## Vigilant and alert citizens help in preventing cyber-crimes by reporting fraudulent call attempts

### Sanchar Saathi in action, citizens and DoT collaborate to fight cyber crime

New Delhi, May 22 (PIB)

Vigilant and alert citizens are playing an indispensable role in preventing cybercrimes. Through their proactive reporting of suspected fraud communications via the Chakshu-Report Suspected Fraud Communications facility on the Sanchar Saathi portal, these alert citizens are contributing significantly to a safer digital environment.

Their watchful eyes and swift actions protect not only themselves but also countless others from falling victim to scams, phishing attempts, and fraudulent activities. By reporting suspicious messages, calls, and impersonation attempts, these citizens act as the first line of defence against cyber criminals.

This prompt approach of citizens helps the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) combat and prevent cybercrimes. The DoT expresses gratitude to the vigilant citizens who enable the Department



in ensuring a safer and secure digital ecosystem. With these inputs, the DoT has been taking prompt and strict action on cyber/ financial frauds. In the latest cases, people were being duped by fraudulent communication in the name of fake LIC officials and Insurance company representatives and SMSs for redemption of SBI Rewards.

The DoT received inputs from citizens on 19.05.2024 regarding such frauds from 14 mobile numbers.

**Action taken by DoT:**

Within 24 hours, the DoT analyzed these cases and generated all linkages for these mobile numbers. Therefore, 372 mobile handsets linked to these mobile numbers were blocked on pan-India basis on 21.05.2024. Also, 906 mobile connections were suspended and flagged for re-verification.

The Department has urged citizens to stay vigilant and report such fraud communications at 'Chakshu - Report Suspected Fraud Communications' facility of Sanchar Saathi portal ([www.sancharsaathi.gov.in/sfc](http://www.sancharsaathi.gov.in/sfc)). Such proactive reporting helps DoT in prevention of misuse of telecom resources for

The Government of India's initiative to integrate emergency Helplines into a single Helpline has resulted in the rolling out of 112 number. ERSS is a unified, Andaman-wide response system, accessible through the single number 112, providing immediate assistance from agencies such as Police (100), Fire (101), Health (102) and Disaster Management.

Any citizen in distress can dial 112 from their



phones; press the power button thrice on any smart phone, or long-press the "5" or "9" key on a regular phone to activate a panic call to the dedicated DIAL 112 Control Room. Additionally, SOS alerts can be sent via email or by using the 112 India mobile app, available for free

on Google Play Store and Apple Store.

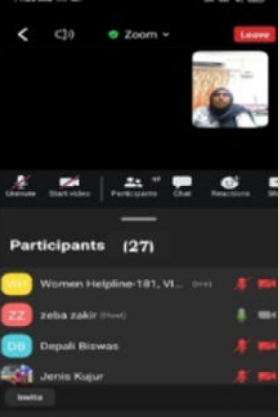
This system includes a dedicated DIAL 112 Control Room staffed with trained call-takers and dispatchers to handle emergency requests for assistance from Police, Fire, Health, and other agencies. All call logs are maintained digitally. This Control Room is linked to Emergency Response Vehicles and Control Rooms of various Departments to provide assistance to victims, a press release from SP (SA) said.

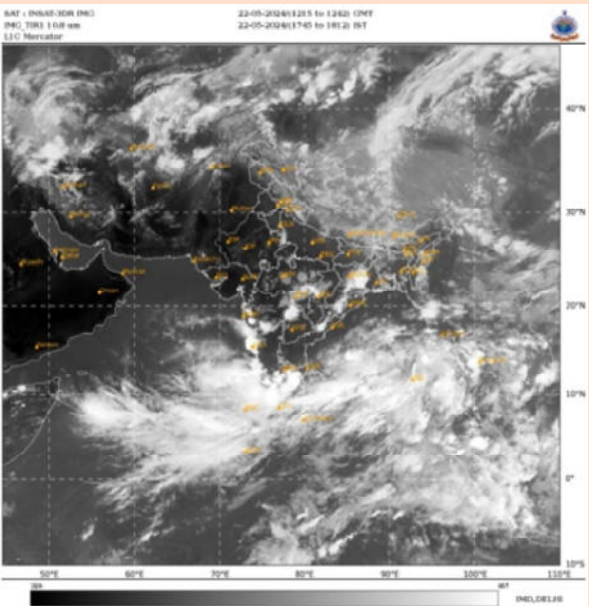

Adhoc/Contract employees are not eligible for allotment of Government Residential Accommodation under General Pool and as such their applications will not be entertained.

Applications from the Government servants who are on fresh appointment or on transfer from Out Station or on Deputation (after last date of receipt of online application i.e., 14/06/2024) and 'Out of Turn' allotment on medical ground shall be received throughout the year through online and their placement in the seniority list shall be made accordingly.

The allottee/ occupants who desire to apply for change of their present quarter to Same Type on repair/medical/mutual/transferral grounds etc. and Higher Type shall also register their applications on online portal only. No hard copy of application is required to be submitted or forwarded to Assistant Secretary (H&E), Secretariat and such applications will not be entertained.

