He stated that technologies such as Open Sea Submerged Fish Cages and Sub-Sea Fish Feeder System can empower island fishermen with advanced tools for sustainable and profitable marine practices. Several key technological innovations

were launched. These include the Open Sea Submerged Fish Cage, which enables aquaculture operations in deeper and more dynamic marine environments and overcomes problems raised due to high surface current, waves action and other surface disturbances etc. which creates more stress to fish, problems of algal blooms at surface which affects fish growth due to non-availabilities of dissolved oxygen, and

The Assistant Commissioner lauded the community's response and reaffirmed the Administration's commitment to uplift artisans and integrate them into the mainstream economy. He encouraged continued cooperation to ensure no eligible artisan is left out.

The camp concluded on a positive note with the participation of about 30 artisans. More such camps are scheduled to maximize outreach and awareness. For details, beneficiaries may contact the local Administration or visit the PM Vishwakarma portal, a press release from AC, Rangat said.

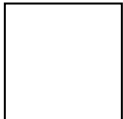
