Successful search operation by Campbell Bay Police results in recovery of narcotic drug

Campbell Bay, May 17
In continuation of the firm stance of zero tolerance against drug menace, the Campbell Bay Police has achieved a significant breakthrough in their ongoing efforts to curb narcotics trafficking. In a meticulously planned jungle search operation in Babu Line & RPRS area, the Campbell Bay Police led by Sub-Inspector Roshan George, SHO Campbell Bay, uncovered a substantial amount of unclaimed narcotic drugs. The dedicated task force comprising of Sub-Inspector Siva Kumar, Head Constable Meiyappan, and Police Constables Bikash Sen, Anup, and Shahir, conducted a thorough search operation aimed at detecting illicit activities in the area.



During the operation, the team ventured to B-Quarry Sea beach where they made a huge recovery of approximately 16 kilograms of narcotics, suspected to be heroin. The origin of these drugs is believed to be from international waters, indicated by a 'Made in Taiwan' marking on one of the seized items. The estimated value of this significant seizure is believed to exceed 50 crores.

ICAR-CIARI and TIFAC, DST conduct meeting on 'Climate Resilient Technologies for Island Agriculture'

ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute (CIARI), Port Blair, in collaboration with the Technology Innovation Forecasting and Assessment Council (TIFAC), DST, New Delhi, organized a Round Table Discussion on 'Climate Resilient Agriculture Technologies for Islands' on May 15, 2024, at ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair.

A&N Police intensifies Traffic Enforcement Challan/fine amount crosses Rs. one crore in 4 and 1/2 months

Port Blair, May 17

The Andaman & Nicobar Police has achieved series of accomplishments in enhancing road safety and managing traffic effectively across the islands, as well as to minimize road accidents.

Through concerted efforts and strategic initiatives, the Department has made substantial progress in promoting safer roads and fostering awareness among citizens, in tandem with all stakeholders.

Key achievements of Andaman & Nicobar Police for promoting road safety awareness and improving traffic scenario during the year 2024:

> **MV Act Fine Collection Surpasses 1 Crore:** The diligent efforts of the Andaman & Nicobar Police have resulted in the collection of fines exceeding 1 crore (Rs.1,00,97,700/-) under the Motor Vehicles Act since 1st January, 2024. This substantial amount underscores its commitment to enforcing traffic regulations and ensuring adherence to road safety norms. A total of 18,650 challans were issued to traffic violators. This demonstrates our unwavering resolve to hold individuals accountable for their actions on the road.

> **Crackdown on Drunken Driving:** Driving under the influence of liquor poses a grave risk to road users.



Dealing with this menace, the A&N Police have apprehended 1,117 individuals in the year 2024 for drunken driving, sending a strong message against this reckless behaviour. During the last year (2023), more than Rs. 1.1 crore fine was imposed for violators of drunken