Note:

i) The applicants, who intends to apply for allotment of Government Accommodation on seniority basis, should upload recent passport size photo, signature, copy of initial appointment order, pay slip, transfer order/deputation order (in case of transfer/ deputation from out station after the last date of receipt of online application) in the online portal for verification of concerned DDOs and Assistant Secretary(H&E). Photo & Signature should be in jpg/jpeg. format (size 20-50 kbs) and documents should be in complete shape & in jpg/jpeg/pdf format (size 20-200 kbs) only.

ii) The applicants those who desire to apply for change of quarter for Same Type should upload copy of quarter allotment order/occupation report in the online portal alongwith the documents mentioned at Sl.No.(i).

iii) The applicants those who desire to apply for 'Out of Turn' allotment on medical ground should upload copies of latest medical certificates in the online portal for verification of Medical Board alongwith the documents mentioned at Sl.No.(i).

iv) Online registration of application is available in the portal <https://aaga.andaman.gov.in> from 16/05/2024 to 14/06/2024.

v) The applicants should register online application form very carefully as no option for alternation/modification in the submitted application is available in the portal. On rejection of application, the applicant should again submit fresh application in the online portal within the stipulated period.

vi) The applicant should ensure that his application is verified and accepted by his DDO/HOO within two days of its submission and within the stipulated period. No request for acceptance of delayed application shall be entertained.

vii) The applicant should provide/ fill all the mandatory details in Capital Letters in the online portal and upload documents in complete shape, failing which, the application will not be accepted by the concerned DDOs and Assistant Secretary (H&E) or summarily rejected.

viii) Before registering online application, the applicants should watch the videos provided in the homepage of AAGA portal.

ix) The portal will also allow the applicant to take printout of the submitted application for record purpose only, a press release from Assistant Secretary (H&E) said.

Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) Gen Anil Chauhan has called upon the three services to create a Joint Culture as they move towards forming Joint Operational Structures. Speaking on 'Jointmanship: The Way Ahead' as part of 22<sup>nd</sup> Major General Samir Sinha Memorial Lecture organised at USI of India in New Delhi, the CDS termed developing Joint Culture in Armed Forces as Jointness 2.0, which is the way forward.

The Chief of Defence Staff said, Jointness 1.0 was about better bonhomie and consensus among the services, and as there were no major differences, there is an impetus to move towards the next level of Jointness which is Jointness 2.0.

Acknowledging the distinct culture of all the three Services, the CDS underscored that there was a need to create a fourth culture in the services. "Joint Culture though different from Service specific Culture, needs to respect the uniqueness of each service. We must be able to distill the best of each service, and incorporate the Highest Common Factor, rather than settle for the Least Common Denominator," said the Chief of Defence Staff. He mentioned various initiatives of symbology that were being processed towards fostering the Joint



Culture, including Tri-Services participation in national events.

The CDS termed Jointness & Integration as pre-requisites to the creation of functional Integrated Theatre Commands, and explained the significance of such Commands. "The creation of such commands will separate the 'operational' functions from the Raise-Train-Sustain (RTS) and other administrative functions, and will allow greater focus of the operational commander to matters of security," he said.

The CDS said the Theatre Commands will not be an end state but the beginning of the next set of reforms. He said, Integrated Theatre Commands

will lead to many reforms like Single to Multi Domain operations, fusing space and cyber space into traditional domains, digitisation of battlefield information and visualisation, net centric to data centric among others.

Stressing that the reforms in Indian Defence eco-system are necessity, the CDS said, nation states across the globe are facing a new set of challenges, and current flux in world order is forcing nations to review their security strategies. The rapid and unbridled march of technology is transforming the way future wars will be fought, he added.

## Directorate of Disaster Management issues monsoon preparedness tips for Cyclone, heavy rain, water logging, flash flood

Port Blair, May 22

Andaman and Nicobar Islands are vulnerable to hydro-meteorological disasters which fall in cyclogenesis zone and cyclones form in the Andaman Sea in each year. Heavy monsoon rains cause localized flooding, which occurs regularly in low-lying locations.

Considering that the Southwest monsoon has already advanced into the A&N Islands, the Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has requested the general public to be prepared to save themselves from heavy rain, strong winds and probable flooding. The monsoon season can cause substantial damage to buildings, property, and

infrastructure, but a few essential precautions can help reduce the impact. Here are some important tips to help preparing for the monsoon season:

- **Clear gutters and drains:** Clogged gutters and drains can lead to water logging, so make sure to clear any debris from these areas before the monsoon season begins.
- **Inspect roof:** Check roof for any damage or leaks, and make necessary repairs before the monsoon season arrives.
- **Secure outdoor items:** High winds can turn outdoor furniture, grills, and other items into dangerous projectiles. Store these items in a safe, secure location or tie them down to prevent them from being blown

## Do's & Don'ts during Earthquake

Port Blair, May 22

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to geological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts (Zone -V) of the world and several great earthquakes have occurred in the past. The severe earthquake that occurred on December 26, 2004 caused horizontal and vertical shift of land mass in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, which caused the loss of lives and property of this UT.

