shri Ganesh Sahu, Mazdoor, Shri Paul Mark, Mazdoor, Shri Vishal Minj, Mazdoor & other Mazdoors of Garacharma Range under South Andaman



Forest Division. The team detected the illegally possessed hand sawn timber in the furniture unit during their working and enquired about the relevant documents of the hand sawn timber which the Furniture unit staff could not furnish. The team carried out an intensive search of the unit and recovered all the illegally possessed hand sawn timber from the unit.

The operation resulted in the seizure of illegally possessed 44 pieces/ 0.506 cbm of hand sawn Padauk timber involved in the illegal activity. The accused involved in the operation was arrested on the spot under relevant

sections for violation of ANI Forest Produce Transit Rule 1966 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 and was subsequently released on bail bond from the Range Officer, Garacharma Range.

Further investigations are going on to ascertain the origin of the illegally possessed hand sawn timber. General public have been requested to pass on any credible information of illegal activities related to Forest and Wildlife offense via Helpline Number 03192-255228. Identity of the informers will be kept confidential, a press release from DFO (SA) said.

In addition to the above, the supply may remain affected on 17.05.2024 between 0730 hrs to 1200 hrs in Sri Vijaya Puram and South Andaman areas on an as-and-when-required due to urgent breakdown maintenance of Panther-I and Panther-II main Transmission Line at Bambooflat and Andhabeda area. During the maintenance of Panther-I and Panther-II line, power supply of the area feeding through the Panel-5 and Shoal Bay & Ferargunj feeders will also be shut down as per schedule given below :

the relevant provisions of MV Act and Rules. In order to curb the violations related to plying vehicles without proper documents, enforcement drive was conducted by the officials of Transport Department at various places in the UT in the second week of May, 2025 in Sri Vijaya Puram, Ferrargunj, Mayabunder, Hutbay, Swaraj Dweep & Diglipur.

Sensing the importance of this aspect, Enforcement teams have been constituted by the Director of Transport under the guidance of Secretary (Transport) in all Islands for checking of motor vehicles plying on the road which include commercial as well as personal vehicles. Intention of the enforcement is not only to sensitize the motor vehicle drivers towards total compliance to the motor vehicle laws in true spirit but also to take action against the violators through spot compounding against the violators. Apart from on the spot compounding by way of challans for violation, separate compilation of data is also carried out for identifying repeated violations, so as to initiate appropriate penal action as per law.

Different types of violations were observed during the enforcement drive. A total of 58 vehicles/riders were challaned for various violations of MV Act and MV Rules and at the same time, they were sensitized about the legal provisions related to Motor Vehicles Laws along with road safety aspects.

Common violations observed were driving without seat belt, driving without valid Insurance, driving without PUC, driving Autorickshaw without putting on the fare meters, expired fitness & permit validity, riding without prescribed helmets, over speed etc.

All motor vehicle drivers and riders have once again been advised to follow the motor vehicle laws diligently as these are crucial for personal safety and legal compliance. General public have also been informed that facilities for proper implementation of MV Act and Rules which includes all the works related to registration of Motor Vehicles and Driver Licensing are available in all the STS Unit Offices functioning in the UT. Such enforcement drives will continue and motor vehicle drivers/riders found violating the provisions of Motor Vehicle Act, Rules and Rules of Road Regulations will be penalized as per the law, a press release from Transport Department said.
