Centre notifies Galathea Bay as a 'Major Port'

Synopsis

The Government has designated Galathea Bay in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands as a 'Major Port'. This Rs 44,000 crore project will be developed under a public-private partnership model and aims to capture transshipped cargo currently handled outside India. The first phase is expected to be operational by 2028.

The centre has notified the international transshipment hub at Galathea Bay in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands as a 'Major Port'. With this, the proposed Rs 44,000 crore mega project is officially under the administrative control of the Union Ports, Shipping, and Waterways Ministry. It is also eligible for central funding and will be developed under the public-private

partnership model.

India currently has 12 operational Major Ports controlled by the central Government and another 200 non-major ones governed by the states. Out of the 200 non-major ports, around 65 handle cargo while the others are used by fishing vessels and by small ferries to carry passengers.

Once operational, the Galathea Bay project will help capture a large share of transshipped

cargo which is handled at ports outside India.

The proposed facility is envisaged to be developed in four phases with Phase 1 is proposed to be commissioned in the year 2028 with handling capacity of approximately 4 Million TEUs, increasing to 16 Million TEUs in the

ultimate stage of development by 2058.

It has also been decided to develop three Mega Ports - Vadhavan-Jawaharlal Nehru Port Authority (JNPA) Cluster, Paradip Port, and Deendayal Port. These will be upgraded into Mega Ports with a capacity of over 300 million tonnes

per annum (MTPA).

Under the Maritime AmritKaal Vision 2047, four port clusters with a capacity of more than 300 MTPA and two with capacity of more than 500 MTPA will be developed. (This news article was published in The Economic Times on Sept. 05, 2024)

Flybig to start seaplane operations in Andaman and Nicobar

In August, the Ministry of Civil Aviation launched Guidelines for Seaplane Operations under the regional connectivity scheme Udan.

Following the easing of guidelines for seaplane operations, regional airline flybig plans to commence services in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Speaking to FE, Flybig's CMD, Sanjay Mandavia, said that the planned operations will be the first seaplane flights from Car Nicobar Airport and Campbell Bay Airport.

The regional airline

plans to deploy De Havilland Canada Twin Otter aircraft on these routes. "Will potentially start by the end of the year or early next year depending on approvals and arrival of our first aircraft," he told FE.

The airline's first Twin Otter aircraft is

slated to join the fleet by the end of October.

"Flybig has recently concluded an agreement with the Government and the Airports Authority of India (AAI), which will enable us to make this strategic move," Mandavia told FE.

According to

Mandavia, the De Havilland Canada Twin Otter aircraft, are "perfectly suited" for operations in the islands. This type of aircraft, he said, is capable of landing on both water and land and will enable flybig to connect remote regions and promote tourism in

the archipelago.

In August, the Ministry of Civil Aviation launched Guidelines for Seaplane Operations under the regional connectivity scheme Udan.

Several firms, including Spice Jet, Mehair, and Heritage Aviation, along with global OEMs, have shown interest in this emerging sector. (This news article was published in Financial Express on Sept. 6, 2024)

Swift Justice: Court convicts accused in PS Kalighat NDPS case