Considering the above, the Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has urged the general public of A&N Islands to adhere to the Do's & Don'ts of Earthquake to mitigate the impact of earthquake and save their precious lives.

### Before Earthquake

- Consult a structural engineer to make your house earthquake resilient.
- Fasten shelves securely to walls; place heavy/ large objects on lower shelves. Provide strong support to power and gas appliances.
- Prepare an emergency kit with essential items for safety and survival.
- Develop an emergency communication and evacuation plan for your family and community.
- Learn the technique of 'Duck-Cover-Hold'.
- Educate yourself and family members about earthquake risk by participating in earthquake safety programmes.

### During Earthquake

If you're indoors, stay inside. If you're outside, stay outside.

- Don't use matches, candles, or any flame. Broken gas lines and fire don't mix.

- If you are in a car, stop the car and stay inside until the earthquake stops.
  - Duck under a table; Cover your head with one hand and hold the table till the tremors last.
  - Stay away from mirrors and windows. Do not exit the building while the earth is still shaking.
  - Move outside as soon as the tremors stop. Do not use a lift.
  - When outside, move away from buildings, trees, walls and poles/electric lines.
  - When inside a vehicle, pull over in an open place and remain inside, avoid bridges.
- ### After Earthquake
- Do not enter damaged buildings.
  - **If trapped in rubble:** Do not light a matchstick. Cover your mouth with a cloth. Tap on a pipe or a wall. Sound a whistle.
  - Use stairs and not lifts or elevators.
  - Move cautiously and check for unstable objects and other hazards above and around you. Check yourself for injuries.
  - Stay away from beaches. Tsunamis and seiches sometimes hit after the ground stops shaking.
  - Do not spread and/ or believe in rumours.

Satwik and Chirag showcased impeccable form throughout the tournament, winning all their matches in straight games. Their



dominant performance was highlighted in the final where they defeated China's Chen Bo Yang and Liu Yi 21-15, 21-15 in just 46 minutes, securing their second Thailand Open men's doubles title.

The Indian pair first rose

to the pinnacle of the world rankings on October 10, 2023, after their groundbreaking gold medal win at the Asian Games in Hangzhou, China. However, their reign was short-lived as Liang and Wang reclaimed the top spot three weeks later.

India's Ekta Bhyan secured gold medal with a season's best throw of 20.12 metre in the women' F51 club throw competition at the World Para Athletic Championships at Kobe in Japan yesterday. While Kashish Lakra took the silver with an effort of 14.56 metre, Nadjet Boucherr of Algeria won the bronze with a score of 12.70 metre.

Deepthi, Para Asian Games gold medallist, had smashed a world record time of 55.07 seconds in the



women's 400 metre T20 category race to win gold medal on May 20. The

championships will continue till 25th of this month.

- **Follow evacuation orders:** If authorities issue an evacuation order, follow it immediately. Do not delay or hesitate.
- **Stay tuned to local news:** Stay tuned to local news and radio stations for updates on the situation.
- **Be prepared:** Have an emergency kit ready, including food, water, medications, and important documents.

**DON'Ts:**  
➤ **Don't stay in low-lying areas:** If you are in a low-lying area and a tsunami warning is issued, do not stay there. Move to higher ground immediately.

- **Don't go to the coast to watch the wave:** Tsunamis are not a spectator sport.

Stay away from the coast and do not go there to watch the wave.

- **Don't use the beach as a shelter:** Do not use the beach or shoreline as a shelter during a tsunami. The wave can be much higher than the normal tide level and can quickly flood the area.
- **Don't use elevators:** If you are in a building during a tsunami, do not use the elevators. Use the stairs instead.
- **Don't return to the area until it is safe:** After a tsunami, do not return to the area until authorities declare it safe to do so.

- Confirm your order history and the potential delivery dates before accepting / cancelling any package.
- Avoid clicking on any link received in an SMS when dealing with such package deliveries.
- Scrutinize all the URLs (links) before opening and filling in any information/

OTP.

- Avoid sharing your personal details such as address, email id, phone number, etc. if not required.
- Avoid clicking on a link or calling back the number from an unexpected delivery notice via a SMS or email.

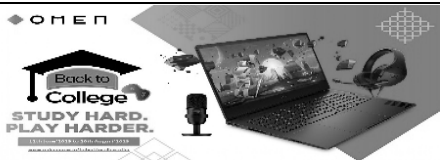

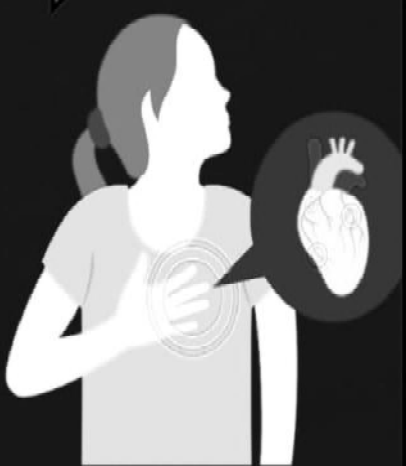
