

7th State Level U-17 Boys Football Tournament
Little Andaman to take on Car Nicobar
in final at Netaji Stadium today

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 25
In the finale of the 7th State Level U-17 Boys Football Tournament, the team Little Andaman will lock horns with Car Nicobar tomorrow (May 26) at 3 PM at Netaji Stadium while semi-final loosers viz Rangat and Nancowrie will clash for the third-place match scheduled tomorrow (May 26) at 6 AM at JNRM Ground.

Meanwhile, the fourth day of the Tournament at Netaji Stadium today witnessed thrilling action as the semi-final clashes kept spectators on the edge of their seats, with teams putting everything on the line for a spot in the much-anticipated final.

In the first semi-final, Rangat faced off against Little Andaman in a hard-fought match that



remained goalless through both regular and extra time. The game was ultimately decided by a tiebreaker, where Little Andaman triumphed 03-01 to secure their place in the final.

The second semi-final between Car Nicobar and Nancowrie was the most exciting and nail-

biting match of the tournament so far. Both teams scored a goal each during regulation and extra time, leading to a dramatic tiebreaker. In a tense shootout, Car Nicobar edged past Nancowrie 06-05, booking their spot in the grand finale, a press release from Education Deptt. said.

PM lauds Indian soldiers for precision strikes...

He expressed happiness that this time as well, youth is going to perform yoga at iconic places related to Indian heritage. Many youth have pledged to create a record and become a part of the Yoga Chain. Shri Modi also praised the efforts of corporates. Some Institutions have set aside a separate place for yoga practice in their offices. Some start-ups have set up 'office yoga hours'. There are also people who are preparing to go to villages and teach yoga. Prime Minister expressed joy at this awareness about health and fitness.

On the topic of Ayurveda, Prime Minister shared that an MoU was signed in the presence of WHO, Director General, Dr. Tedros Ghebreyesus yesterday. Along with this agreement, work has started on a dedicated traditional medicine module under the International Classification of Health Interventions. This initiative will help in making AYUSH reach maximum number of people across the world in a scientific manner.

Prime Minister also spoke about 'Sugar Boards' being installed in some schools. The aim of this unique initiative of CBSE is to make children aware of their sugar intake. Shri Modi hailed this unique effort, saying it will prove to be very helpful in inculcating healthy lifestyle habits in children. He stated that Fit India is the foundation of a strong India.

Prime Minister spoke about cleanliness and cited an example of members of ITBP team. This team went to climb the world's most difficult peak, Mount Makalu. At the same time, they added another mission of 'cleanliness' to their goal. They took up the task of removing the garbage lying near the peak. Shri Modi expressed awe that the members of this team brought down more than 150 kg of non-biodegradable waste.

Prime Minister also spoke about paper waste and recycling in this episode of 'Mann Ki Baat'. He said that a fourth of the country's landfill waste is related to paper. He stressed the need for every person to think about paper recycling, saying many Indian Start-Ups are doing excellent work in this sector. In cities like Visakhapatnam and Gurugram, many Start-Ups are adopting innovative methods of paper recycling. Some are making packaging boards from recycled paper, and others are making newspaper recycling easier through digital methods.

Prime Minister stated that the Khelo India Games were a big hit. Five cities of Bihar hosted the Khelo India Games. Shri Modi said that over five thousand athletes reached Bihar from all over India. These athletes have praised the sporting spirit of Bihar and the warmth shown by the people there. Prime Minister congratulated all the medal winners, especially the top three winners - Maharashtra, Haryana and Rajasthan. He said a total of 26 records were made in Khelo India Games this time.

World Bee Day was celebrated on the 20th of May. Prime Minister said this day is also an example of health, self-employment and self-reliance. He observed that during the last 11 years, a sweet revolution has taken place in beekeeping in India. About a decade ago, honey production in India was around 70-75 thousand metric tons a year. Shri Modi expressed happiness that today, it has gone up to around 1.25 lakh metric tons. This is an increase of about 60 percent in honey production. India has become one of the leading countries in the world in honey production and export. Shri Modi said National Beekeeping and 'Honey Mission' have a big role in this positive impact. Under this, thousands of farmers associated with beekeeping were imparted training, equipment and their direct access to the market was created.

Shri Modi opined that protection of honeybees is protection of environment, as well as protection of nation's agriculture and future generations. He mentioned Amit from Pune who formed a team named Bee Friends. These Bee Friends transfer beehives from one place to another in a safe manner, so that people are not in danger and the honeybees also stay alive.

teams to locate and retrieve the missing individuals. Simultaneously, a simulated fire broke out near the mortuary section. The ward's fire response team initiated fire fighting measures to contain the blaze.

Upon receiving the mock incident report, personnel from the Fire Department, Police, District Administration, and National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) promptly arrived on the scene. Under the coordination of the IC, the Departments worked in unison with the ward teams to extinguish the fire, rescue the missing individuals, and administer first aid to the injured. Doctors on-site examined the injured, and those with major injuries were shifted to the main G.B. Pant Hospital for further medical treatment. The drill concluded with the Incident Commander issuing an "All Clear" signal at 12.15 pm.

During the debriefing session, Shri Janik Ram, Assistant Director, Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration commended all doctors and paramedical staff for their active participation and prompt response during the drill. Dr. B. Ajith Kumar and Dr. Rajeev Ghosh, Nodal Officers from the Directorate of Health Services (DHS), A&N Administration extended their gratitude to all supporting Departments for their cooperation and assistance in the successful completion of the drill, a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.
